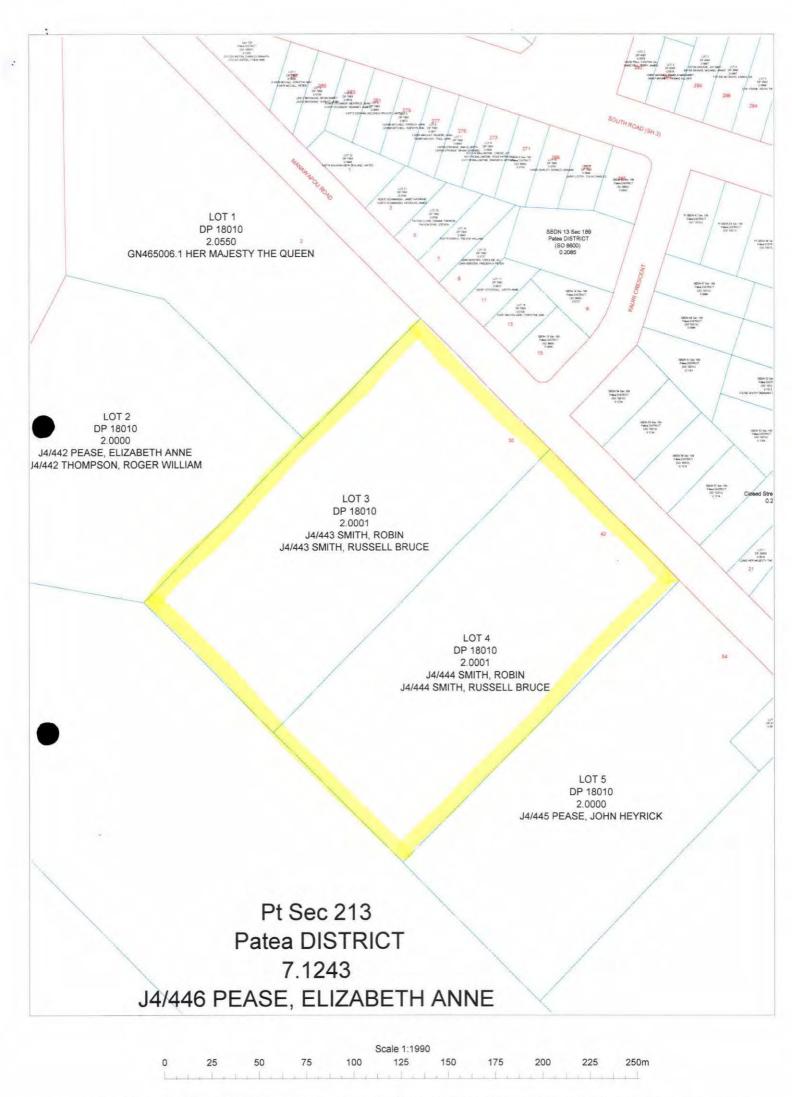

## PROPERTY REPORT

#### INTRODUCTION

The ongoing report assesses the market value of individual allotments assuming all services are installed, separate Certificates of Title are issued and all the requirements for the subdivision, as specified by the South Taranaki District Council, are met.

#### LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed allotments are contained within two Certificates of Title being TNJ4/443 and TNJ4/444 with a total area of 3.4558 hectares and being Lot 4 DP 18010 and Lots 1, 2 and 4 DP 334063.

The attached subdivisional scheme plan indicates the proposed residential allotments and we have adopted this configuration and lot sizes in respect of this report.

#### **ZONING**

The zoning for the proposed allotments is Residential and the Resource Management Plan is South Taranaki District.

#### **GENERAL**

The property is located on the south-western periphery of Hawera to the south of the sealed, dual carriageway of Manawapou Road. Residential development in the immediate vicinity is of mixed quality ranging from superior and including farmlets through to plainer homes of the 1950s and 1960s era. Rural land adjoins the subject to the south and private school grounds adjoin to the north west. Resale potential in the immediate vicinity is considered to be above-average relative to other parts of Hawera. All district amenities and services are provided along Manawapou Road.

#### Performance Standards - Access

#### **APPLICATION**

The applicant, Glyn Hogg is proposing to subdivide the property at 40 Manawapou Road, Hawera (land legally described as Lot 4 DP 18010 and Lots 1,2 and 4 DP 334063), into Lot 1 of 3097 square metres, Lot 2 of 1990 square metres, Lot 3 of 2458 square metres, Lot 4 of 2977 square metres, Lot 5 of 986 square metres, Lot 6 of 1431 square metres, Lot 7 of 1616 square metres, Lots 8,9 and 10 of 818 square metres, Lot 11 of 804 square metres, Lot 12 of 839 square metres, Lot 13 of 922 square metres, Lot 14 of 856 square metres, Lot 15 of 1194 square metres, Lot 16 of 812 square metres, Lot 17 of 813 square metres, Lot 18 of 1045 square metres and Lot 19 (balance land) of 9578 square metres.

