



**ADDENDUM TO DIRECTOR'S ORDER**

**Re: Addendum to Director's Amended Order for Social Distancing, Facial Coverings and Non-Congregating.**

I, Stephanie McCloud, Director of the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), pursuant to the authority granted to me in R.C. 3701.13 to "make special orders...for preventing the spread of contagious or infectious diseases" **Order** the following to prevent the spread of COVID-19 into the State of Ohio:

Effective immediately Paragraph 12 of the *Director's Amended Order for Social Distancing, Facial Coverings and Non-congregating* signed on April 9, 2021 shall read as follows:

g. Students:

iii. Youth involved in sports and extracurricular activities who are vaccinated and have no symptoms of COVID-19 are not required to quarantine.

h. Vaccinated people:

- i. In accordance with guidance from the CDC, anyone who is fully vaccinated (two weeks after second dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 or two weeks after the single-dose Johnson & Johnson Janssen COVID-19 vaccine) and has been exposed to someone with COVID-19, is not required to quarantine or get tested unless they have symptoms.
- ii. If you live or work in a nursing home or a long term care facility, you shall quarantine in accordance with CDC guidance for the industry, Orders issued by the Director of Health, or other lawful authority.
- iii. If you live or work in another congregate setting (prison/jail, ICF/IID, or other group home setting), you shall quarantine and test in accordance with CDC guidance for the industry, Director of Health Orders and/or other lawful authority.

To the extent there may be a conflict between this Addendum and the *Director's Amended Order for Social Distancing, Facial Coverings and Non-congregating* signed on April 9, 2021 this Addendum controls.

Accordingly, this Addendum is effective immediately and remains in effect until the Director of the Ohio Department of Health rescinds or modifies this Addendum.
