Join our mission to serve survivors of domestic & sexual violence by listening to their stories, believing them, & connecting them to resources. CPAF trains volunteer hotline counselors to answer calls coming in to our 24-hour hotline.

CPAF invites you to apply to volunteer as a Hotline Counselor! Volunteer counselors provide emotional support, community referrals, maintain a client-centered focus, and begin the client intake process. Volunteers commit to a regular, weekly or bi-monthly shift on weekdays during business hours (9am and 5pm).

Requirements: LiveScan Background check; TB test; volunteer application and interview; completion of CPAF's 65-hour Advocate Training
