This area has been identified as lying within a zone susceptible to amplified shaking in an earthquake and potential liquefaction during a severe earthquake event. The Dunedin City Council may require a site specific design for any new building foundation construction in this area subject to site investigation.

The general vicinity of this property is identified as a 'liquefaction awareness area'. It is classified as liquefaction-susceptibility Domain B. This means that the ground is predominantly underlain by poorly consolidated river or stream sediments with a shallow groundwater table. There is considered to be a low to moderate likelihood of liquefaction-susceptible materials being present in some parts of the areas classified as Domain B. Put another way, there is a moderate to high likelihood that there are no liquefaction-susceptible materials present in some parts of the areas mapped as Domain B.

'Liquefaction awareness areas' do not represent specific hazard zones, but rather highlight areas where there may potentially be a liquefaction hazard that may need further evaluation, in regard to existing or future infrastructure or development. Natural hazards on the Taieri Plains, Otago

This property has been identified as lying within Flood Hazard Area 20 Mosgiel has limited exposure to flood hazard from the Silver Stream, Owhiro Stream, Quarry Creek, and from internal ponding. It is not exposed to flood hazard from the Taieri River due to its elevation. Part of this area was flooded in 1868 and 1923. Floodbanks are located along the length of the Silver Stream, containing flows of 260m3/s or more on the Mosgiel side of the Silver Stream. Flow preferentially spills over the Gordon Road Spillway to the north when flows exceed about 170m3/s. Surface flooding and runoff from the eastern hills can cause localized ponding, such as occurred in April 2006, especially in southern part of the urban area near Quarry Creek. Quarry Creek has a history of flooding. The extent of localized ponding within urban Mosgiel is determined in part by the stormwater network which is designed to provide primary drainage to an urban standard. Part of the area is located within the East Taieri Drainage Scheme which provides land drainage to a rural standard.

Your application for resource consent to erect a garage to replace the existing carport in the same location, on the rear boundary of your property at 6 Laing Street, Mosgiel, was processed on a non-notified basis in accordance with section 93 and 94 of the Resource Management Act 1991. A Council Senior Planner – Consents considered the application under delegated authority on 2nd December 2003.

I advise that the Council has **granted** consent to the application. The full text of the decision commences on page 3. The consent must be given effect to within five years, in accordance with section 125 of the Resource Management Act.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY

The applicant seeks resource consent for the erection of a single garage (3m x 4.6m), to replace the existing carport in the same location. The garage will be erected in the rear boundary of the site at 6 Laing Street, Mosgiel. The garage is to be erected on the rear boundary with No. 1 Laing Street and No. 82 Church Street.

The property is legally described as Lot 1 Deposited Plan 6345 and comprised in Certificate of Title OT327/17 containing an area of 627m².

REASONS FOR APPLICATION

Transitional District Plan

The Proposed District Plan provisions for the residential zone are now beyond challenge. The site is not subject to a designation in the Transitional District Plan. Section 19 of the Resource Management Act as amended in 2003 has the effect of making the relevant provisions of the Proposed District Plan operative and therefore negating the need to further consider the Transitional District Plan in this instance.

Proposed District Plan

The subject site is zoned **Residential 2** in the Dunedin City Proposed District Plan (1999).

Accessory buildings are provided for within the Residential 2 zone, provided that they are associated with a residential activity and are erected on any side or rear yard, and comply with Rule 8.8.2. The proposed activity beaches Rule 8.8.2. (i) (a) (ii) of the Proposed District Plan which requires minimum rear and side yard setbacks of 1.0 and 1.0m respectively. The proposal also breaches Rule 8.8.2.(ii) of the Proposed District Plan, which stipulates that no structure may extend through the height plane envelope of 63°.

Planning Status

Overall, the proposal is considered to be a **Restricted Discretionary activity**.

EFFECTS ASSESSMENT

Affected Persons

The written approval of the persons detailed in the table below has been obtained. In accordance with section 104(3) of the Resource Management Act the consent authority cannot have regard to the effect of the activity on these parties.

Both the parties that completed Affected Persons consent forms own and occupy the adjoining properties to the east and south have no objection to the application.

No other persons are considered to be adversely affected by this proposal for those reasons outlined below in the section headed Effects on the Environment. Furthermore, there are considered to be no circumstances that would warrant the notification of this application.

