Encourage your child to read the daily Scriptures. Read the verses yourself. Use the questions to help your preteen understand the verses and apply them to life. ○ **SUNDAY**—Read Psalm 119:30-32.

○ **MONDAY**—Read Ephesians 4:15.

○ **THURSDAY**—Read Romans 1:25.


