NOW THE CONDITION of the above written bond is that if the Consent Holder shall duly and punctually observe and perform all and singular the covenants, agreements and stipulations and provisions contained and implied in the schedule of works hereunder and within the times and in the manner therein stated then this Bond shall become void but otherwise shall remain in full force and effect.

That in case of default being made in the performance and observance of the foregoing condition the sum shall be recoverable by the Council from the Consent Holder or the Guarantor as liquidated damages in any Court of competent jurisdiction or at its option it shall be lawful for the Council to arrange for the satisfactory completion of any and all the works detailed in the Schedule by its servants or agents employed by the Council in that behalf, and the Consent Holder shall pay all costs incurred by the Council in so arranging for the completion of those works, and in terms of this Clause the Consent Holder shall be liable for any sums so expended by the Council in excess of the sum bonded and from the date Council incurs any expense in completing such works, interest shall run on such payments made until payment at a rate equivalent to two percent (2%) above the then current overdraft rates as charged to Council by its Bankers from time to time.

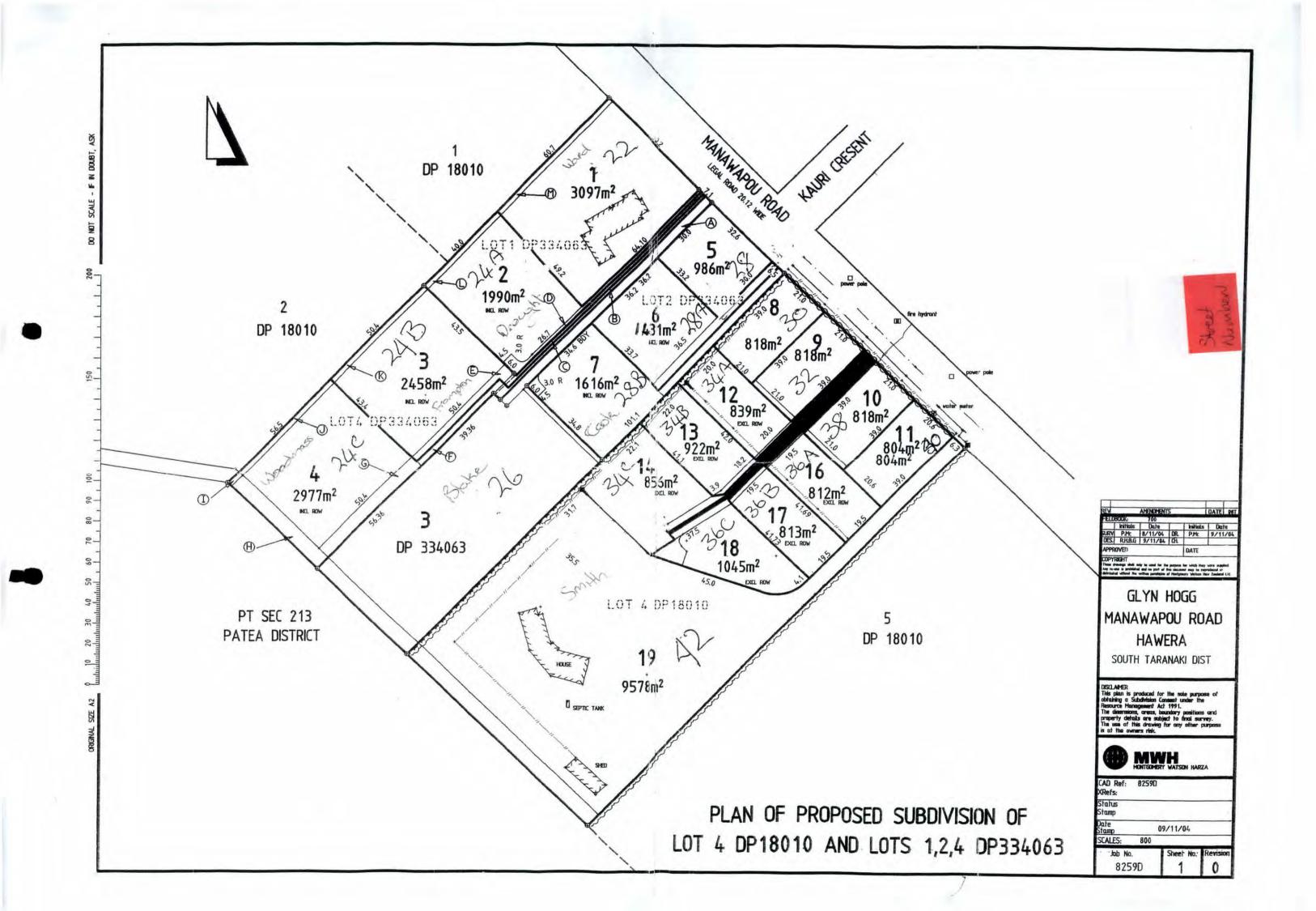

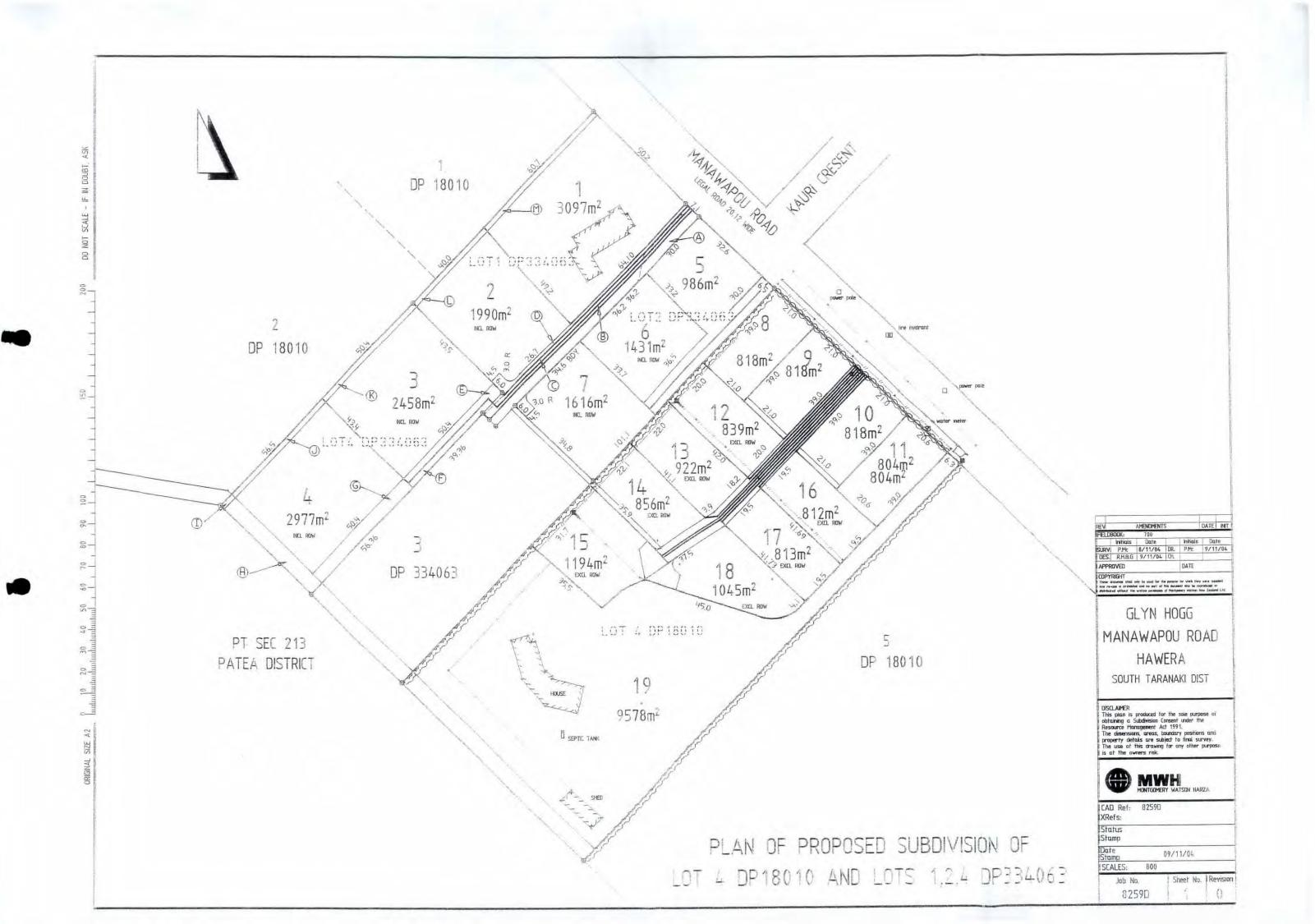
The applicant has entered into a written bond in preference to satisfying some of the conditions of the resource consent held for the subdivision of the property at Manawapou Road, Hawera.

The applicant has entered into a written bond for the sum of \$29,200.00 and has paid a cash deposit of \$2,920.00. This bond applies only to the parts of conditions which apply to the plan being deposited and further action may be required in order to complete the conditions when the final plan is lodged for approval.

The amount for the bond was estimated at \$50 per metre for 96 metres of footpath and grass berm along the road frontage of the development. A rural property entrance to serve Lot 8 was included at \$1,000 and the cost of the sewer was estimated at \$200 per metre and \$2000 per manhole (based on information supplied verbally by Apex Consultants) for a total of 97 metres and 2 manholes.

