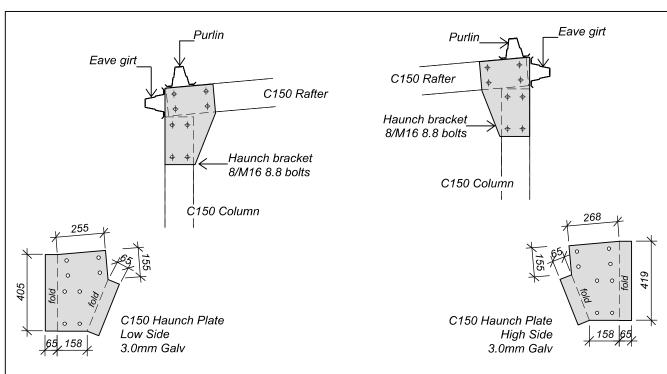
#### **CONCRETE NOTES:**

- 1. All construction detailing shall comply with NZS 3604:2011, unless modified within the structural drawings.
- 2. Foundation Soil is assumed to have an ultimate geotechnical bearing pressure of 300kPa (allowable bearing pressure of 100kPa) in accordance with NZS 3604 definition for 'good ground.' The builder is to notify the engineer if it is suspected that the ground beneath foundations will not achieve 300kPa ultimate bearing pressure.
- 3. Consolidate the base of all excavations for foundations by compacting plate, rollers or other appropriate methods
- 4. Any fill material shall be fit for purpose, placed and compacted in layers of no greater than 150mm to a maximum fill depth of 600mm
- 5. All concrete and workmanship shall comply with, NZS 3109 concrete
- 6. Concrete shall have a minimum 28 day strength of 20MPa unless the site is within a seaspray zone where 25MPa concrete strength shall be adopted. For 150mm slabs a minimum of 30MPa shall be adopted. Higher strength concrete may be required for industrial and commercial use buildings, refer to the engineer.
- 7. Reinforcing bars are denoted by the following:-
- -D grade 300E, Deformed bar
- -H grade 500E. Deformed bar
- -R grade 300E, Plain bar
- -HR -grade 500E, Plain bar
- Reinforcing cover shall be as follows:
- Concrete Cast against natural ground 75mm
- Concrete Cast against formwork in ground or against DPM 50mm
- Internal cover for bars & mesh for
  - T = 100mm, provide 30mm cover
  - T = 125mm, provide 50mm cover
  - T = 150mm, provide 55mm cover
  - T = 200mm, provide 75mm cover
- 9. Reinforcing and mesh shall be supported on plastic 'chairs' or 'spacers' to maintain the required cover.
- 10. Slabs shall be reinforced using 500e mesh as follows:
- 100mm Slabs 2.27kg/m² SE62 mesh or equivalent
- 125mm Slabs 2.50kg/m² SE72 mesh or equivalent
- 150mm Slabs 3.21kg/m² SE82 mesh or equivalent
- 11. DPM shall consist of a single layer of polyethylene not less than 0.25mm thick. Lap joints shall be not less than 150mm wide, sealed with pressure sensitive plastic tape not less than 50mm wide
- 12. Floors shall have a minimum slab thickness of 100mm
- 13. Curing of the concrete slab must take place immediately after finishing the slab by ponding or continuous sprinkling of water for a minimum period of 7days. Buildings may be constructed on the slab within 7 days with due care not to overtighten fixing anchors.
- 14. Shrinkage control joints, free joints, construction joints and saw cuts shall be located as shown on the drawings.
- 15. Sawcuts are to coincide with major changes of plan and placed at a maximimum spacing of 6m. Sawcuts shall be placed to create slab panels with length:width ratios of no greater than 2:1. Sawcuts are to be made no later than 24 hours following the slab pour. Sawcuts shall be 5mm wide x 0.25 slab thickness unless noted otherwise.
- 16. A free joint (or use of a propriety dowel joint system) shall be provided at a maximum of 24m spacing.

