Tips

for the Beginner Painter

1. Setup Comfortably

- Wear clothes you can stain.
- Setup your workshop in a bright area, with space and lots of natural light.
- Print the color palette.
- Arrange your paints tubes in stacked rows of 10 for quicker access.
- Make a great palette with an old plate.

2. About Paint

- Work from top to bottom.
- Paint undiluted.
- Lather paint with even and parallel brush strokes.
- Get an even better look by avoiding overlap marks.
- Get the best coverage by layering your paint 2 or 3 times.

3. About Brushes

- Make flat areas easier by using a flat brush.
- Use several brushes to avoid color contamination.

4. Care For Your Tools When You Are Done

- Wash brushes thoroughly with dish soap and water.
- Store your brushes in a cup, hair up.
- Make sure your tubes are closed and clean.
