What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files containing a string of characters that can be placed on your computer or mobile device that uniquely identify your browser or device.

What are cookies used for?

Cookies allow a website to know if your computer or device has visited that website before. Cookies can then be used to help understand how the website is being used, help you navigate between pages efficiently, help remember your preferences, and generally improve your browsing experience.

What types of cookies does CSI Literacy Cloud use?

There are generally four categories of cookies: “strictly necessary,” “performance,” “functionality,” and “targeting.” CSI Literacy Cloud routinely uses the first three categories of cookies on the service, but *does not* use targeting cookies.

1. Strictly necessary cookies. These cookies are essential, as they enable you to move around the website and use its features, such as accessing resources that require you to be logged in.
2. Performance cookies. These cookies collect information about how you have used the website – for example, information related to the unique username you have provided. These cookies also track aggregate service usage to help website developers improve how the website works.
3. Functionality cookies. These cookies allow the website to remember how you’re logged in, when you logged in or out, and the state or history of website tools you’ve used.
4. Targeting cookies. Companies use these types of cookies to deliver advertising. These cookies can remember that your device has visited a website, and may also be able to track your device’s browsing activity on other websites. This information may be shared with organizations, such as advertisers and/or advertising networks to deliver advertising and help measure the effectiveness of an advertising campaign. CSI Literacy Cloud *does not* use targeting cookies.

How long will cookies stay on my device?

The length of time a cookie will stay on your computer or mobile device depends on whether it is a “persistent” or “session” cookie. Session cookies will only stay on your device until you stop browsing. Persistent cookies stay on your computer or device until they expire or are deleted.

First and third party cookies

First-party cookies are cookies that belong to CSI Literacy Cloud, while third-party cookies are cookies that another party places on your device through our service. Third-party cookies may be placed on your device by someone providing a service for CSI Literacy Cloud, for example to help us understand how our service is being used.

How to control and delete cookies
