

**DIVISION OF INTERNAL INVESTIGATION**  
**2013 ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT**

The Division of Internal Investigation (DII) opened 187 cases of Illinois State Police employee misconduct during 2013. In 76 investigations completed by DII, 3 employees were exonerated; 12 employees received discipline, 12 cases were unfounded or not sustained, and 48 cases are still open. Cases of less serious transgressions (113) were referred to the employee's division to investigate.

In 2013 DII opened 48 cases of employee misconduct reported by other agencies under the purview of the Governor. Of those cases investigated by DII, one led to a conviction, 13 were cleared, one was dismissed, on four cases the prosecutor declined to prosecute the subject and there are 29 cases still open.

In 2013, 1,161 background investigations were completed for ISP applicants and for agencies under the Governor's purview. An additional 651 criminal history checks were completed for the ISP and external agencies.
