

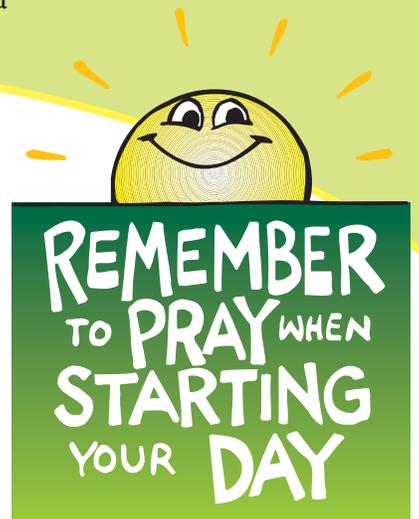
Faith & Family

Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Philippians 2:3-5.
What does it mean to be humble? How can we show humility?
- **MONDAY**—Read 2 Corinthians 1:3, 4.
What makes you sad? How does God comfort you? How can we be used by God to comfort others?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Psalm 37:10, 11.
What does it mean to be meek? What is promised to the meek?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Proverbs 11:18-21.
What characterizes the life of a righteous person? What are the rewards of the righteous?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Romans 12:18.
It is better to be a peacemaker than to cause trouble. How can we help keep the peace in everyday situations?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Acts 14:19-22.
Has anyone made fun of you for loving Jesus? What did you do? What can we do to encourage other Christians?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Romans 12:12-16.
Name specific times when we can demonstrate some of the qualities listed in these verses.
