The above Toka Tū Ake EQC claim was paid out. If you require sign off or repair completion documents, they may be obtainable from the contractors who completed the substantive repairs at the property.

In accordance with the provisions of section 31A of the Earthquake Commission Act, I have included Toka Tū Ake EQC documentation relating to the assessments and repairs carried out at the property, which contains information held on unassigned claim numbers.
