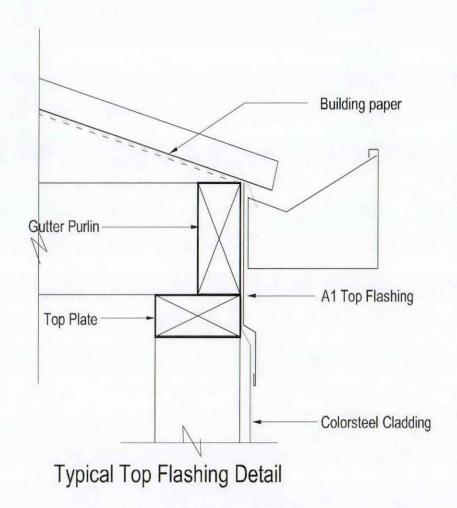


TITLE: Corner Flashing Detail

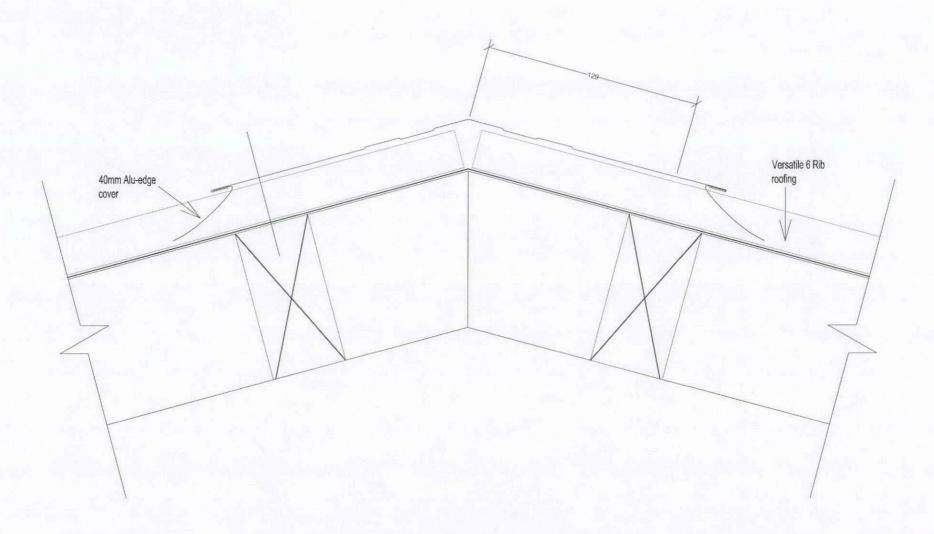

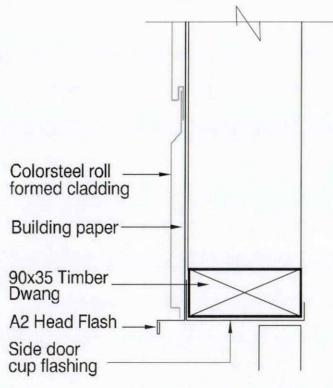

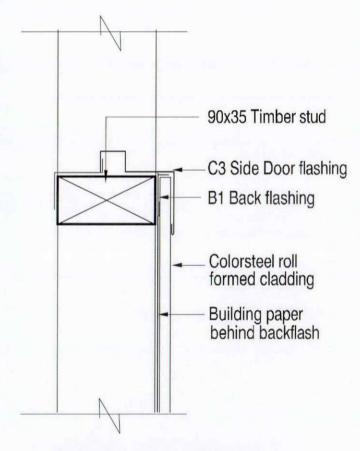

Side Door Jamb Detail

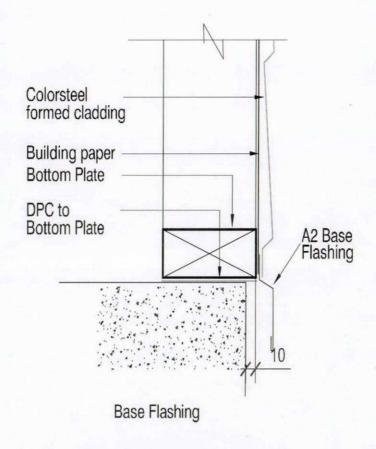

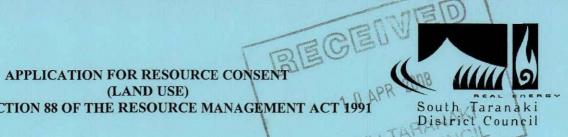
SITE PLAN - MR J. PMANGINO - IN BED FORD OREET SHEWING PROPOSED SITE OF CAR SHED

 - (i) To the rear of a dwelling if a dwelling is on the site; or 20 metres from its road boundary if no dwelling is on the site; and
 - (ii) No closer than 1 metre to the rear or side boundary.

5. No part of any building may extend above the natural ground level at the nearest site boundary by more than 3 metres plus the horizontal distance between that part of the building being measured and the nearest site boundary.