The land is in the Residential Zone and the applicant is marketing the subdivision as a residential development. This subdivision is a controlled activity and is subject to the performance standards in the District Plan.

#### **EVALUATION**

The proposed subdivision will create fifteen new lots in the Residential Zone. There are currently dwellings under construction on several of the lots and there are plans for building on several of the remaining lots. Part of the site was the subject of a four lot subdivision earlier in the year.

#### **Utilities and Services**

The District Plan requires all new lots to be connected to the Council's water supply and sewerage system if the services are available. The Council's water supply is available to serve the subdivision. Clive Margetts, the Council's Reticulation Officer has assessed the application and has required that each lot is separately connected to the Council's water supply.

The Council's sewerage system is available to serve the subdivision from Denby Road. The applicant is proposing to build a new sewer to serve the subdivision. The design of the sewer will be sufficient to serve the subdivision and cater for some further subdivision of the surrounding land. The Reticulation Officer has advised that the Council would be prepared to adopt this sewer providing it is constructed to meet Council requirements. Each lot is to be connected into the sewer; the Reticulation Officer has stated that each lot will require a separate connection.

Stormwater for the proposal is to be retained on-site.

#### **Access**

The District Plan requires all lots to have access to a legal and formed road. Lots 1,5,8,9,10 and 11 have access to Manawapou Road. Vincent Lim, the Council's Roading Manager, has assessed the proposal and has advised that each of these lots will require a vehicle crossing to meet the Council's Sealed Urban Property Entrance specifications.

Lots 2-4 and Lot 3 DP 334063 will be served by a 7.1 metre wide right of way. This right of way will have a turning area provided approximately 100 metres in from the road boundary of the property. Lots 6 and 7 will be served by a second right of way 6.5 metres wide. This right of way serves only two lots and does not require a turning area. Lots 12-19 will be served by a third right of way 6.3 metres wide. This right of way will also have a turning area at its end.

The Roading Manager has advised that each of the three rights of way will require a vehicle crossing to meet the Council's Standard Commercial Vehicle Crossing specifications. The Roading Manager has also advised that the rights of way will need to be constructed in accordance with NZS 4404:2004 Land Development and Subdivision Engineering. This will also include stormwater run-off from the rights of way which is to be retained within the rights of way.

The properties frontage to Manawapou Road does not currently have a footpath. The area has a footpath across the road and most of the wider area has footpath. The Roading Manager has requested that the applicant provides a 1.2 metre wide concrete footpath (including a grass berm along the remainder of the properties road frontage) along the full length of the properties frontage to Manawapou Road.

#### **Financial Contributions**

Residential subdivisions attract the payment of financial contributions in the form of Reserve Fund contributions. The Reserve Fund Contribution can be in the form of land as a reserve or can be as a monetary contribution to the Council which will be put toward providing extra reserves in the district. The applicant has not set aside any of the property to form a reserve and therefore a financial contribution is an appropriate option. Council practice has been to take 7.5% of the value of any new lots created.

The subdivision will create fifteen new lots in the Residential Zone. The Council's standard practice has been to take a financial contribution on the lots of lesser value. Hutchins and Dick property consultants and valuers have assessed the application and their report is attached.

Excluding lots 1,3,4 and 19, as the four lots of highest value, the total Reserve Fund Contribution equates to \$60,375. The applicant has a subdivision consent (040029) for a prior subdivision of part of the site. This earlier subdivision attracted a Reserve Fund Contribution of \$22,875. Given that this new subdivision is a re-subdivision of the same property, it is considered inappropriate to require a contribution of the total amount (\$60,375) through this contribution. A solution which is more reasonable to the applicant would be to subtract the amount paid from the previous subdivision from the total required from this subdivision. This would ensure that a Reserve Fund Contribution is not taken twice from any property and would equate to a total contribution of \$37,500.

