Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- SUNDAY—Read Luke 17:11-19.

  How many of the lepers thanked Jesus for healing them?

  What are some things our family can thank God for?
- MONDAY—Read Mark 7:31-37.
   Hearing and speech are gifts from God. Name four reasons to be thankful for these gifts.
- TUESDAY—Read John 5:1-9.
  How did Jesus heal the man at the pool? Praise Jesus for His power over sickness.
- WEDNESDAY—Read John 4:46-54.
  How has Jesus shown His power in the lives of members of our family?
- THURSDAY—Read John 9:1-7.
  Why was the man in this story blind? What can we tell people when they are surprised because of what Jesus does for us?
- FRIDAY—Read John 11:38-45.

  Many people put their faith in Jesus after Lazarus was brought back to life. What helps you believe in Jesus?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Matthew 9:18-26. How can we spread the news of Jesus' great power? Who can we tell about Jesus?
