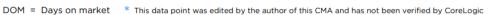

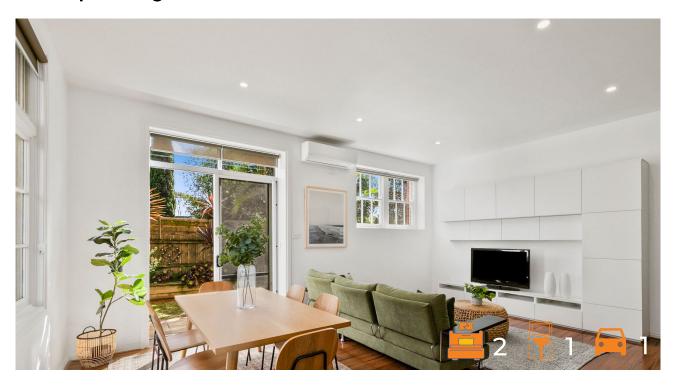

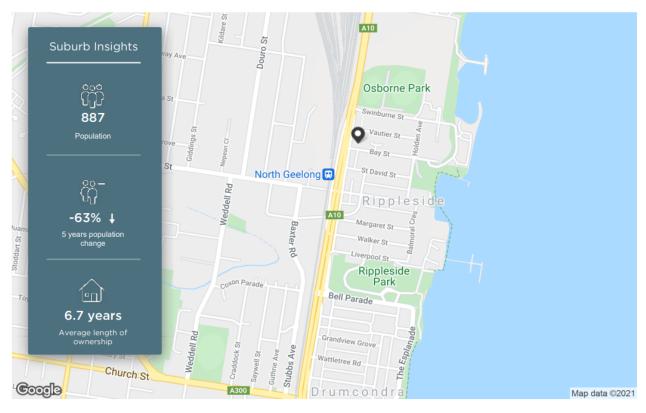

DEMOGRAPHIC



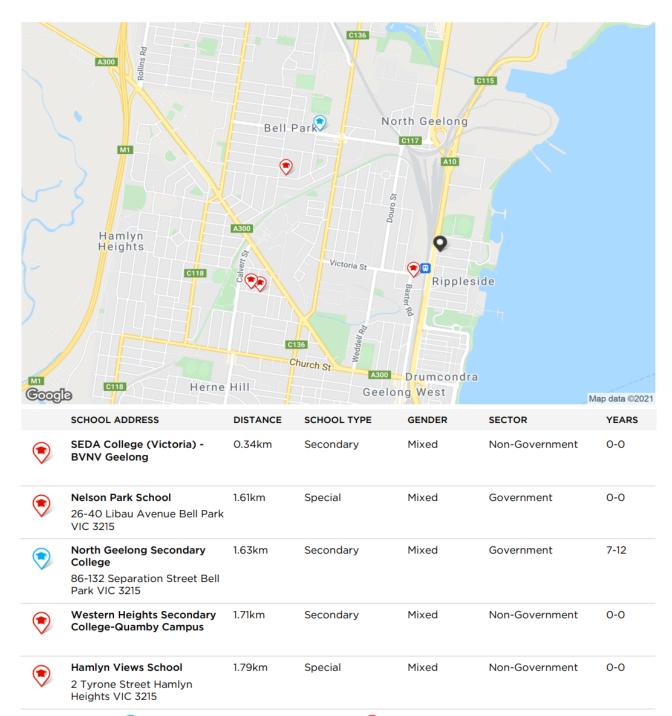
The size of Rippleside is approximately 0.5 square kilometres. It has 3 parks covering nearly 21.2% of total area. The population of Rippleside in 2011 was 2,395 people. By 2016 the population was 887 showing a population decline of 63.0% in the area during that time. The predominant age group in Rippleside is 60-69 years. Households in Rippleside are primarily couples with children and are likely to be repaying \$1000 - \$1399 per month on mortgage repayments. In general, people in Rippleside work in a professional occupation. In 2011, 63.5% of the homes in Rippleside were owner-occupied compared with 74.7% in 2016. Currently the median sales price of houses in the area is \$874,000.

Property is within school catchment area

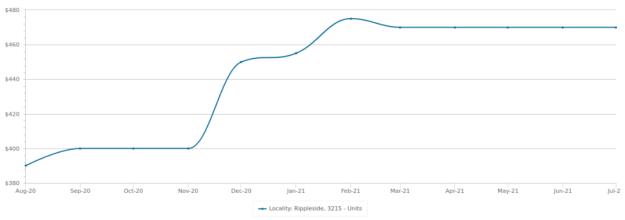


Property is outside school catchment area

Median Asking Rent - 12 months



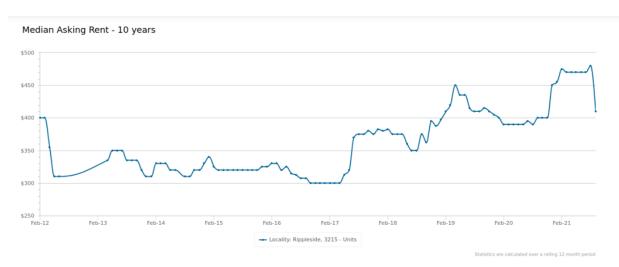
