Quick SMART Goals review (sorry!)

- S pecific
- M easurable
- A ction-oriented (or achievable!)
- R ealistic (or Resonant!)
- Time-based

Change your mindset

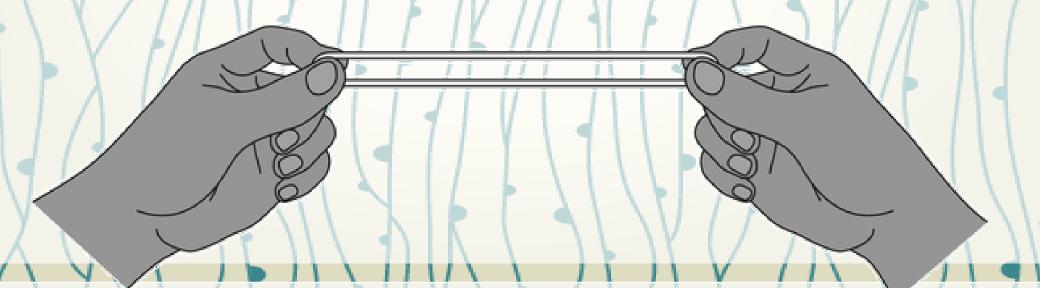
- Banish certain phrases
- Goals can change/evolve

Your "WHY"

- Start With Why by Simon Sinek (Why → How → What)
- Personal and/or biz mission statement (belief system)
- Gut decisions come from this place (limbic brain)
- I Have a Dream vs. I Have a Plan

Cognitive dissonance

- Start with the end in mind
- Examine beginning what needs to change?
- Let go of beginning!



ONE Thing

- Big goals take time (66 days to a new habit)
- Counterbalancing
- 80/20 (Pareto)
- Multitasking
- Willpower is finite but renewable
- One Thing big-picture and right-now

Control free time

- Priorities
- Time is finite... but elastic
- Put your goals on the schedule FIRST (yes... it's kind of a chicken-or-the-egg activity)
- Laura Vanderkam (168 Hours ; I Know How She Does It)

Deliberate practice

- 10,000 hours?? (Malcolm Gladwell)
- Purposeful and systematic
