DISTRICT PLAN REQUIREMENTS

SECTION 8: SUBDIVISION

8.01.2 Controlled Activities

(c) Subdivision that fully complies with the performance standards set out or referred to in Section 8.02 and is not listed in Sections 8.01.3, 8.01.4 and/or 8.01.5.

8.02 Performance Standards

8.02.1 Utilities and Services

- Where public water, sewerage and/or drainage services are not available within 200 metres
 of a proposed subdivision, all lots shall be self-sufficient in terms of water supply, drainage
 and effluent disposal. Sufficient regard to suitability in respect of topography, soils, water
 tables and proximity to water bodies must be demonstrated.
- 3. In residential, commercial and industrial zones, and in other zones where power lines, gas distribution pipes and communication lines are available within 200 metres of any boundary of any lot of a proposed subdivision, the services, where installed, shall be provided underground to the subdivided land.
- 4. At the time of subdivision sufficient land for transformers and associated ancillary services shall be set aside.
- 5. All necessary easements for the protection of utilities and services to the lot(s) shall be provided by the subdivider, and duly granted and reserved.
- 6. NZS 4404:2004 Land Development and Subdivision Engineering shall be complied with where necessary.

8.02.2 Vehicle Access

- 1. All lots shall provide vehicle access, in accordance with the Council's vehicle crossing standards (set out in Appendix VI), to a formed legal road.
- 2. NZS 4404:2004 Land Development and Subdivision Engineering shall be complied with, including (where necessary) the requirements for upgrading and/or forming vehicle crossings, roads and rights-of-way in all zones.

SECTION 3:RURAL ZONE

3.01.4 DISCRETIONARY ACTIVITIES

(g) Any activity, other than an activity listed in Section 3.01.5 below, which cannot meet the performance standards set out or referred to in Section 3.02 or 3.03 below and which has not been granted a resource consent as a Controlled or Limited Discretionary Activity.

3.02 PERFORMANCE STANDARDS - PERMITTED ACTIVITIES

3.02.1 Bulk and Location

- 5. Other buildings (other than dwelling units, buildings used for intensive farming and industrial buildings) shall be a minimum of 10 metres from any site boundary adjoining a public road and 5 metres from any other site boundary.
- 8. No part of any building, other than a dwelling or a stock loading and unloading facility, may extend above the natural ground level at the nearest site boundary more than the horizontal distance between that part of the building being measured and the nearest site boundary.

- (b) Provides adequate independent reticulated or non-reticulated services for each lot.

(b) Protection and enhancement of the rural character and amenity values and access to fresh air, open space and privacy.

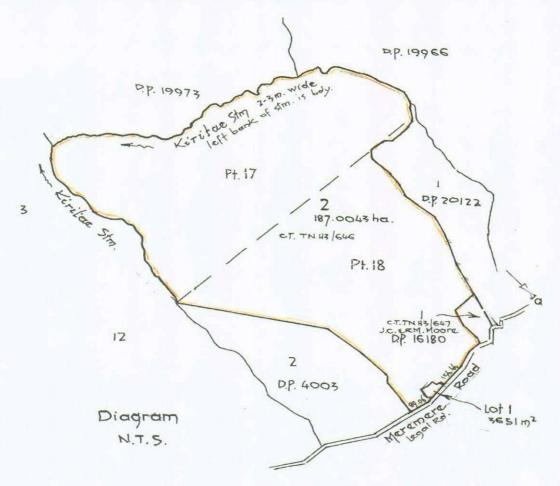
2.03.2 POLICIES

- (a) Within the framework of sustainable resource management the Council will:
 - (i) Provide for flexibility in the use, development and subdivision of land while maintaining amenity values; and ensuring that any adverse effects on the surrounding environment are avoided, remedied or mitigated.

