Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Isaiah 6:1, 8.
Do you think our family is ready and willing to do work for God? What could we do?
- **MONDAY**—Read Ecclesiastes 4:9, 10.
How can we make a job easier for someone else in our family this week?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Mark 12:28-31.
What did Jesus say are the two most important commandments?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Luke 10:25-37.
Is there a new person or family in our neighborhood? What can we do to be good neighbors?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Matthew 5:43-47.
It is easy to be friendly to people who are nice. God wants us to love the people who are not lovable. Name some ways we can do that.
- **FRIDAY**—Read Philippians 2:14, 15.
Do we serve others without grumbling? How can we improve in this area?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Matthew 25:34-40.
When we serve others, we are serving God. Choose a way we can serve someone this week.
