DIVISION OF INTERNAL INVESTIGATION 2011 ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT

The Division of Internal Investigation (DII) opened 257 cases of Illinois State Police employee misconduct during 2011. In 104 investigations completed by DII, 41 employees were exonerated; 43 employees received discipline and 20 cases are still open. Cases of less serious transgressions (153) were referred to the employee's division to investigate.

In 2011, there were 267 cases of employee misconduct reported by other agencies under the purview of the Governor. Of those cases initiated, 57 were investigated by DII and 210 were referred back to the originating agency for investigation. Of those cases investigated by DII, 22 were cleared, 2 were sustained and in 16 cases the prosecutor declined to prosecute the subject. There are 17 cases still open.

In 2011, 1482 background investigations were completed for ISP applicants and for agencies under the Governor's purview. An additional 1607 criminal history checks were completed for the ISP and external agencies.