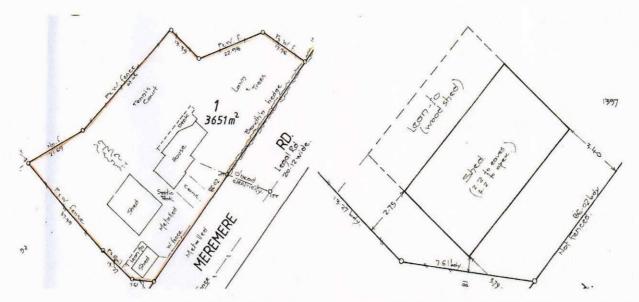
APPLICATION

The applicants, Jeremy and Rachel Moore are proposing to subdivide the property at 1397 Meremere Road, Meremere (Part Sections 17 and 18 Block VIII Hawera Survey District) into two lots being Lot 1 of 3,651 m² and Lot 2 of 187 ha.

The applicants are also requesting yard and height to boundary dispensations for an existing shed in Lot 1 because it would be located 0.81 metres from the south western boundary and would not comply with the five metre boundary setback. The shed would be 2.2 metres high at the proposed south western boundary of Lot 1 and would not comply with the height requirement of the District Plan. The District Plan requires accessory buildings to be no higher than their horizontal distance from the boundary. The shed would comply with all other bulk and location requirements of the District Plan.



The 187.37 ha site is irregular in shape and is located in the Rural Zone. The site abuts the Kiritae Stream to the north and north west. The site topography is flat near the road with some steep slopes in the middle and towards the margin of the stream. The property is currently used for residential and farming purposes.



Proposed Lot 1 would have frontage onto Meremere Road and has an existing dwelling and two sheds. The existing shed at the south western corner of Lot 1 is the building that requires yard and height to boundary dispensations. The other buildings in Lot 1 would comply with all applicable bulk and location requirements of the District Plan.

Proposed Lot 2 would have frontage onto Meremere Road and has existing farm buildings. The existing buildings on Lot 2 would comply with all the applicable bulk and location requirements of the District Plan.

EVALUATION

This application triggers two activity statuses: Discretionary for Land Use (bulk and location non-compliance) and Controlled for the Subdivision.

The Land Use (bulk and location non-compliance) is considered as a Discretionary Activity because the existing shed in proposed Lot 1 cannot fully meet the applicable performance standards of the District Plan. The proposed subdivision is considered a Controlled Activity because it would comply with the applicable performance standards of the District Plan (subject to consent conditions).

Bulk and Location

The District Plan's Objective 2.03.1 (b) and Policy 2.03.2 (a) (i) should be taken into account in considering the yard and height to boundary non-compliance. This Objective and Policy ensure that development is addressed in a manner where adverse environmental effects are avoided, remedied or mitigated. They also ensure that the character and amenity values associated with the rural environment are maintained.

The yard and height to boundary non-compliance could potentially give rise to adverse environmental effects in terms of amenity values, access to open space and shading.

The shed would be visible from Lot 2. The applicants are the landowners of this property and no external parties are considered affected by the proposal in terms of amenity values.

The shed would be positioned sufficiently clear from all other proposed new boundaries. This would ensure that access to open space is maintained.

The area affected by shading is currently a grass paddock and is used for farming purposes. This area would not be built-on subject to the District Plan's applicable yard setback requirements. The applicants are the landowners of this property and no external parties are affected in terms of shading.

It is considered that the proposal would not adversely impact on the rural environment based on the above factors. This is not inconsistent with the District Plan's Objective 2.03.1 (b) and Policy 2.03.2 (a) (i).

Subdivision

In considering the proposed subdivision, the District Plan's Objective 2.07.1(a) should be taken into account. This Objective ensures that subdivision is controlled through a framework of sustainable management that will avoid, remedy or mitigate any adverse effects on the environment.

The proposed subdivision would be a small scale development that would only create two new allotments. The purpose of the proposed subdivision is to acquire new Certificates of Title for each lot to enable the applicants to sell Lot 1 and keep the balance lot. Because there is no proposal to change the existing use (residential and farming) of each lot and because of the above factors, the proposed subdivision would not adversely change the character of the surrounding rural environment.

