10 Ways To Prevent The Next Week Crash

1. Understand it's a marathon, not a sprint.

2. Identify what is the real "win" and make it measurable.



3. Prioritize collecting contact information.

4. Develop a follow-up strategy.

Allocate marketing dollars after the big event.



6. Incentivize a return visit for visitors.

7. Ask for a specific, small next step.

8. Create urgency.



9. Promote the next big day.

10. Make sure next week is not an off week.