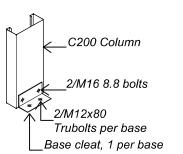




LOW SIDE HAUNCH BRACKET AND CONNECTION (Detail 01)



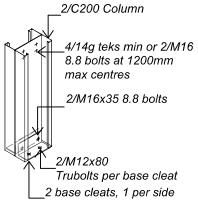

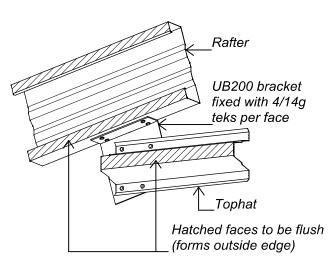
SINGLE C-SECTION - LAPPED TOPHAT (Detail 03)



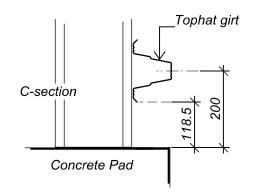

Apply a band of Chem-Bar 3500 at 75um DFT (a good brushed or rolled coat) direct on to the galvanized coating after a degrease and light sand (refer to specification). The band of Chem-Bar 3500 shall extend a minimum of 50mm above and 100mm below the concrete interface for any exposed Embedded Column surface. Seal around the exposed Embedded Column / concrete interface with mastic sealant. Slope Concrete surface away from steelwork, wherever possible.

NOTE: Any damage to the galvanized coating shall be spot primed with Carbozinc 858 prior

to coating with Chem~Bar 3500 (refer to specification for surface preparation).

#### Additional Coating for Column / Concrete Interface (External).

(Refer to Altex Coatings Limited Specification)

Apply to the underside and edges of steel plate with Chem~Bar 3500 at 75um DFT (a good brushed or rolled coat) direct on to the galvanized coating after a degrease and light sand (refer to specification). The Chem~Bar 3500 shall extend a minimum of 100mm in from the edges to the top face of the plate. Chamfer and place mastic bead when interface between steel and concrete is clearly visible.

NOTE: Any damage to the galvanized coating shall be spot primed with Carbozinc 858 prior to coating with Chem~Bar 3500 (refer to specification for surface preparation).