It is considered that the proposed land area of each lot is large enough to maintain the open nature of the rural environment. This is also consistent with the land area of the adjoining properties.

It is considered that the above factors are consistent with Objective 2.07.1(a) of the District Plan.

The District Plan's Policy 2.07.1 (a) and (b) should also be taken into account in considering the proposed subdivision. This Policy ensures that each lot has access to a formed legal road and has adequate independent reticulated or non-reticulated services.

Utilities and Services

Each lot should be self-sufficient in terms of water supply, drainage and effluent disposal because the Council's reticulated services are not available within 200 metres of a proposed subdivision.

Water Supply

The existing dwelling on Lot 1 is supplied with water from a rain water collection tank. The rain water collection tank is positioned sufficiently clear from the proposed new boundaries. This type of water supply is considered self-sufficient and satisfies the District Plan's water supply requirement.

Proposed Lot 2 has a well which is the source of water for the farm. This is considered self-sufficient and satisfies the District Plan's water supply requirement.

Sewage Disposal

The dwelling on Lot 1 disposes of sewage by septic tank and effluent field system. This system is positioned sufficiently clear from all site boundaries. The proposed land area of Lot 1 is considered large enough to ensure that the septic tank and effluent field system would not give rise to any cross-boundary effects.

A septic tank and effluent field system could dispose of sewage for Lot 2 in the event of future building. This is because Lot 2 has a large enough land area to position this type of sewage disposal sufficiently clear from all site boundaries.

Stormwater Disposal

Proposed Lots 1 and 2 dispose of stormwater by ground absorption. It is considered that Lots 1 and 2 have large enough ground areas to ensure that stormwater disposal does not give rise to any cross-boundary effects.

Vehicle Access

The District Plan's Policy 2.07.2 (a) and performance standards 8.02.2.1 and 8.02.2.2 require all lots to have access to a formed legal road and constructed in accordance with the Council's standard.

Proposed Lot 1 has an existing vehicle crossing. The Council's Development Control Engineer has advised that the vehicle crossing serving Lot 1 should be upgraded to meet the Council's Rural Property Entrance specifications.

Proposed Lot 2 has four existing vehicle crossings. The Development Control Engineer has advised that one of the vehicle crossings serving Lot 2 should be upgraded to meet the Council's Rural Property Entrance specifications.

Part II of the Resource Management Act 1991

The purpose and principles of the Resource Management Act 1991 should also be taken into account in considering this application.

Sections 5 (1) and (2) (c) of the Act promote the sustainable management of natural and physical resources while avoiding, remedying, or mitigating any adverse effects of activities on the environment. It is considered that the yard and height to boundary dispensations would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor because this non-compliance would not affect external parties and the area affected by shading would not be built-on (subject to the District Plan's bulk and location requirements). This is consistent with Sections 5 (1) and (2) (c) of the Act.

Sections 7 (c), (d) and (f) of the Act require the Council to have regard to the maintenance and enhancement of amenity values and qualities of the environment. The proposed subdivision would be a small scale development which would only create two allotments. In addition, there are no proposed changes to the existing residential and farming use of each lot which would ensure that the proposed subdivision would not adversely impact on the adjoining farming community. This is consistent with Sections 7 (c), (d) and (f) of the Act.

There are no known matters of national importance or Treaty of Waitangi issues relevant to this application.

CONCLUSION

This application triggers two activity statuses: Controlled Activity (Subdivision) and Discretionary Activity (Land Use). This is because the proposed subdivision would fully comply with the applicable performance standards of the District Plan (subject to consent conditions). The shed in Lot 1 would not comply with the yard setback and height to boundary requirements of the District Plan in terms of the proposed new south western boundary of Lot 1.

It is considered that the proposed subdivision would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor.

It is considered that the bulk and location non-compliance would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor. There are no external parties affected by this non-compliance.

