## DIVISION OF INTERNAL INVESTIGATION 2010 ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT

The Division of Internal Investigation (DII) opened 278 cases of Illinois State Police employee misconduct during 2010. In 120 investigations completed by DII, 51 employees were exonerated; 63 employees received discipline and 6 cases are still open. Cases of less serious transgressions (158) were referred to the employee's division to investigate.

In 2010, there were 229 cases of employee misconduct reported by other agencies under the purview of the Governor. Of those cases initiated, 70 were investigated by DII and 159 were referred back to the originating agency for investigation. Of those cases investigated by DII, 27 were cleared, 12 were sustained and in 25 cases the prosecutor declined to prosecute the subject. There are 6 cases still open.

In 2010, 993 background investigations were completed for ISP applicants and for agencies under the Governor's purview. An additional 1507 criminal history checks were completed for the ISP and external agencies.
