Take a Bird Walk

Gather your family and take a walk to look for birds. Point out the different kinds of birds. Ask your verbal child to name the colors of the birds. Tell your child to listen for the birds. Invite him to make sounds to imitate the birds. Look in trees for nests. Remember to thank God for making the birds.

Feed the Birds

If you have a bird feeder, let your child help fill it with birdseed. If you don't have a bird feeder, help your child string O-shaped cereal or pretzels onto yarn or string. Hang these in the tree branches for the birds to enjoy. Invite your child to watch the birds eat. Remind him that God made the birds.