It is considered that the proposal is consistent with the Objectives and Policies of the District Plan and the purpose and principles of the Resource Management Act 1991.

RECOMMENDATION

<u>THAT</u> consent be granted to Jeremy and Rachel Moore to subdivide the property at 1397 Meremere Road, Meremere (Part Sections 17 and 18 Block VIII Hawera Survey District) into Lot 1 of 3,651 m² and Lot 2 of 187 ha pursuant to Sections 104, 104A and 108 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

<u>THAT</u> consent be granted to Jeremy and Rachel Moore for yard and height to boundary dispensations for a 2.2 metre high shed 0.81 metres from the south western boundary of Lot 1 at 1397 Meremere Road, Meremere (Part Sections 17 and 18 Block VIII Hawera Survey District) pursuant to Sections 104, 104B and 108 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

For the following reasons:

- 1. The subdivision would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor.
- 2. The yard setback and height to boundary non-compliance would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor.
- 3. The proposal is not inconsistent with the Objectives and Policies of the District Plan and Part II of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- 4. There are no external parties considered affected by the proposal.

Subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That Lots 1 and 2 are independent of each other in terms of water supply.
- 2. That Lots 1 and 2 are independent in terms of the disposal of effluent and stormwater and that the provision of these services does not give rise to cross-boundary effects.
- 3. That the vehicle crossing serving Lot 1 is upgraded to meet the Council's Rural Property Entrance specifications.
- 4. That one of the vehicle crossings serving Lot 2 is upgraded to meet the Council's Rural Property Entrance specifications.
- 5. That, where installed, all other services for the subdivision including power lines, gas distribution pipes and communication lines be installed underground.
- 6. That all necessary easements are duly granted and reserved, and shown on the Land Transfer Plan.

