### Sewer

The Council sewer main at Denby Road is available to receive sewage from the subdivision. The Council would not make any contributions towards the cost of any sewer line from the subdivision to the Denby Road sewer main. Any connections would have to comply with Council's standards. It is recommended that the sub-divider undertakes the design of such sewer line by a qualified Engineer, as the Council would not take any responsibility of sewage problem beyond the Councils existing sewer main.

Should the subdivider decides to install on-site septic tank, it would be their responsibility to ensure that the design of such a septic tank system is adequate for the disposal of sewage without causing any health and environmental nuisances.

The septic tank system or sewer line shall be designed by a qualified Engineer and the report submitted to the Council before commencing any physical works.

### Water

Water to the subdivision could be made available by connecting to 100mm main at Denby Road. The Council would not make any contributions towards the cost of reticulating water to the subdivision. Any connections would have to comply with Council's standards.

### Storm water

There is no public storm water system to dispose of storm water from the subdivision. A report prepared by a qualified Engineer on how storm water will be retained on site shall be submitted to the council prior to commencing any physical works.

# PROPERTY REPORT

### INTRODUCTION

The ongoing report assesses the market value of individual allotments assuming all services are installed, separate Certificates of Title are issued and all the requirements for the subdivision, as specified by the South Taranaki District Council, are met.

### LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed allotments are contained within an existing Certificate of Title TNJ4/443 Taranaki Registry (Lot 3 DP 18010) which has an area of 2.0001 hectares.

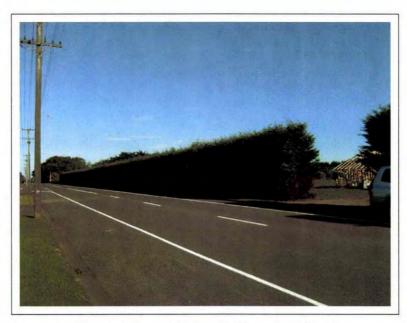

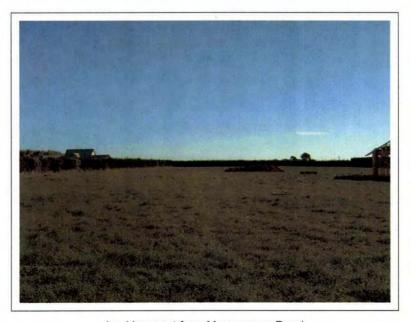

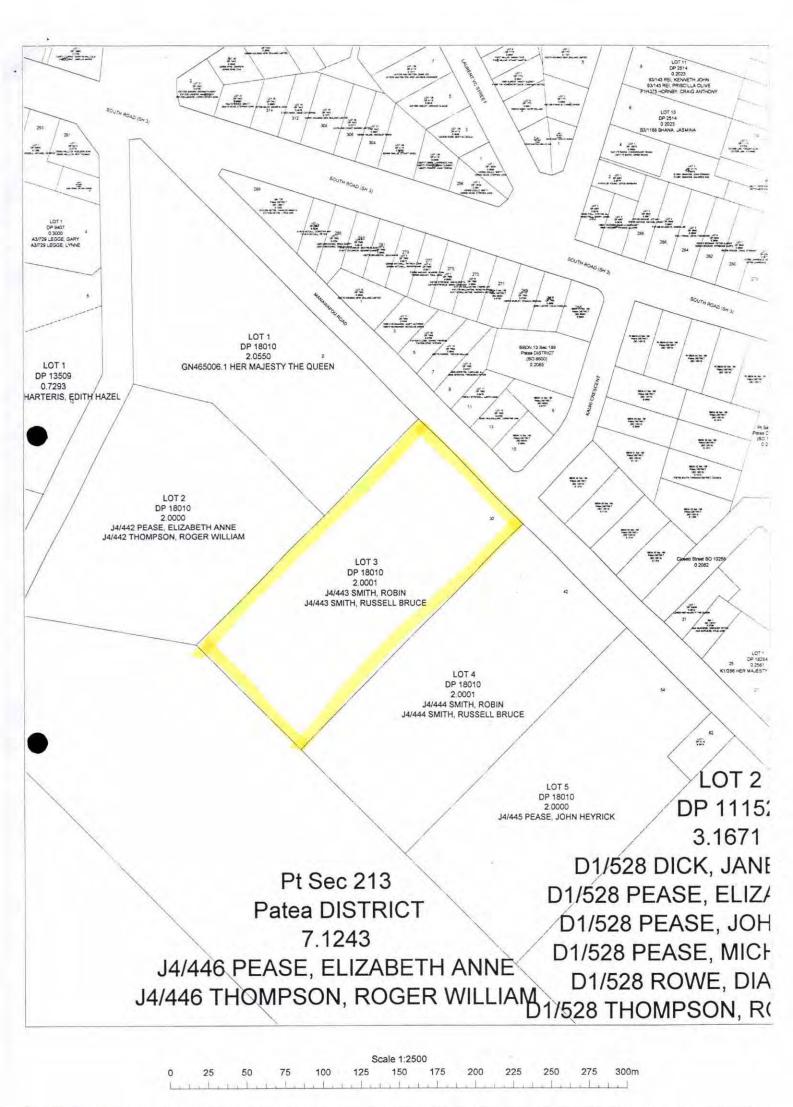
The property road frontage to Manawapou Road