Construction of pipeline through easement

I refer to your letter recieved on 26th April 2005 concerning the pipeline that has been laid across the easement on your property. I have asked my engineering staff to research this matter and now respond to the points you have raised.

The developer Mr Glen Hogg employed consulting engineers (MWH) to design the pipe line which was then sent to the council for approval. We granted approval for the design subject to certain conditions. Mr Hogg then arranged the construction work through his contractors under the supervision of his engineer.

At the end of the construction developers are required to forward a compliance certificate to the council as proof that the work has been undertaken in accordance with required standards and conditions. The council then checks the work and assumes ownership of the finished network, provided it has been built according to the approved design. The onus is clearly therefore on the developer to design and construct the work and naturally this includes liaision with land owners prior to construction. As our planner Blair Sutherland has explained, in a case like this, the developer has the total responsibility for the project. The pipeline was not laid at Council's instigation or request (contrary to the statement in Mr Hogg's handwritten note) and only becomes a Council asset once it is completed.

Nevertheless after receiving your letter my staff met the developer, Glen Hogg on 29th April to discuss your concerns. We are aware that an onsite meeting took place before the construction started in late February involving Mr Hogg, Trustee Mr Roger Thompson and Mr Richard Moody. It would seem that around that time, various assurances were sought concerning reinstatement and duly recieved. If the work has not been carried out to your satisfaction, I can omly suggest you take it up with either Mr Hogg, or your lawyers. It is my understanding however, that Mr Hogg is quite amenable to carrying out further reinstatement to your satisfaction.

Given the circumstances I have outlined, I cannot agree with your assertion that there was "a serious lack of duty by the Council". Nor do I think there are any grounds for an apology for our actions. This is a civil property matter and not one Council should become involved in.

I realise that this reply will not provide you with the result you were seeking from the Council however I trust it probides you with the reasons why we cannot advance this matter on your behalf.

I refer to your letter of 4 February 2005 and the subsequent meeting between Graeme Young (of MWH) and our Engineering staff on 18 February 2005.

At that meeting the planned sewer reticulation for the Hogg Subdivision was discussed in some detail, particularly the changes requested in our Project Engineer's memo of 15 February 2005. These discussions also included determination of the most cost effective means of designing the sewer reticulation to accommodate the possible development of Lot 5 DP 18010 on the eastern side of Hogg Subdivision.

It was agreed that the sewer reticulation be extended between Lots 16 and 17 to the boundary of Lot 5 DP 18010. This was preferable to the proposed route along the western boundary of Lot 19. The effect of this revision is to lower the invert levels of the pipes to achieve the required gradients.

The Council agreed at the meeting to make a contribution towards the extra over costs of the additional excavation required and a similar contribution towards the costs of extending the sewer reticulation between Lots 16 and 17.

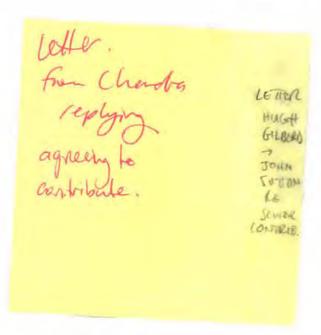

Hogg Subdivision, Manawapou Road and Sewer Drainage

In our planning application for the Hogg Subdivision in Manawapou Road we raised the subject of the provision of the sewer and being able to allow for the connection of adjacent land into the sewer connecting to Denby Road. In our application we said: "With the increased number of lots Glyn has accepted that it is not appropriate to continue with septic tanks for effluent disposal and proposes connecting Stage 1 and Stage 2 to the existing Council sewer in Denby Road. The design for this sewer will be such that full allowance will be made to service the adjacent land, Lots 2 and 5 DP18010. In that the provision of this sewer will provide for more than the land under subdivision we ask that the STDC give consideration to making a contribution toward the cost. The design of the sewer will be undertaken by MWH NZ Ltd." To date no one from the District Council has come back to us or raised this question in the Conditions of Consent.

It is of considerable importance to Glyn Hogg that this matter is addressed as he will need to make provision for the increase in the depth of the sewer to allow for the servicing of adjacent land at some stage in the future. We suspect that there will be a difference of approximately 1m in required excavation. This is significant.

The original subdivision of DP 18010 provided for an easement along its south boundary to allow for the future development of all lots.

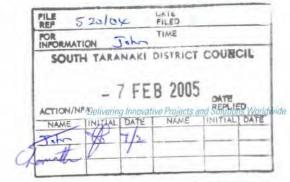
We submit that the time is now right for the South Taranaki District Council to give careful consideration to joining with Glyn Hogg and paying part of the cost of his reticulation to allow for the future development of the eastern lot of DP 18010.