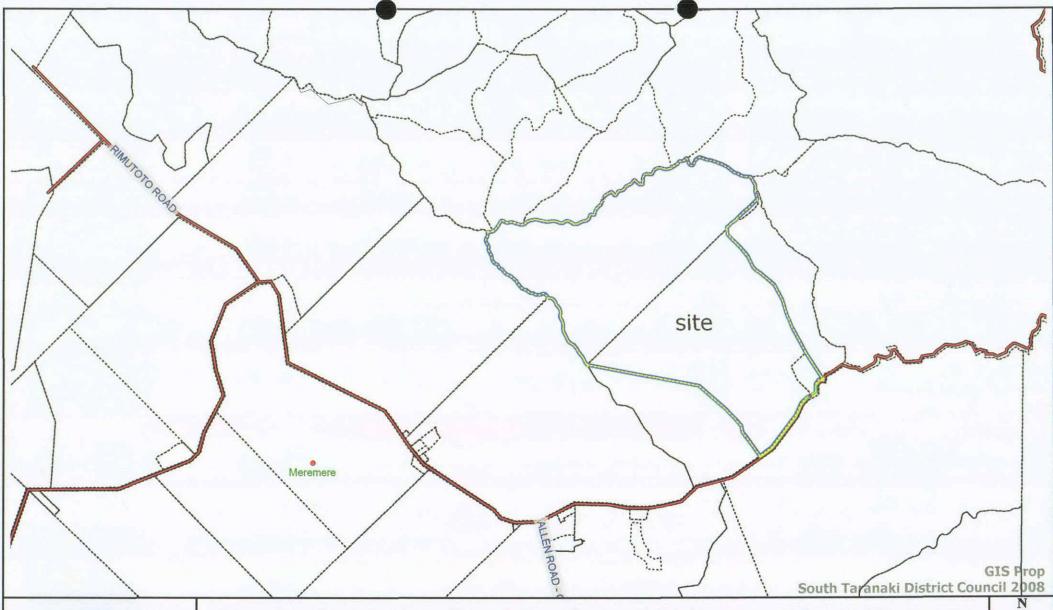

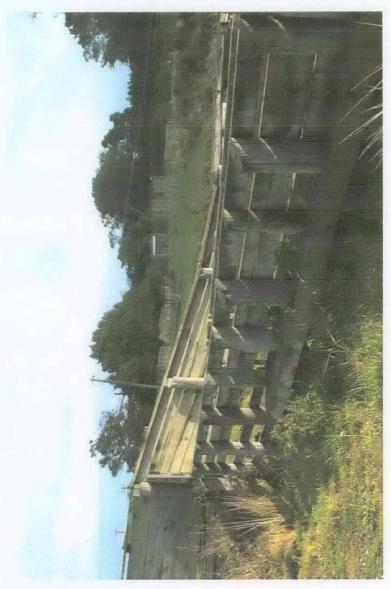

Engineering conditions for J. C. & R. M. Moore's subdivision at 1397 Meremere Road, Meremere of Pts Secs 17 & 18 Block VIII Hawera SD into two lots of 3651m² and 187.0043ha are discussed below:

Water

There is no Council water supply in the area. Water for the house on Lot 1 is supplied from rainwater; water for the farm is sourced from a well. The application states that there are no cross-boundary connections. Thus the existing water supplies for the lots are independent and no water conditions are recommended.

Sewage

There is an existing septic tank serving the house on Lot 1. Lot 2 is farmland and will continue to be farmed. The application states that effluent lines from the septic tank are contained within the proposed boundaries. Thus Lot 1 is self sufficient and without cross-boundary effects in terms of sewage disposal and no sewer conditions are recommended.

Stormwater

Stormwater from both lots shall be disposed of on site without cross-boundary effects.

Access

The vehicle crossing serving Lot 1 comprises unbound sealing chip sized stones from the carriageway to the property boundary and should be upgraded.

There are four entrances to Lot 2 off Meremere Road. The first is immediately west of Lot 1, the second is 125m up from the house entrance, the third is at the stockyard area and the fourth is just before the start of the Meremere track. All of these Lot 2 access are unsealed; the second one would be the most straightforward to upgrade.

All entrances are satisfactory in terms of visibility.

The vehicle crossing serving Lot 1 shall be upgraded to meet the Council's rural property entrance specifications

One of the vehicle crossings serving Lot 2 shall be upgraded to meet the Council's rural property entrance specifications.

Report on Proposed Subdivision of Pts Sections 17& 18 Block VIII Hawera SD – 1397 Meremere Road.

Owners: JC & RM Moore.

Purpose of Subdivision:

The above owners wish to subdivide an area of 3651m², containing an existing dwelling, from their farm on Meremere Road. The intended purchasers are the existing tenants, Mr and Mrs Arnold Landers. Lot I on the attached plan contains the existing house and ancillary sheds. Lot 2 is the balance area.

Legal Description:

The subject area of the proposed subdivision is the land comprised in CT TNH3/646 and is described as Parts of Sections 17 and 18 Block VIII Hawera Survey District. The total area is 187.3694 hectares.

The Site:

Each allotment is independent of the other in respect of the existing sevices. The water supply to the house is rainwater collected and stored in an underground tank. The water supply for the farm is sourced from an on-site well. There are no cross- boundary connections.

The effluent lines from the existing septic tank are contained within the proposed boundaries.

Electricity to the house is conveyed by overhead lines from Meremere Road. Telephone lines are installed underground.

The granting of a dispensation for a Land Use consent may be necessary in respect of the shed located at the south corner of Lot 1. A diagram showing heights and offsets is attached for this purpose. The corner of Lot 1 has been splayed to preserve access to Lot 2 through the adjacent gateway.

District Plan Provisions:

The whole of the property is within the Rural Environment Area.

Assessment of Environmental Effects:

The environmental effects generated by this subdivision should be minimal as the subdivision is simply a consolidation of the existing usage and no additional demands are being placed on the existing infrastructure.

There are no known cultural or heritage issues in the immediate vicinity of the subdivision.