Effects on the Environment

The following effects assessment only takes into account the effects of the proposal that are relevant under section 104 of the Resource Management Act. The Courts have determined that the effects of an activity on the environment should be considered in relation to the existing environment.

The following assessment of the actual and potential effects of the proposal on the environment has been prepared on the basis that the environment is characterised by the residential nature of the locality. The effects of the proposal are considered to be no more than minor. The erection of a (3m x 4.6m) single garage to replace an existing carport in the rear of the site will not result in a building that is dominant on the streetscape, and the proposed works will not have an adverse effect on the residential character of the locality.

Any actual or potential effects on the environment of allowing this proposal to proceed will be no more than minor for the following reasons:

- (i) Accessory buildings are a permitted activity subject to conditions. While this building does not fully comply with the conditions the adverse effects will be no more than minor because the building is not out of scale with its surroundings. Similar sized garages are located in the locality.
- (ii) The proposal has been assessed against the permitted baseline which provided for residential dwellings and associated accessory buildings. The proposal fits comfortably with the permitted baseline.

CONSENT DECISION

That pursuant to section 34A(1) and 104C and after having regard to Part II matters and section 104 of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Dunedin City Council **grants** consent to a **restricted discretionary activity** for the erection of a single garage to replace an existing at 6 Laing Street, Mosgiel, being legally described Lot 1 DP 6345, CT OT327/17 and subject to the following conditions imposed under section 108 of the Act:

1. The proposal shall be constructed/undertaken in general accordance with the information provided with the application dated 10th October 2003 and received by Council on 31st October 2003.

ADVICE NOTE

- 1. In addition to the conditions of a resource consent, the Resource Management Act establishes through sections 16 and 17 a duty for all persons to avoid unreasonable noise, and to avoid, remedy or mitigate any adverse effect created from an activity they undertake. A similar responsibility exists under the Health Act 1956.
- 2. As discussed with the Drainage Section, the drain under the floor of the garage is to be **sleeved** in accordance with drainage regulations, before any work commences.

DURATION OF CONSENT

This consent shall expire after a period of 5 years from the date of this decision unless the consent has been given effect to during this time. This period may be extended on application to the Council pursuant to Section 125 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

REASONS

SECTION 104 MATTERS

Effects

In accordance with section 104(1)(a) of the Resource Management Act 1991, the actual and potential adverse effects associated with the proposed activity have been assessed and outlined above. It is considered that the proposal will have less than minor adverse effects on the environment.

District Plan – Objectives and Policies

In accordance with section 104(1)(b) of the Resource Management Act 1991, the objectives and policies of the Proposed District Plan (1999) were taken into account when assessing the application.

<u>Dunedin City Proposed District Plan</u>

With regard to the Proposed District Plan the proposal is considered to be consistent with the following objectives and policies:

- Objective 4.2.1 and policy 4.3.1 which seeks to maintain and enhance the amenity values of Dunedin.
- Objectives 8.2.1 and Policy 8.3.1 seeks to ensure that the adverse effects of activities on amenity values and the character of residential areas are avoided, remedied or mitigated.

Consideration has also been given to the Manawhenua, Transportation and Environmental Issues sections of the Proposed District Plan and it is considered that the proposal is consistent with these matters.

In summary the proposal is for an accessory building in a residential zone, which is consistent with the surrounding development in terms of design, appearance and amenity.

Part II matters

It is also considered that the proposal meets Part II Matters of the Resource Management Act 1991. For the reasons outlined in the above, the proposal is considered consistent with sections 5 (2) (c); "Avoiding, remedying, or mitigating any adverse effects of activities on the environment", section 7 (c) "The maintenance and enhancement of amenity values" and section 7 (f) "The maintenance and enhancement of the quality of the environment."

COMPLIANCE WITH CONDITIONS

It is the consent holder's responsibility to comply with any conditions imposed on their resource consent prior to and during (as applicable) exercising the resource consent. Failure to comply with the conditions may result in prosecution, the penalties for which are outlined in Section 339 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

BUILDING CONSENT

This is a resource consent. A building consent is required before any work is undertaken on the site. Please check with the Building Control Office, Development Services .In addition it may be that an Earthworks permit may be necessary. It is the responsibility of the application to establish whether or not an earthworks permit is required. This can be achieved by contacting Montgomery Watson Harza based at The Dunedin City Council Civic Centre.

RIGHTS OF OBJECTION