The effects of this subdivision will not be more than minor. The land being subdivided is zoned Residential, thereby anticipating residential development. The subdivision will enable the land to be used for its intended purpose. The subdivision, subject to conditions, will not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

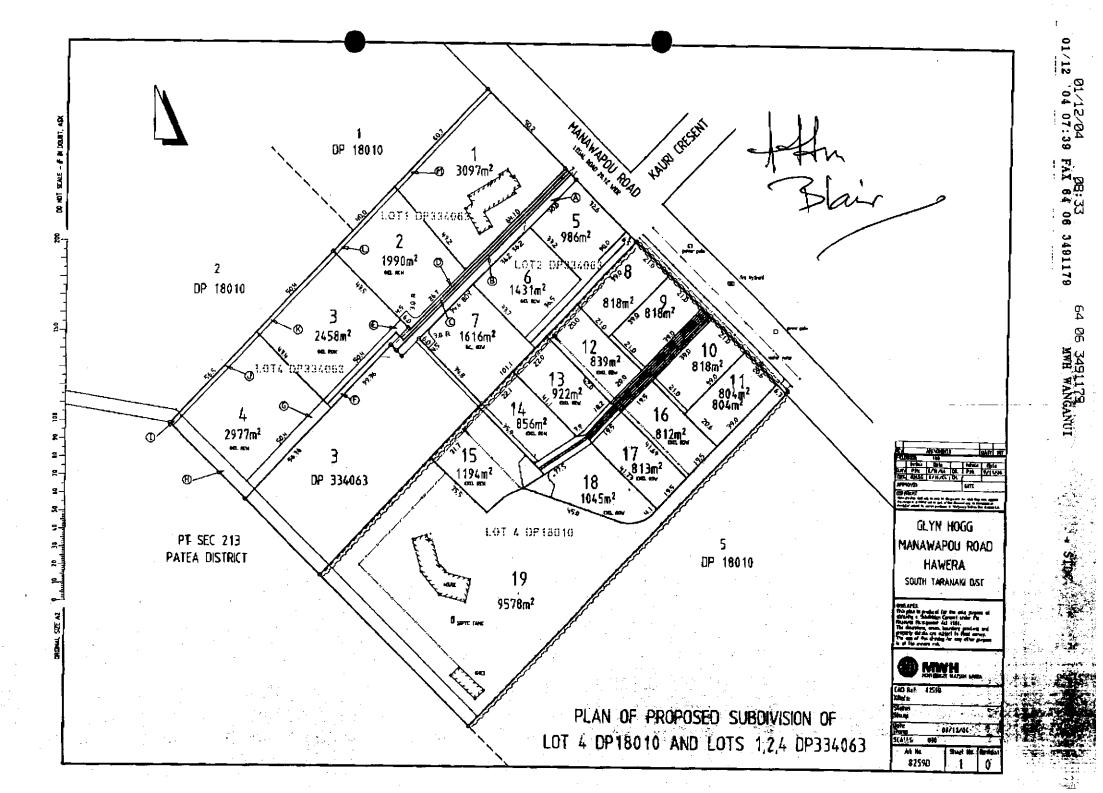

## Glyn Hogg, Manawapou Road

Further to our brief telephone conversation this morning we submit an amended plan of the proposed subdivision of the original stage 1 and the Smith land to the south east.

Glyn has a purchaser for Lot 7 on the amended plan who requires an area of 1400m<sup>2</sup> exclusive of access. We have now revamped that portion of the scheme to provide for three lots, Lot 5 having an area of 986m<sup>2</sup>, Lot 6 having an area of 1431m<sup>2</sup> and Lot 7 having a total area of 1616m<sup>2</sup>. Lots 6 and 7 will be served by a right of way running along the boundary between the original stage 1 and the Smith land. We imagine the services for Lot 7 will continue to be provided up the original right of way, as may be the services for Lot 6. Lot 5 will be serviced from Manawapou Road.

This resubdivision of this area will require an extension of the proposed sewer to allow for the connection of Lot 6. Although this possibly will be handled by a direct connection into the extension of the sewer which will serve Lots 1 and 2.

This plan replaces those previously submitted and the comments within this letter are additional to the application.

Please do not consider that the time you have had the original application, submitted on 18<sup>th</sup> November, is part of the current time we are quite satisfied that this plan and notes should re-start the consent process.

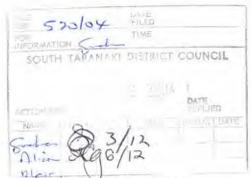

A description of the activity to which the application relates is: 3.

In March 2004 the STDC approved a subdivision consent for Glyn Hogg - ref RM 040029. This was to subdivide Lot 3 DP18010 into 4 lots with the rear two being serviced by a right of way. The survey for this was completed in March 2004 and the plan number is LT334063. The survey plan has not yet deposited and titles issued. Glyn has had the two new homes on Lots 1 and 2 on the market and has succeeded in selling Lot 3.

