## Suggested Packing List for Campers!

This list indicates the kind and quantity of items the average guest will need during their stay at camp. It is meant as a guide, and it is <u>not</u> necessary that guests have each item in the quantity suggested. Always check the weather before leaving home and adjust accordingly!

You absolutely need to bring your own sheets, pillow and don't forget your towel!

- If you are staying in a Lodge, Quad, or Health Center: These are "twin" size beds.
- If you are staying in a **Cabin**: These are "full" size beds.
- It can get cold at night, bring a blanket or sleeping bag.
- If you want to be extra comfy, bring a foam pad to sleep on.