Hawera District Council Building Bylaws

Together with every application there shall be submitted in duplicate detailed plans, elevations, sections, and specifications, accompanied by duplicate locality plans drawn to scale showing the site of the building, together with the land, streets, and buildings, immediately surrounding the site.

NOTE:

- 1. All floor plans should the extent of the soffit line (or overhang of roof) in broken lines.
- 2. All distances from boundaries shown on site plan must be from the soffit line to the boundry NOT from the foundations or walls.

In addition, for buildings for which parking of vehicles is required under the Council's District Scheme there shall be submitted a parking plan to scale showing the required number of off - street parking spaces in accordance with the requirements.

All plans must be signed by the Architect, or Designer responsible for their production.

NOTE: Any receipt is not a permit.

FEES AND DEPOSITS: N.Z.S.S. 1900 Chapter 2.

Every applicant for a permit under this Bylaw shall, before the issue of a permit, pay to the Council the following fees and deposit:—

- (i) fees for building permit, including sewer, stormwater and water charges;
- (ii) fees for any plumbing and drainage permit;
- (iii) deposit for possible damage to streets, footpaths, or other services during the building operations. The amount of such deposit shall be fixed by resolution of Council from time to time.
- (iv) Hoardings.
- (v) Vehicle Crossing fees where applicable.

No permit in respect of the work or any part of the work shall be issued until all the said amounts have been paid.

DRAINAGE AND PLUMBING REGULATIONS:

Every application for sanitary plumbing and drainage work including all stormwater drainage shall be accompanied by a block plan or alternatively the plan may be incorporated on the site and building plan submitted.

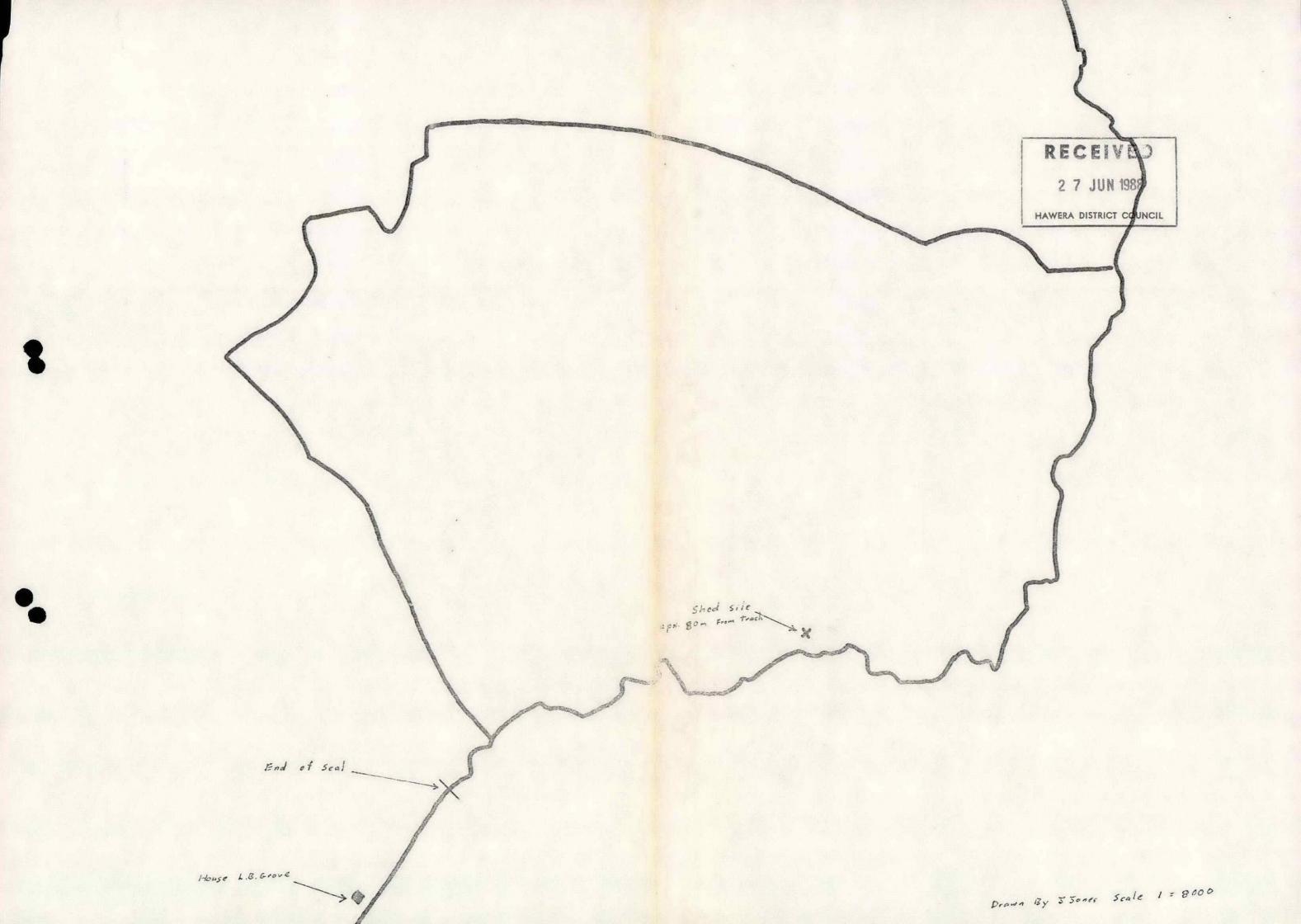
Where any building is of two storeys or more, the plumbing layout shall be shown by a diagramatic elevation.