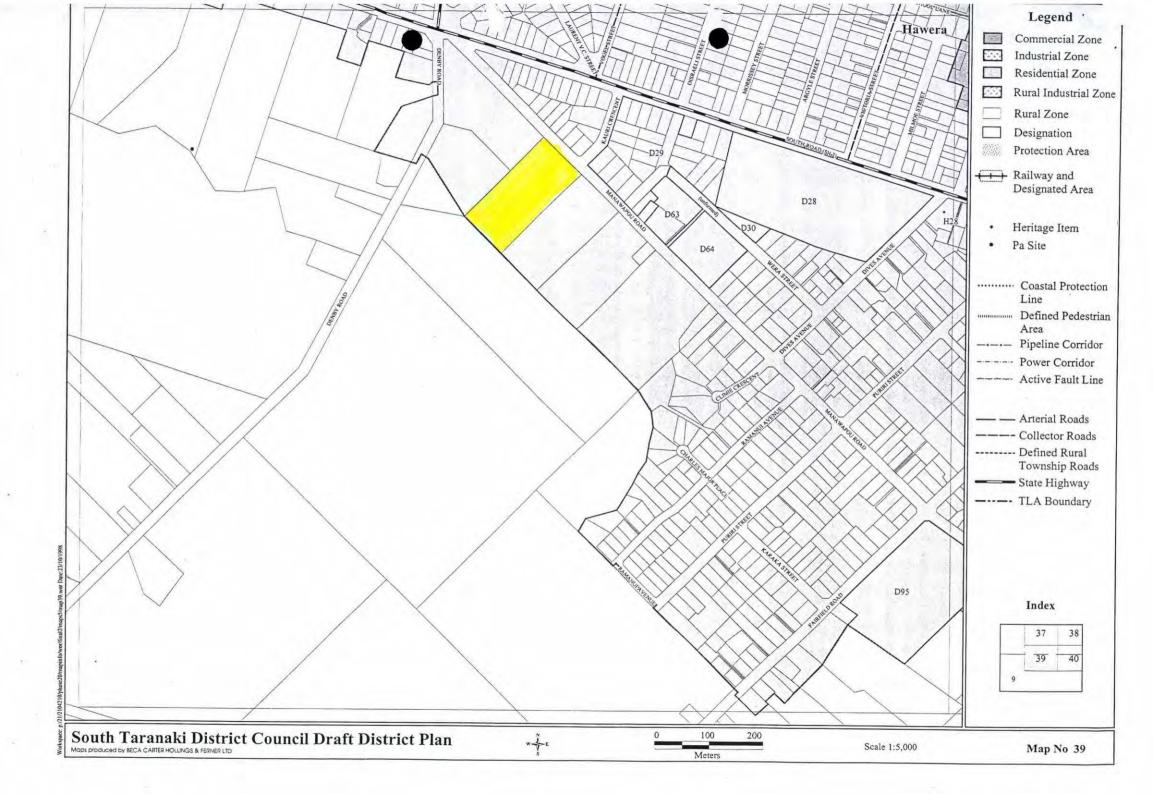


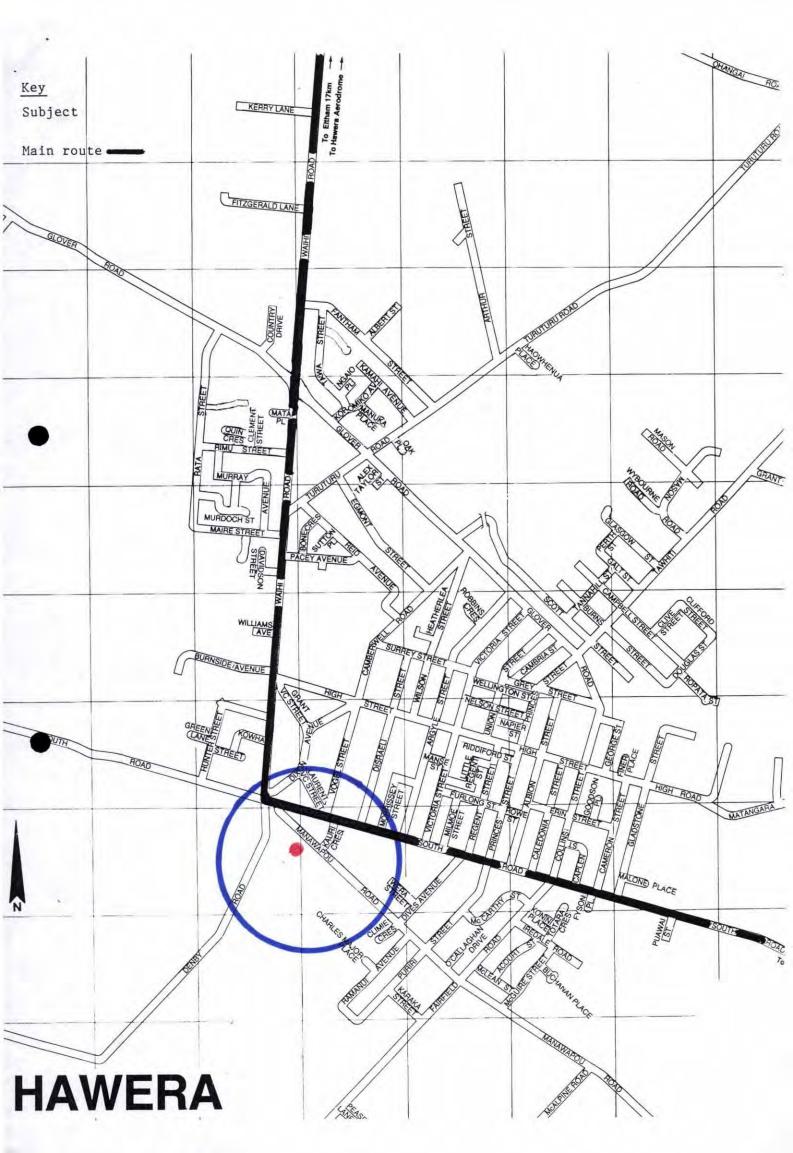
