## Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Luke 18:1-8.  
Why did Jesus tell this parable? (Read Luke 18:1 again.)
- **MONDAY**—Read Philippians 4:4-7.  
How should we present our requests to God?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Matthew 6:9-15.  
What can we say in our prayers to follow Jesus' example of how to pray?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Ephesians 6:18-20.  
For what should we pray?
- **THURSDAY**—Read 1 Timothy 2:1-4.  
What does God want for everyone?  
Do you pray for this?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Proverbs 15:29.  
Whose prayers does God hear?
- **SATURDAY**—Read John 17:20, 21.  
In one of Jesus' last prayers while He was on earth, He prayed for you! What does Jesus want for us?