2.04 THE RESIDENTIAL ZONE

2.04.1 OBJECTIVES

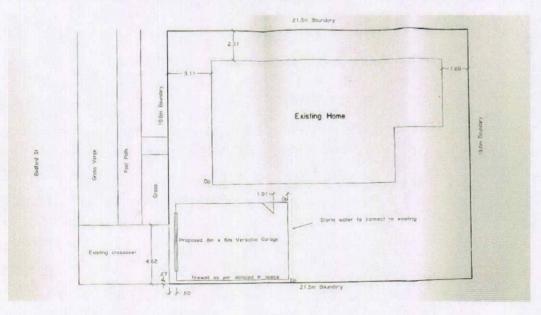
- (a) Maintain and improve the character and amenity values of residential neighbourhoods ensuring:
 - * Activities do not detract from those amenity values
 - * Open street frontages;
 - * Front yards and public places are landscaped;

2.04.2 POLICIES

- (a) To control the bulk and location of building to maximise the penetration of daylight and sunlight to adjacent sites, the availability of open space around dwelling units and the accessibility of dwelling units for vehicles.
- (b) To encourage the landscaping of yards, private and public open spaces, and street frontages.
- (e) To require all activities to utilise existing utilities and services where available, and to ensure that all sites provide adequate vehicle access, parking and manoeuvring space on site.

APPLICATION

The applicant, Sara Griffiths, is requesting yard and height to boundary dispensations for a garage at the property located at 29 Bedford Street, Eltham (Lot 2 DP 4488).



The 443 m^2 site is rectangular in shape and flat in topography. The site is located in the Residential Zone and has an existing dwelling and the garage which is the subject of this application.

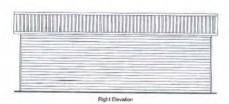


The $48~\text{m}^2$ garage is positioned in front of the existing dwelling and has the following boundary setbacks: 0.50~m metres from the road boundary, 0.27~m metres from the side (north) boundary, approximately 15~m metres from the other side (south) boundary and approximately 13~m metres from the rear boundary. The garage is 2.4~m metres high at the eaves and 3.3~m metres high at the apex. The garage has weatherboard profile cladding and iron roofing.









The garage requires a resource consent for yard dispensations because it is located in front of an existing dwelling and 0.27 metres from the side (north) boundary. The District Plan requires a garage to be located to the rear of an existing dwelling and no closer than one metre to the side boundary. The garage complies with the relevant height to boundary requirements of the District Plan.

EVALUATION

This application is considered as a Discretionary Activity because it does not comply with the relevant boundary setback requirements of the District Plan.

In considering this application, the District Plan's Objective 2.04.1 (a) and Policies 2.04.2 (a) and (b) should be taken into account. These Objectives and Policies seek to balance flexibility in the application of performance standards to enable the particular characteristics of specific activities or sites to be taken into account. At the same time they aim to maintain the character and amenity values of residential neighbourhoods. They also ensure that the activity does not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor.

Because the garage is positioned close to the road boundary, vehicles entering and exiting the garage would need to manoeuvre within the road reserve. It is considered that Bedford Street is wide enough to allow manoeuvring within the road verge without interruption to road users. The surrounding properties are predominantly residential and have adequate on-site manoeuvring. The landowners and occupiers of the surrounding properties who would most likely use the footpath have provided their written approval and are aware of potential effects arising from the proposal. The garage is positioned adjacent to the existing vehicle crossing. The dwelling has a separate access for pedestrian users. It is considered that off-site manoeuvring would not adversely compromise pedestrian safety on adjacent footpaths or vehicle movements along Bedford Street.

The bulk and location performance standards are in place to ensure that access to open space and open street frontages is maintained. Because the garage is positioned in front of the dwelling and closer to the side (north) boundary, adverse environmental effects relating to access to open space and open street frontages should be considered. The garage is positioned approximately three metres away from the dwelling and sufficiently clear from the rear boundary. The areas in between the dwelling and garage and to the rear of the garage are considered large enough to maintain access to open space. The dwelling is positioned approximately three metres from the road boundary. The front yard is approximately 42 m² in area. It is considered that although the garage is positioned in front of the dwelling, there is sufficient front yard available to maintain an open street frontage. The garage and dwelling are painted in beige and are clad with similar materials. There are other garages within the surrounding area constructed with similar materials. Taking onto account the above factors, it is considered that despite the reduced yards, the garage would not adversely impact on the character and amenity values of the surrounding residential environment.

In summary, it is recommended that the yard dispensation be upheld because it would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor. The proposal is not inconsistent with the District Plan's Objective 2.04.1 (a) and Policies 2.04.2 (a) and (b).

Part II of the Resource Management Act 1991

This application is also considered in terms of the purpose and principles of the Act.

It is considered that the vehicles entering and leaving the garage would be able to manoeuvre within the road verge without compromising pedestrian and vehicle safety because Bedford Street is wide enough to accommodate off-site manoeuvring. Bedford Street does not have high traffic usage as compared to High Street and most of the residential properties within the surrounding area have on-site manoeuvring.

