Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Matthew 1:1, 16, 17.
Jesus' family tree included people who made mistakes. Thank God for accepting and using us even though we sin.
- **MONDAY**—Read Luke 1:25-38.
With God anything is possible. Name three things God has done that seem impossible.
- **TUESDAY**—Read Luke 2:1-20.
As a family, read about Jesus' birth. Thank God for sending His Son, Jesus.
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Matthew 1:18-24.
Joseph's decision required a lot of faith. How can we show faith in God?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Luke 2:1-7.
Jesus slept in a manger because there was no guest room available. How can we make room in our lives for Jesus?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Luke 2:8-11.
The angels brought the shepherds good news that was for all the people. How can we make sure our family, friends, and neighbors know about Jesus?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Luke 2:19.
Mary quietly thought about all the events surrounding Jesus' birth. How do we spend our quiet times with God?
