AWARD

The recipient will receive up to one full week of training at the Colorado Chapter Educational Institute, including up to five nights lodging (reserved by CCICC), up to \$250 for meals not included in the registration and an allowance of \$200 will be available for use at the ICC bookstore. Also, if not a current member of the Chapter, a one year CCICC membership will be included in the award. The total value of the award package shall not exceed \$2000.

ELIGIBILITY

Any State of Colorado resident may apply for the Award. The following evaluation criteria shall be taken into consideration by the Institute Scholarship Program Committee (ISPC) during the evaluation process for each applicant:

- The candidate's accomplishments, awards, or recognition that demonstrates leadership abilities and qualities.
- The candidate's submission of at least two recommendation letters (one from your current supervisor and one from a previous supervisor or other community leaders).
- The candidate's submission of a personal statement elaborating on his or her personal goals and qualifications.
- The candidate's interest in the mission of the Colorado Chapter of ICC.
- The candidate's involvement in extracurricular ventures or affiliations.
