You will be an agile tester and learner, skillfully assessing how best to leverage D-Rev's resources for maximum learning and credibility. You will be a creator of new knowledge and evidence, always looking for new questions to explore and eager to find the answers.

Responsibilities

- **Design, plan, and carry out research through various means, such as focus groups, surveys, interviews, and hospital-based studies.**
- Identify and frame relevant research questions in collaboration with project teams.
- Develop research strategies, including deciding on the most appropriate research methodologies.
- Draft study proposals, including sections related to literature review, methodology, timeline, budget, and tools.
- Research and create survey protocols and tools specific to different areas of practice within the organization, including, for example, Knowledge, Attitude and Practice (KAP) surveys for ECHO training program and Human Factors study protocols for medical device testing.
- Record and analyze research results using statistical techniques and packages.
- Prepare written summaries, and prepare and present oral and poster presentations.
- Liaise with and support the efforts of external researchers evaluating our interventions.
- Ensure adherence to relevant regulations and best practices.
- Contribute to development and evolution of program theories.
- Recruit and supervise enumerators as budget allows, otherwise, independently collect data by travelling to health facilities around India and possibly East Africa.
- Develop and cultivate relationships with external researchers and potential study sites.
- Develop systems to track ongoing projects.
- Contribute to the budget planning process and ensure that research activities are executed within allocated budget.

Requirements

- Post-graduate degree in social science or public health with 3-5 years of relevant work experience.
- Clinical, public health, or medical research strongly preferred.
- Experience with Human-Centered Design strongly preferred.
- Effective, clear oral and written communicator.
- Ability to work successfully on multidisciplinary teams across different time zones.
- Fluency in both English and Hindi.