Comments from prospective purchasers indicate that while they want to live in the area they find the lot sizes too large.

Glyn has now instructed us to prepare a scheme to further subdivide Lots 1, 2 and 4 into 6 lots creating an additional 3 lots from the existing. Following that instruction he made an offer for and has entered into an agreement to purchase the major portion of Mr Russell Smith's land - Lot 4 DP18010 - to the south east. Glyn then instructed us to prepare a combined scheme for both areas.

This is the scheme now submitted.

We will refer to the original subdivision as Stage 1 and the Smith land as Stage 2.

The existing right of way for stage 1 is 7.1m wide and originally served 2 lots. The proposal now is for this right of way to serve 5 lots being Lot 3 DP334063 and Lots 2, 3, 4, and 6 of the new scheme. We consider that the existing right of way is capable of being used in this manner. To



facilitate this increase in traffic we have designed a "T" shaped turning area where the right of way lessens in width to serve Lots 3 and 4.

With the increased number of lots Glyn has accepted that it is not appropriate to continue with septic tanks for effluent disposal and proposes connecting Stage 1 and Stage 2 to the existing Council sewer in Denby Road. The design for this sewer will be such that full allowance will be made to service the adjacent land, Lots 2 and 5 DP18010. In that the provision of this sewer will provide for more than the land under subdivision we ask that the STDC give consideration to making a contribution toward the cost. The design of the sewer will be undertaken by MWH NZ Ltd.

Extensive levels have been taken over both area and we are satisfied that a sewer can be designed to serve all the land.

Stage 2 is the development of the Smith land. The location, size, and existing entrance have conspired against the development of this land using a cul-de-sac as was originally envisaged when the subdivision of the underlying land was designed in 1993.

The development of Stage 2 comprises 5 Lots with direct access to Manawapou Road and 7 Lots with access via a right of way. The right of way in 6.3m wide and includes a turning area adjacent to Lots 14 and 15.

The number of lots served by the right of way is one more than the accepted maximum under the District Plan and given the situation set out above we ask that this be accepted.

The lots in Stage 2 will all be served by the proposed new sewer.

Power, telephone, gas and water are all available to serve the new lots.

MWH will be designing both rights of way.

Having reviewed the conditions imposed on the original subdivision we and Glyn expect similar conditions to be imposed now.

- 4. Further applications for Resource Consent that may be required in relation to this proposal.
- 5. An assessment of any effects that the proposed activity may have on the environment is attached in accordance with Section 88 and the Fourth Schedule of the Act.

The land is appropriately zoned for this use.

Given that the development is now larger that that for which consent has been given there will be a number of additional vehicle movements per day. We estimate these to be in the order of 72 per day. Manawapou Road is well formed and carries a significant number of vehicles but very few of these are in the heave class. The increase in vehicle movements in the localised area should not pose a problem.

