

Dexcom External Research Program – Quick Reference Guide

Welcomes global proposals for research involving Dexcom technology. Typical categories of eligible research include:

- Investigator-initiated studies (IIS)
- Studies sponsored by non-profit groups/research consortiums (e.g. Artificial Pancreas groups)

How To Apply Online

1) Register at <http://www.dexcom-exrp.com/> for account username and password (new users only).

2) Log into your account using email address and password.

3) Complete submission fields and upload applicable documents.

4) Submit to Dexcom for review either as concept or full protocol.

**The online submission/review process is confidential by design. Any submitted materials are solely used for support evaluation purposes.*

Study Support Expectations

- Investigator/Sponsor's compliance with regulations related to clinical research (e.g. regulatory approvals, device labeling/accountability, monitoring and safety reporting)
- Timely product forecasts/requests
- Quarterly progress updates or as requested
- Submission of final report and/or draft publications for review

Approved Project Requirements

- Supply Agreement, Letter of Support, or Purchase Order, based on scope of project
- Verification of IRB/EC approval and any other required regulatory approvals

Review Process

- An internal research committee meets regularly to review submissions. Please allow **approximately 8-10weeks** for Dexcom to review and contact you about your submission.
- The Committee's decision to support, including discounted product prices and funding level (if any) are made upon scientific merit, product availability, and current company objectives.

Project Submission Types

1) Concept Submission: An initial submission that contains a brief summary of the proposed research. Dexcom will determine initial level of interest. If approved a full protocol submission will be required for final support.

2) Full Protocol Submission: Submission of full protocol and project details, including:
1) Study Title 2) Project Contact information 3) Background, Rationale, & Study Objectives 4) Study Timelines 5) Product and Funding Requests.
