Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Genesis 2:7-9, 15-17.
What is one of the first commands in the Bible?
- **MONDAY**—Read Matthew 22:34-40.
What did Jesus say are the two greatest commandments?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Genesis 3:1-13.
Adam and Eve both blamed someone else for their sin, but each one chose to disobey. Do we ever blame others when we have done wrong? What should we do?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read 1 Corinthians 10:13.
Sometimes our friends want us to do things that go against God's teachings. How does God help us obey Him?
- **THURSDAY**—Read 1 Timothy 4:12, 15, 16.
How can we help our friends do what is right?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Romans 7:18-25.
Have you ever tried to be really good, but you messed up anyway? Let's read how confused Paul felt about having the same problem.
- **SATURDAY**—Read 1 Timothy 6:11, 12; 2 Timothy 2:22.
What can we do that will help us obey God's laws?