It is considered that the garage would maintain the character and amenity values of the residential environment because it is constructed with similar materials as the other garages in the surrounding area. The garage is set back far enough from the rear boundary and the dwelling to maintain access to open space. The dwelling has sufficient front yard to maintain open street frontages.

It is considered that the above factors are consistent with Sections 5 and 7 of the Act.

There are no special land features and known Treaty of Waitangi issues relevant to this application.

Conclusion

The garage is unable to comply with the boundary set back requirements of the District Plan. Because of this, the application is considered as a Discretionary Activity in accordance with Section 4.01.4 (a) of the District Plan.

It is considered that the garage would maintain the character and amenity values of the surrounding residential environment and would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor in terms of pedestrian and vehicle safety.

It is considered that the proposal is not inconsistent with the relevant Objectives and Policies of the District Plan and the purpose and principles of the Resource Management Act 1991.

RECOMMENDATION

<u>THAT</u> consent be granted to Sara Griffiths for a yard dispensation to erect a garage 0.27 metres from the side (north) boundary and 0.50 metres from the road (east) boundary of the property at 29 Bedford Street, Eltham (Lot 2 DP 4488) pursuant to Sections 104 and 104B of the Resource Management Act 1991.

For the following reasons:

- The garage would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor.
- 2. The garage is consistent with Objective 2.04.1 (a) and Policies 2.04.2 (a) and (b) of the District Plan and Part II of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- 3. The written approval of all affected parties has been provided by the applicant.

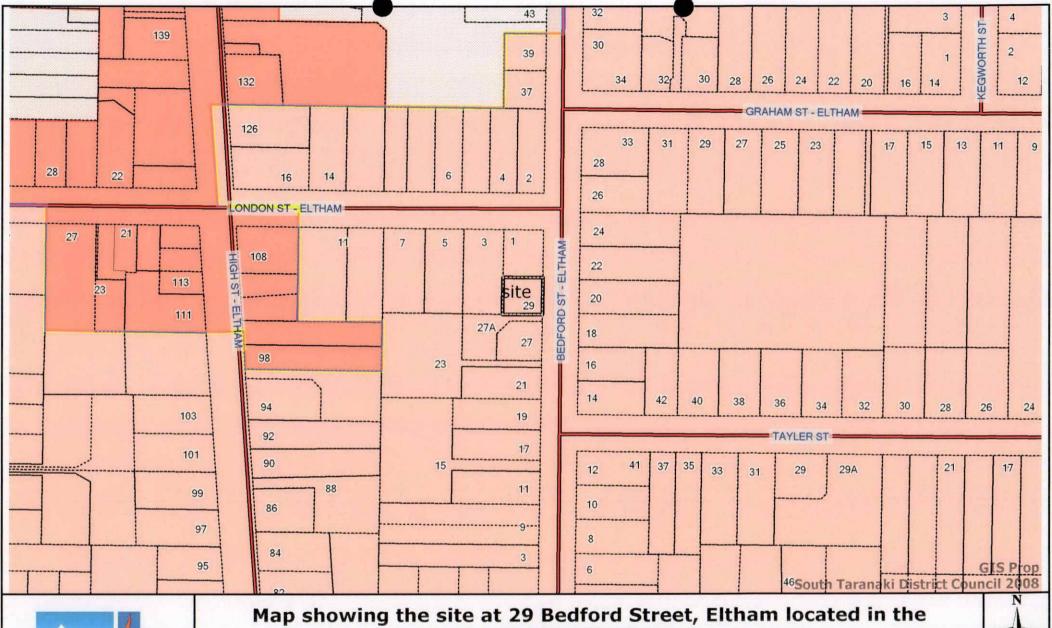

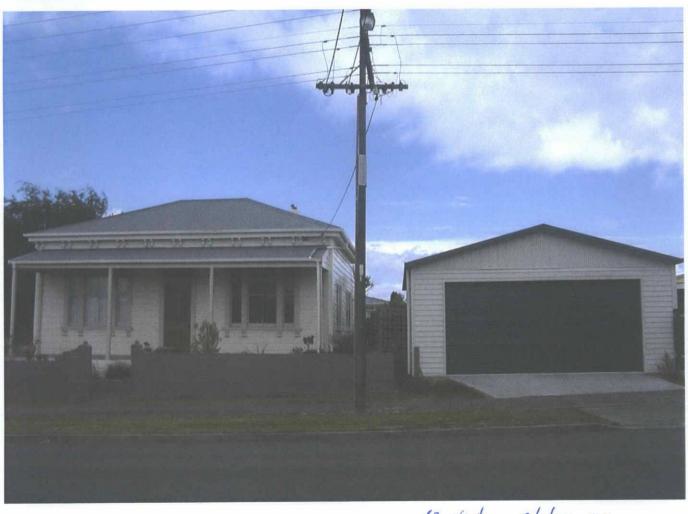
