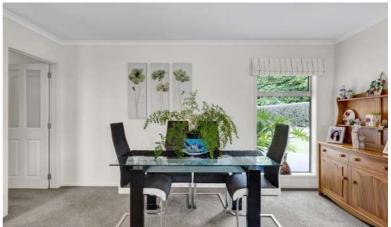

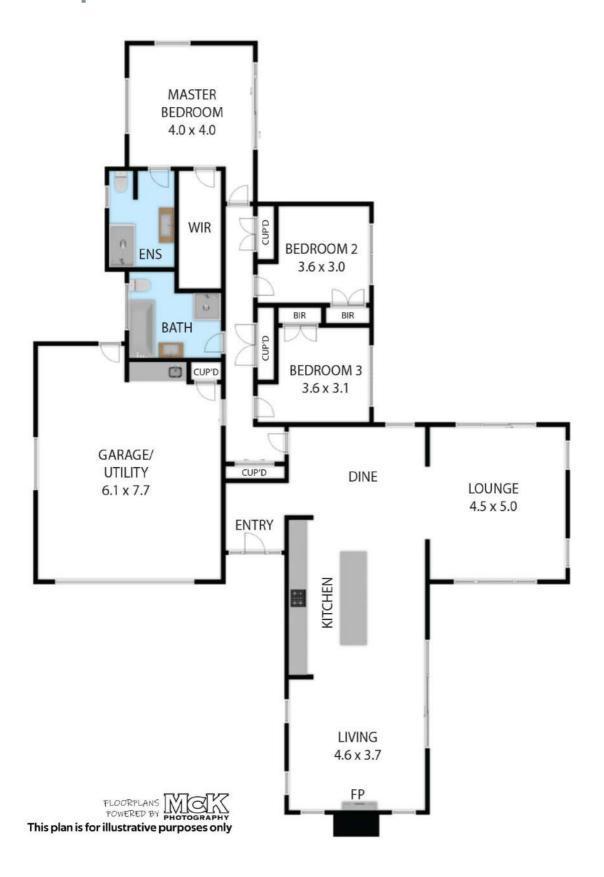








floor plan

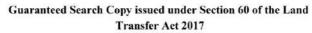