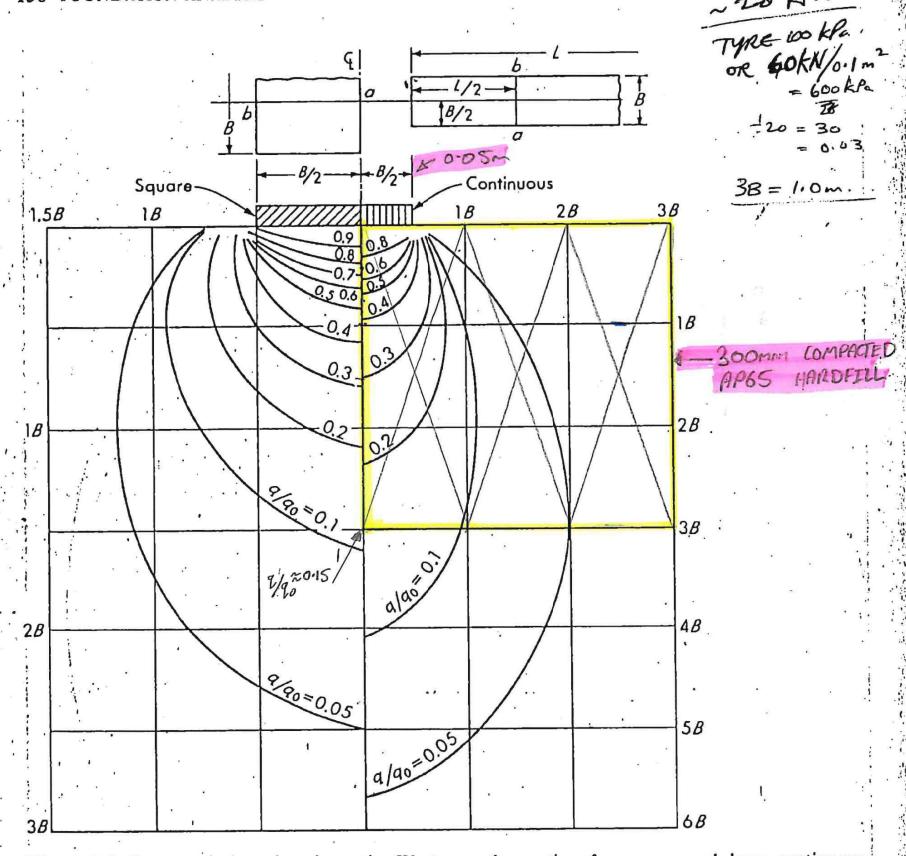


Figure 5-6. Pressure isobars based on the Westergaard equation for square and long continuous footings of dimension  $B \times B$  or  $B \times L$ . Values for the continuous footings are at the point L/2 from the end. Chart contructed from Fig. 5-5 ( $\mu = 0$ ). Applicable along line ab as shown.

