- Development shall be positioned within the Building Area Generally Suitable for Residential Development following NZS3604:1999, or Area Subject to Specific Engineering Design depicted on Nelson Consulting Engineers plan – Geotechnical Certificate Plan, Job No. 07152, dated 31 March 2009.
- 2. The Building Area Generally Suitable for Residential Development following NZS3604:1999 is expected to be suitable for structures in regards to NZS:3604:1999 Timber framed Buildings, however this will be dependent on the specific footprint and position of the dwelling, and the gradient of the slope to be built upon. Structures outside the limits of NZS:3604 such as larger dwellings built on steeper slopes and buildings founded on poles, will require specific foundation engineering.
- 3. The Area Subject to Specific Engineering Design is subject to specific investigation, design and inspection by a suitably qualified Chartered Professional Engineer practising in civil or geotechnical engineering, due to potential local stability concerns.
- 4. Retaining walls should be designed and inspected during construction by a Chartered Professional Engineer practising in civil, structural or geotechnical engineering when:
  - a) the wall is 1.2 m in height or greater,
  - b) the wall is retaining ground supporting surcharge loads such as buildings,
  - c) the wall retains non-level slopes of over 1V:5H (20%), or
  - d) the wall is founded on sloping ground of over 1V:5H (20%)
- 5. All retaining walls shall include provision for an adequate, appropriate and maintainable groundwater drainage system behind the wall. Surface stormwater shall not be directed into this system.
- 6. Foundations for all buildings, including concrete slab-on-ground floors, shall extend through topsoil to bear in competent natural ground or fill certified in accordance with NZS 4431: 1989. Alternatively, concrete slab-on-ground floors meeting the provisions of NZS 3604: 1999 Timber Framed Buildings, may be founded on granular fill up to 600mm thick placed over competent natural ground in the manner specified as per Clause 7.5.3.1 of that Standard.

- 7. Where structures comply with NZS:3604 all foundation excavations shall be inspected by a building inspector, or otherwise, a charted Professional Engineer practising in civil, structural or geotechnical engineering, prior to placing formwork, poles, DPM or reinforcing steel,
- 8. All earthworks and ground shaping shall be constructed to prevent ponding and provide a positive gradient away from foundation elements.
- 9. The location of subsoil drains installed during the construction of stage 1 and 2 of the subdivision are shown on the Jones and Associates Limited Subsoil Drainage drawing, dated October 2005, appended to the Tonkin and Taylor Earthworks and Building Site Certification Report dated February 2006. The invert levels vary and are not exactly known, however we expect all sub-soil drains to be at least 1.8m below finished ground level and beyond the influence of typical dwelling foundations. Any proposed foundations in excess of 800mm depth below existing ground level, and within 1m or over horizontal of existing subsoil drain locations should be reviewed by a suitably qualified Chartered Professional Engineer practising in civil or geotechnical engineering.
- 10. All seepages encountered in any excavations or during site development must be conveyed away from the building sites in controlled manner,

# IT SHOULD BE NOTED:

- 16. Not to use any pre-used building materials in the construction of any buildings or fencing on the Lot without the prior written approval of the Grantor.
- 17. Not erect any fence constructed of post and wire or iron irrespective of profile whether painted, factory prefinished or otherwise. No fence shall be greater than 1.83m in height and second-hand materials shall not be used without first obtaining the written consent of the Grantor. # 1. Height Restrictions on Lots 26, 27, 28, 32 and 33

The registered proprietor of any Servient Lot [being Lots 26, 27, 28, 32 and 33] will not at any time hereafter erect or permit to be erected any dwelling, building, mast, aerial or other structure of any nature whatsoever on the Servient Lot to a height exceeding 5 metres above ground level.