In assessing the estimated cost of drainage works, all stormwater drainage must be included.

Subdivision Consent Application - 1397 Meremere Road, Meremere

Your application was considered by the Planning Manager under delegated authority on 8 May 2009 and she has resolved as follows:

THAT consent be granted to Jeremy and Rachel Moore to subdivide the property at 1397 Meremere Road, Meremere (Part Sections 17 and 18 Block VIII Hawera Survey District) into Lot 1 of 3,651 m² and Lot 2 of 187 ha pursuant to Sections 104, 104A and 108 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

<u>THAT</u> consent be granted to Jeremy and Rachel Moore for yard and height to boundary dispensations for a 2.2 metre high shed 0.81 metres from the south western boundary of Lot 1 at 1397 Meremere Road, Meremere (Part Sections 17 and 18 Block VIII Hawera Survey District) pursuant to Sections 104, 104B and 108 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

For the following reasons:

- 1. The subdivision would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor.
- 2. The yard setback and height to boundary non-compliance would not give rise to any adverse environmental effects that are more than minor.
- 3. The proposal is not inconsistent with the Objectives and Policies of the District Plan and Part II of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- 4. There are no external parties considered affected by the proposal.

Subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That Lots 1 and 2 are independent of each other in terms of water supply.
- 2. That Lots 1 and 2 are independent in terms of the disposal of effluent and stormwater and that the provision of these services does not give rise to cross-boundary effects.

- 3. That the vehicle crossing serving Lot 1 is upgraded to meet the Council's Rural Property Entrance specifications.
- 4. That one of the vehicle crossings serving Lot 2 is upgraded to meet the Council's Rural Property Entrance specifications.
- 5. That, where installed, all other services for the subdivision including power lines, gas distribution pipes and communication lines be installed underground.
- 6. That all necessary easements are duly granted and reserved, and shown on the Land Transfer Plan.

Council draws your attention to the rights of objection to which this Consent is subject, as set out in Section 357 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

Enclosed is an invoice for the costs associated with processing this Consent. Also enclosed is information relating to the requirement to protect archaeological sites. Any future development on the subdivided land should be sensitive to the protection of archaeological sites.

Please note, subdivision consent does not imply or guarantee consent in respect of future development on (or use of) the sites.
