THE ART OF REFLECTION

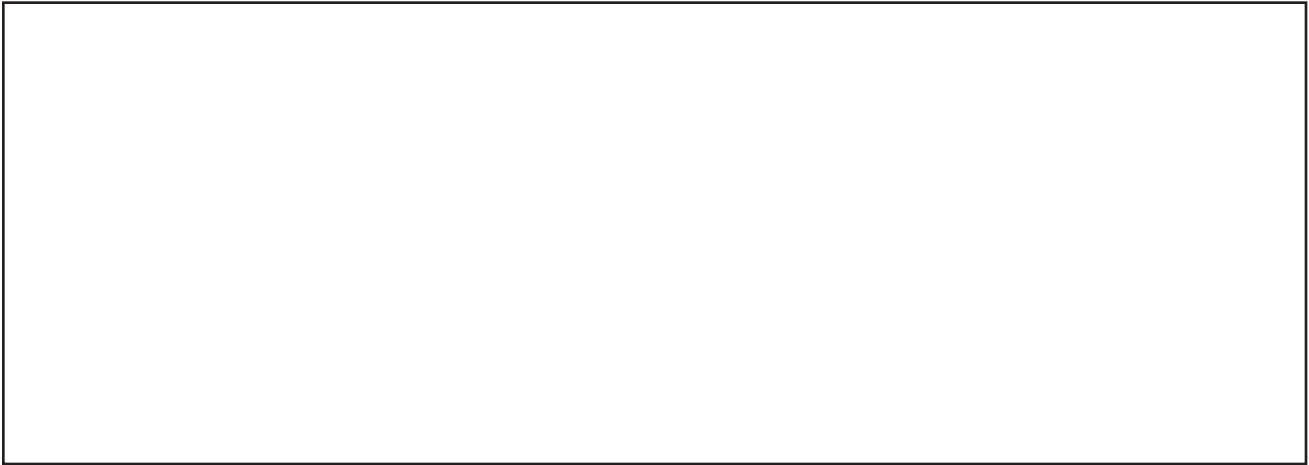

What did you become aware of in your family upbringing?

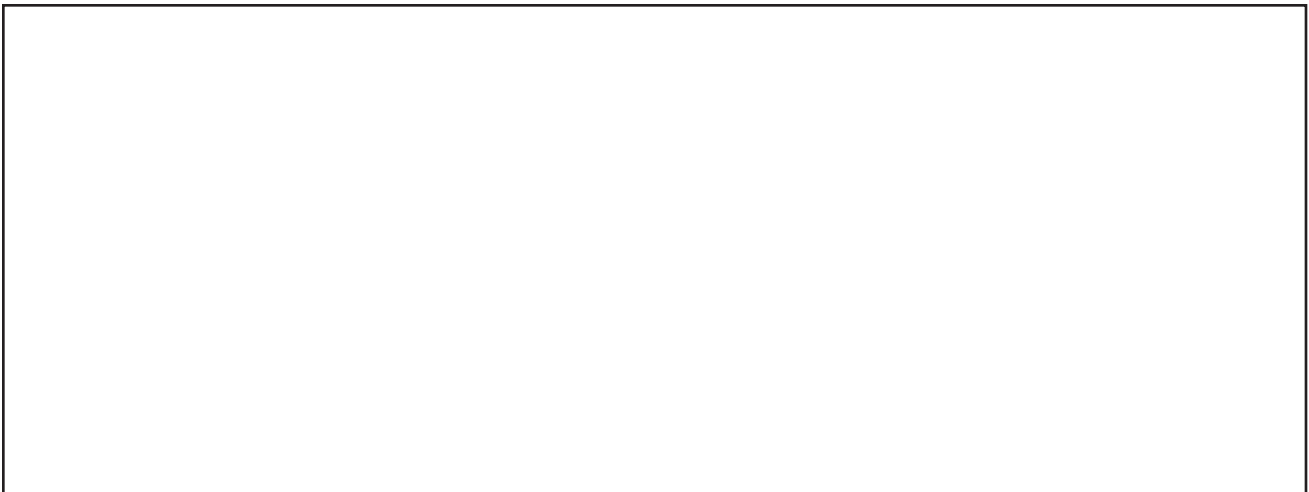
