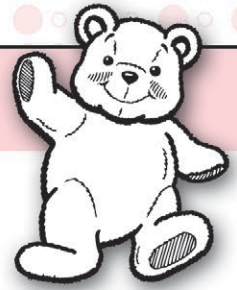

Bible Words

"God made me"

(based on Genesis 1:27).

Say these words. Point upwards while saying "God" and point to yourself while saying "me." Repeat and invite your child to imitate your motions.

(Sing to the tune "This Is the Way" while washing your child's hands.)

Pudding Paint

Place a few spoonfuls of pudding on a clean table or tray. Let your child smear the pudding like finger paint. As he plays, talk about how God made his hands. Make sure your child wears old clothes for this messy activity.
