Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?



- **SUNDAY**—Read Hebrews 10:24, 25.
Why is meeting with the church family on a regular basis so important?
- **MONDAY**—Read Acts 2:42-47.
What are some things Christians can do together?
- **TUESDAY**—Read 1 Thessalonians 5:11-18.
How can we encourage others in the church family?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Psalm 96:1-3.
What are some of your family's favorite praise songs? Sing them to God today.
- **THURSDAY**—Read 2 Corinthians 9:6, 7.
What does it mean to be a cheerful giver?
- **FRIDAY**—Read 1 Corinthians 11:23-26.
What does communion, or the Lord's Supper, help us remember?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Acts 12:5-12.
Who in our congregation needs prayer? Pray for those people today.
