

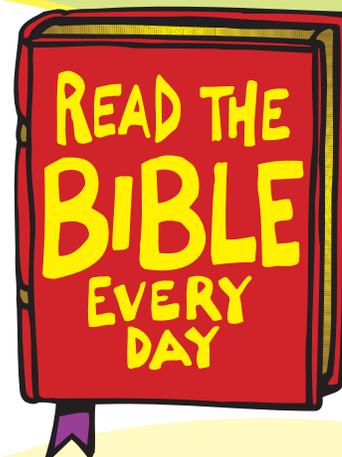
# Faith & Family

## Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Psalm 119:101-105.  
How can obeying God's Word help us walk through life?
- **MONDAY**—Read 2 Samuel 22:31.  
How do we know that God's words are true?
- **TUESDAY**—Read 2 Timothy 2:15; Proverbs 16:3.  
Trying to get through life without knowing what the Bible says is like trying to play a game without reading the rules. As a family, thank God for His Word.
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read 2 Timothy 3:16, 17.  
How can reading God's Word help us?
- **THURSDAY**—Read 1 Thessalonians 2:13;  
John 14:23, 24.  
Knowing God's Word can help us make godly choices.  
Pray and ask God to help you obey His Word.
- **FRIDAY**—Psalm 119:18; Deuteronomy 11:18-20.  
When can we read and study God's Word in our home?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Psalms 1:1-3; 119:14-16.  
We can be joyful and content when we know and obey God's Word.
