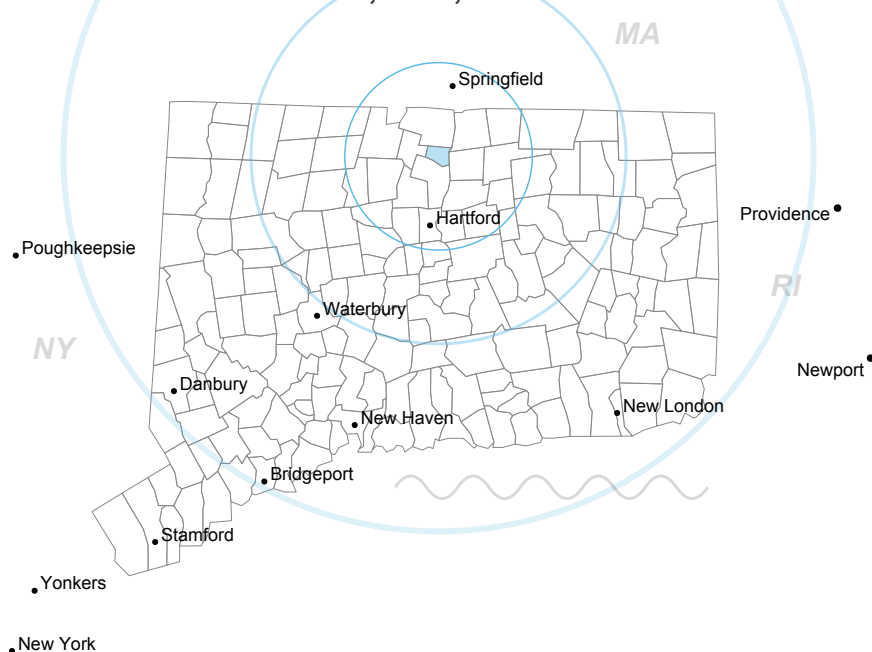


Self-Employment Rate*

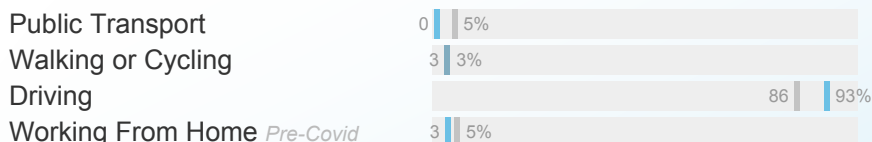