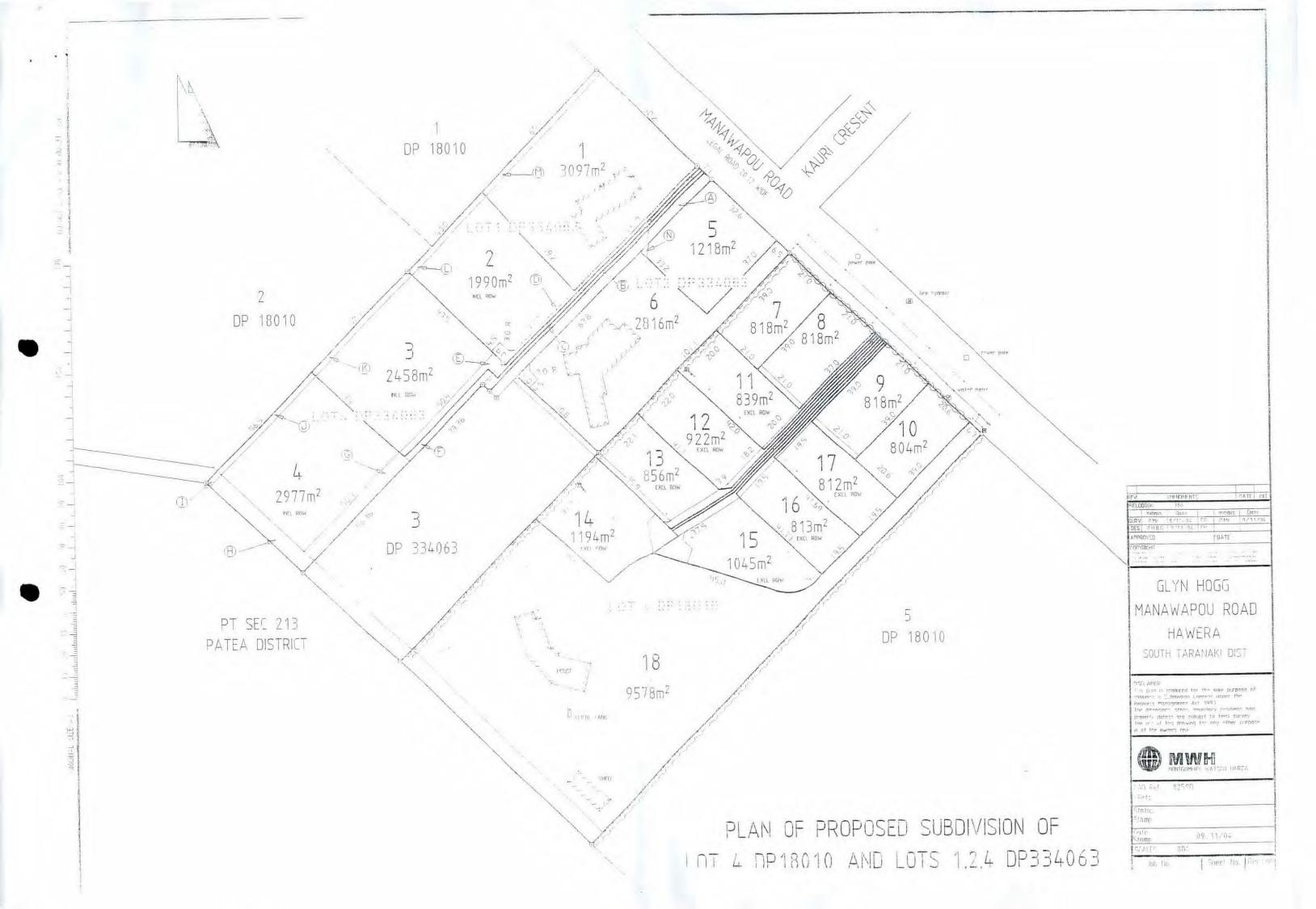

#### **Stormwater**

All stormwater, including that from the ROW's, will be retained on site. Engineering design calculations will be required to show the efficacy of the soak holes for the ROW's.

#### <u>Sewer</u>

It is not likely that the council will make any contribution to the cost of any sewer reticulation system for either Stage 1 or Stage 2 of the proposed development. However, depending on the design of the system, it is possible that the council will assume responsibility for the maintenance of the sewer reticulation pipework. This can be discussed when engineering drawings are available and will be subject to a number of conditions.

#### <u>Water</u>

Each plot will have a separate water supply. As with the sewer reticulation, is possible that the council will assume responsibility for the maintenance of the water reticulation pipework. Again, this can be discussed when engineering drawings are available and as before, will be subject to a number of conditions.

Glyn has had the two new homes on Lots 1 and 2 on the market and has succeeded in selling Lot 3.

Comments from prospective purchasers indicate that while they want to live in the area they find the lot sizes too large.

Glyn has now instructed us to prepare a scheme to further subdivide Lots 1, 2 and 4 into 6 lots creating an additional 3 lots from the existing. Following that instruction he made an offer for and has entered into an agreement to purchase the major portion of Mr Russell Smith's land - Lot 4 DP18010 - to the south east. Glyn then instructed us to prepare a combined scheme for both areas.

This is the scheme now submitted.

We will refer to the original subdivision as Stage 1 and the Smith land as Stage 2.

The existing right of way for stage 1 is 7.1m wide and originally served 2 lots. The proposal now is for this right of way to serve 5 lots being Lot 3 DP334063 and Lots 2, 3, 4, and 6 of the new scheme. We consider that the existing right of way is capable of being used in this manner. To



facilitate this increase in traffic we have designed a "T" shaped turning area where the right of way lessens in width to serve Lots 3 and 4.

With the increased number of lots Glyn has accepted that it is not appropriate to continue with septic tanks for effluent disposal and proposes connecting Stage 1 and Stage 2 to the existing Council sewer in Denby Road. The design for this sewer will be such that full allowance will be made to service the adjacent land, Lots 2 and 5 DP18010. In that the provision of this sewer will provide for more than the land under subdivision we ask that the STDC give consideration to making a contribution toward the cost.
