Family Devotions

Hopefully your preteen is beginning to develop a habit of personal devotions. But there are still plenty of times when your input is needed—and valued. Encourage your child to read the daily Scriptures. Read the verses yourself. Use the questions to help your preteen understand the verses and apply them to life. Discover and learn from God’s Word—together!

- **SUNDAY**—Read Ephesians 5:8-12.
God wants us to live as “children of light.” How can we do that? What “deeds of darkness” do we need to avoid?
- **MONDAY**—Read 1 Chronicles 16:23-25.
God longs to hear our praise. Where, besides in worship services, can we praise Him? How can we praise Him?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Luke 10:25-37.
God wants us to love our neighbors. Who are some of our neighbors? How can we help a neighbor in need?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Matthew 5:14-16.
God wants others to see our love for Him. Why might we hide our love for God? How can we let our love for God show to those around us?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Luke 6:46-49.
God wants us to be wise and obey Christ’s teachings. What are some things we can do to find out how Christ said we should live our lives?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Psalm 91:14, 15.
What does God promise to do if we call on Him? When and where can we pray to God?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Matthew 28:16-20.
God wants us to tell others about Him. Who do we know that needs to hear about Christ? How can we share our faith with that person?
