Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Luke 23:32-34.
What example of forgiveness did Jesus set for us?
- **MONDAY**—Read Colossians 3:13, 14.
Why should we forgive others?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Matthew 6:14, 15.
What must we do to be forgiven by God?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read 2 Corinthians 2:10, 11.
When we don't forgive, we fall into Satan's trap.
Is there anyone you need to forgive?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Mark 11:24, 25.
According to these verses, what are we to do when we pray?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Matthew 6:9-13.
What does Jesus' model prayer teach about asking God for forgiveness?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Galatians 5:22, 23; 1 Corinthians 13:4, 5.
Which fruit of the Spirit can help us to forgive others?
