## Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Acts 28:16, 30, 31.  
When can we be bold for Christ?
- **MONDAY**—Read Joshua 24:14, 15.  
How can our family serve God even when other families we know won't?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Psalm 27:1, 2.  
Do you sometimes fear those who do not follow God? Who can help us overcome our fears?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Acts 10:34-43.  
What would you say if you were asked to stand up and tell a crowd of people about Jesus?
- **THURSDAY**— Read Luke 22:54-62.  
Share about a time when you missed an opportunity to stand up for Jesus. Ask God to forgive you.
- **FRIDAY**—Read 1 John 3:15-18.  
How can we show our love for Jesus?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Psalm 28:6, 7.  
Thank God for helping you stand up for right.