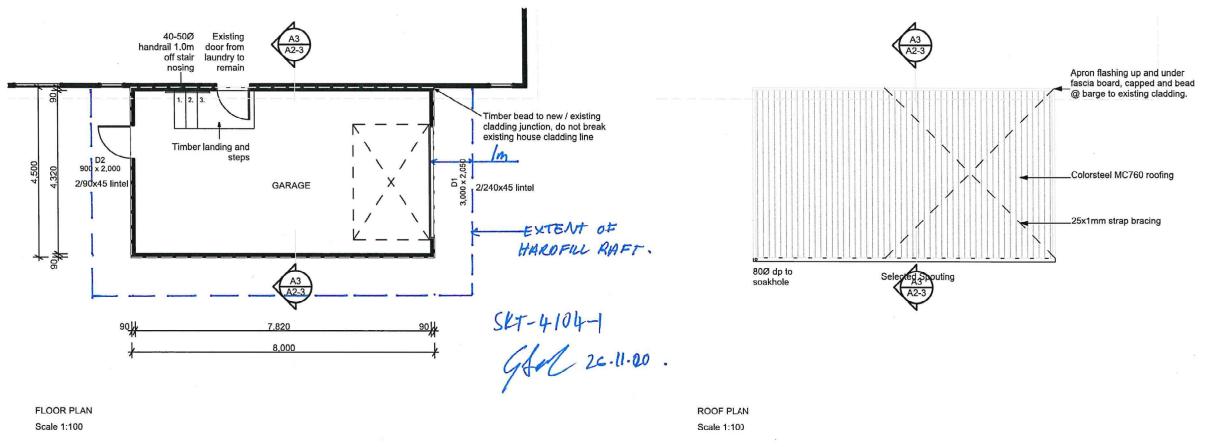

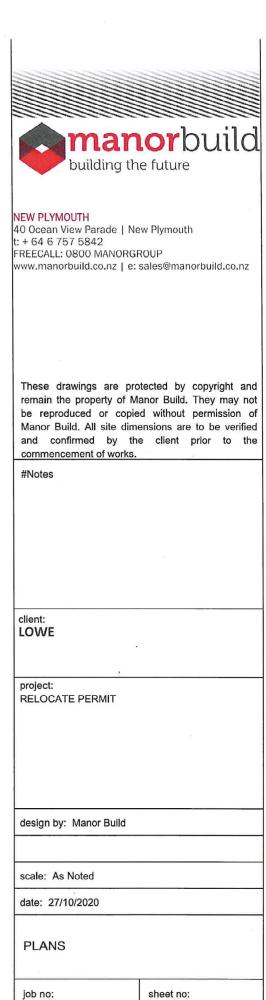




BRACING PLAN Scale 1:100 ROOF FRAMING PLAN Scale 1:100

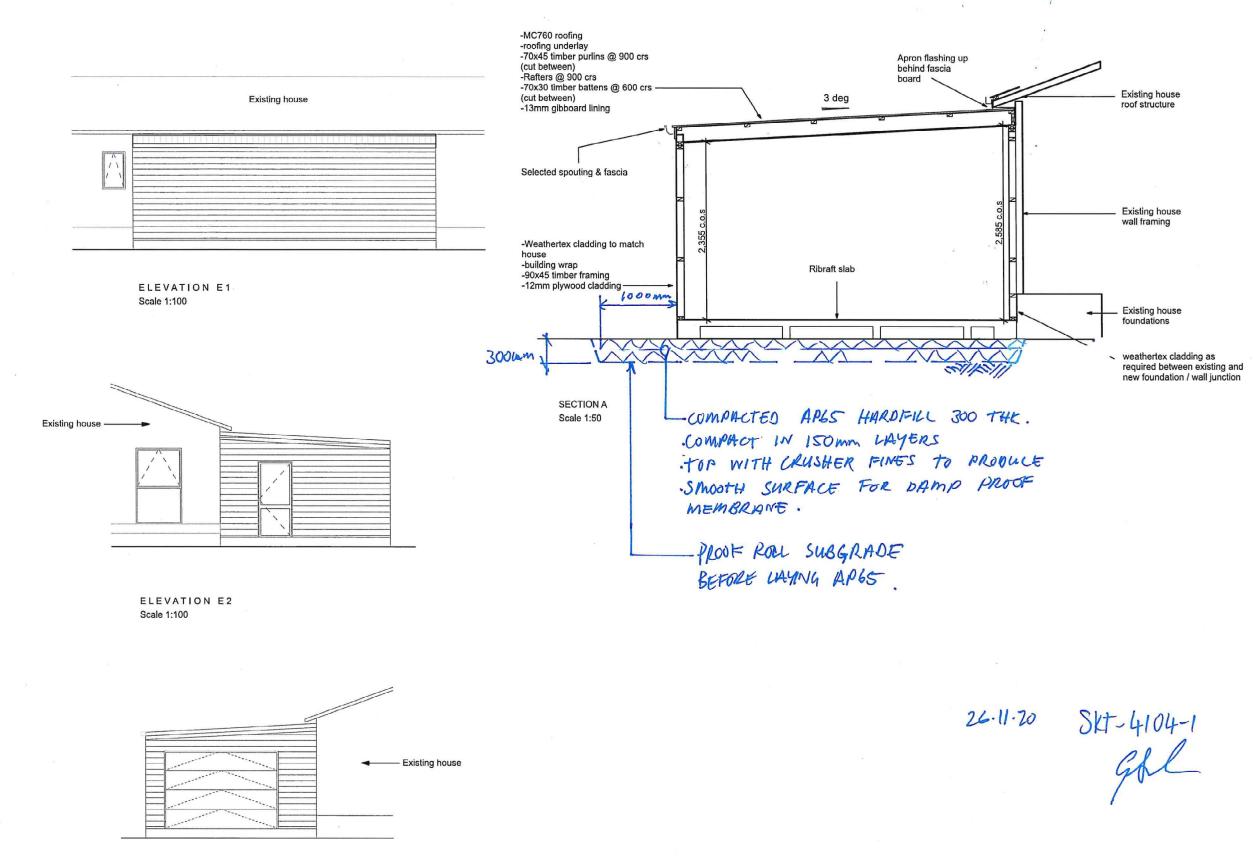

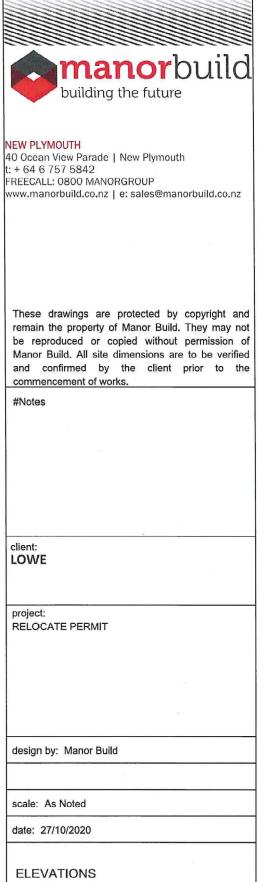