Proposed Lot 1 looking south west

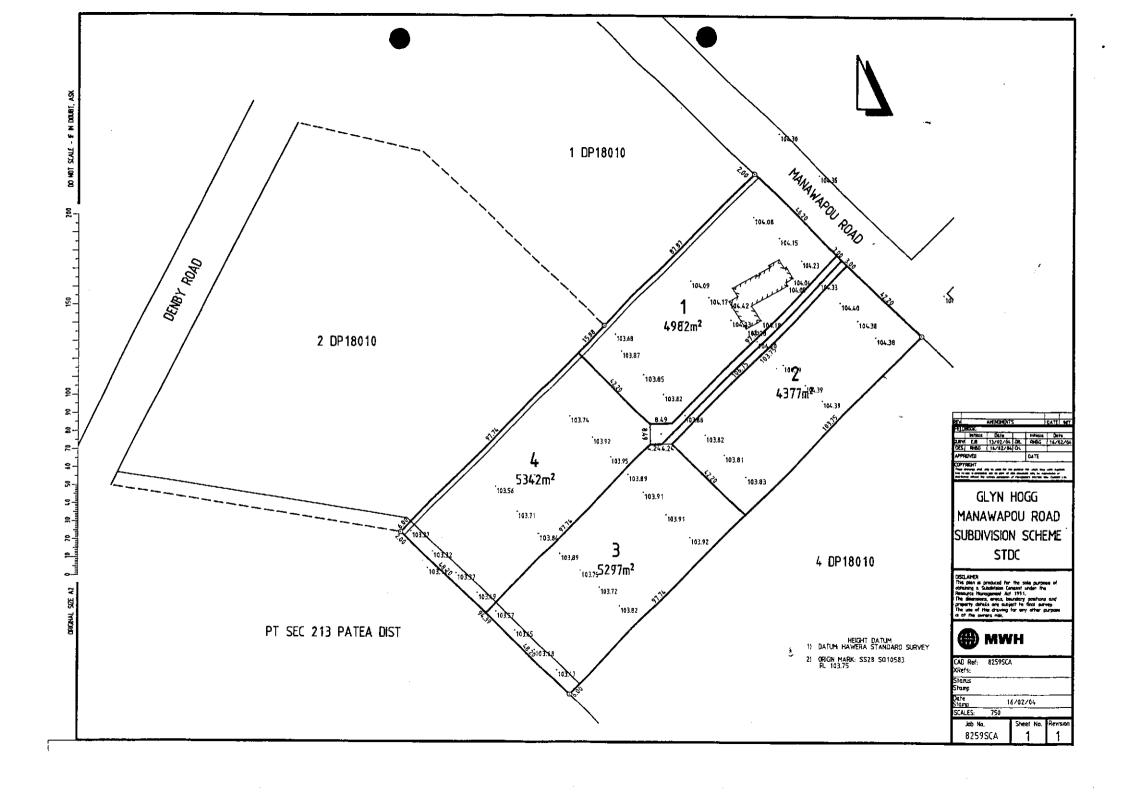


Looking west from Manawapou Road
