This land payment represents EQC's calculation of the full amount due for your land damage under the claim number/s listed earlier in this letter.

In settling land claims, EQC pays the value of your damaged land at the time of the earthquake, or the repair cost, whichever is lower.

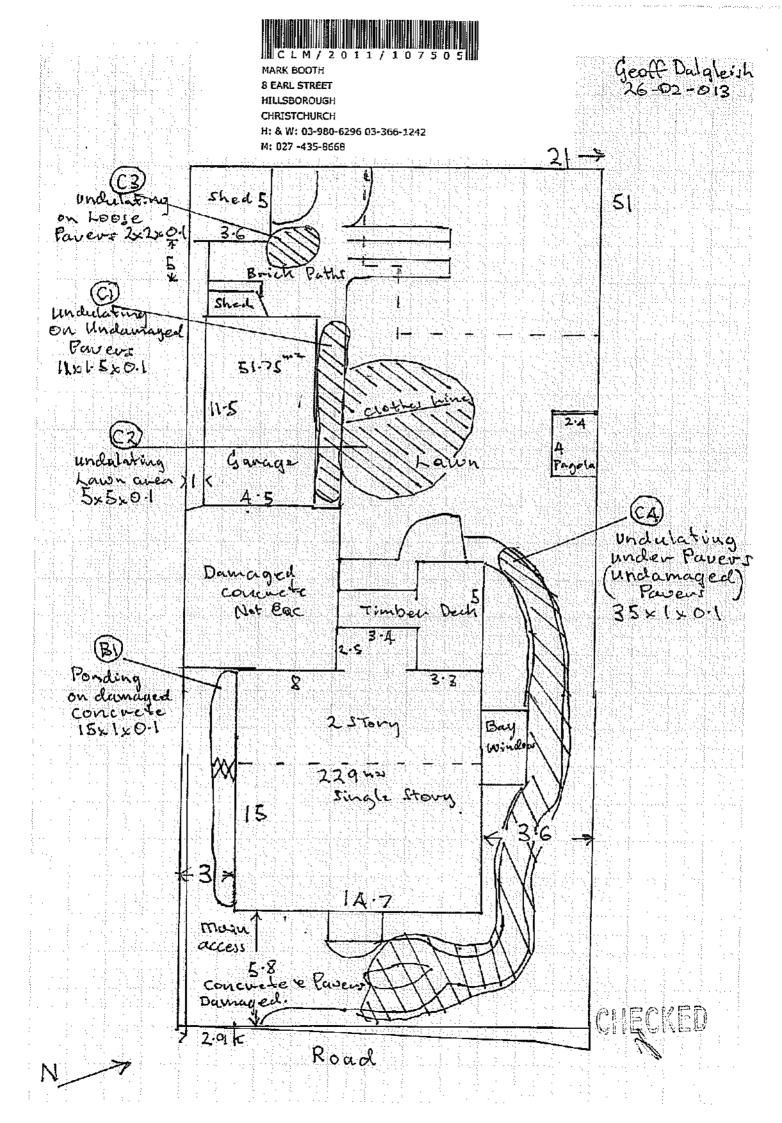
