Thank you for contacting us about the sale of your property at **126 Halswell Junction Road**. We understand that moving house can be stressful which is why we have a dedicated team here to support you through the process

As promised please find attached original SolarZero agreement, draft transfer agreement and some clauses you may want to use in your sale and purchase agreement.

Transferring the agreement

As we discussed when transferring your agreement, the new owner will take over the remaining term of your contract [till **10/08/2043**]. There are two ways this can be done depending on your preference, either:

- 1.New homeowners take over of the contract and the responsibilities of paying the monthly fee [\$ 153+GST]
- 2.Or you can prepay the remaining term of your contract the prepayment value is approximately [\$23,444.00 inc GST] this cost can be incorporated in the sale price of your property, so it is incurred by the purchaser. As the agreement will be prepaid the new owner will not need to pay the monthly solar fee, only the low-rate grid power when not using solar.

Once you have confirmed who is purchasing your property and you have a settlement date can you please pass this information on so that one of our solar specialists can reach out before sending the transfer agreement for signing.

What if we cannot transfer the agreement?

In the case we are unable to transfer your solar agreement there are costs associated with ending the agreement. I have requested these costs from our team and will provide them to you as soon as possible. (typically between \$15K-\$20K)

Please note: Where removal is required under clause 12.c, we will remove the posts, replace fixings, and waterproof the area of the roof where the Energy Hardware was installed (without repainting). You acknowledge that the roof will not be reinstated to its original condition and may incur minor cosmetic damage on installation and removal. Any reinstatement will primarily be to waterproof the post area on the roof so that the roof is watertight after removal, having regard to its age and condition. Where the battery cabinet requires

removal you will be responsible for any remediation (ie filling holes, plastering, painting) required, unless we cause additional damage to the Property for which we will make good. In addition to any statutory warranties or guarantees that you are entitled to under applicable law, we will warrant the water proofing for 90 days after the Energy Hardware is removed.

Broadband Cancellation

If you have received any promotional product(s) as part of your broadband services, and cancel or novate your broadband services within 5 years from the date we dispatch the promotional product(s) to you, you will be required to refund us such proportion of the cost of the promotional product as is commensurate with the duration of the unexpired portion of that five year period, as notified to you at the time of receiving the promotional product.

On the 23rd of January 2025 the claw back for your Bonus wash machine will be \$759.37

Important details to take note

- Please note that the energy hardware (including solar panels and battery) will still remain the property of SolarZero for the remainder of the term of the Agreement.
- The system is not a chattel of the property and cannot be on sold as it belongs to SolarZero. We have the system registered with the securities website / PPSR, ensuring that SolarZero legally has ownership of the solar system.

As the contract holder with SolarZero you are liable to pay the monthly solar fee until the
account has been transferred or cancelled.

We're going to start by quickly re-capping what the solarZero energy service is all about. In a nutshell - the system installed will deliver cheaper, cleaner energy from your own roof. Excess energy is stored in the smart battery to access at night or in a power cut.




It's cheaper because there are \$0 upfront costs to install solar panels and a smart battery. You also get access to price protected rates from our grid partners. Plus we guarantee you will save from year one.



It's cleaner because you'll be powering your home with solar energy, reducing your carbon footprint and living more sustainably.



It's smarter because of the intelligent smart battery system, which manages and stores your household energy, even when the sun isn't shining. When there is a power cut you can access the back up energy to keep the lights on.





How our solarZero energy service works

Our system will deliver cheaper, cleaner, smarter energy straight from the solarZero panels to your home and smart battery. This is your key to a more energy efficient home.

The image above outlines how the solarZero system works, what equipment comes with it and how to get the most out of it.

- 1. The solarZero smart battery helps you store and manage your household's energy. It also provides backup power during a power cut, so you won't be left in the dark.
- 2. You have access to a dedicated solarZero support team who work with you to answer any questions, provide technical support and help reduce your overall energy costs. They'll also supply you with regular updates to maximise your solar energy use.

3. Our solarZero monitoring

(which you can log in to on your smartphone, tablet or computer) allows you to remotely monitor your home's energy use and solar energy generation. Plus, we also monitor the system for you to make sure everything is operating as it should.

4. As part of the solarZero system installation we wire your hot water cylinder, so that in the future you'll have the option to have it switched on or off with our solarZero monitoring.

The monitoring service will control the schedule so it operates at the optimum hours that best suit your usage.

- 5. solarZero owns and manages the solarZero system, and are responsible for the installation of the solar panels to your roof, the smart battery, and technology to run the system. That means there's no upfront costs to you for the technology or the system hardware.
- 6. As promised, we'll manage the system for you for 20 years at no additional cost. This includes repairs and necessary upgrades.
- 7. solarZero gives you members only access to grid power with a price protection rate for any excess grid energy (plus lines and network charges and GST). With solarZero's energy service, you also get:
- Enhancements and upgrades that improve your system over time.
- Add on broadband at a competitive price to accelerate your savings.
- Exclusive rewards and members only benefits including access to special pricing for a curated range of energy efficient appliances in the solarZero Store.





As well as storing excess energy generated from solar panels, It will also charge up during the night or when electricity is cheap.

When the sun in shining, it will charge up from any excess solar you produce during the day, and top up from the grid if required in the afternoon ready for the evening peak.

It will discharge to you on demand during the evening peak, again minimising the electricity you need to buy during that peak period.

Note: solarZero will take care of the scheduling of your smart battery. We have taken into account pricing and use at different times of the day to devise a schedule which maximises the savings our smart battery makes for you.

During a power cut.

If there is a grid power outage, you might notice all of the power to your home go out. A second later, any circuits connected to your smart battery will come back on (provided there is charge remaining in the smart battery). We ensure that there is 10% charge in the battery as standard.

If your smart battery has charge remaining, these circuits will remain live until there is no charge remaining. You can check the state of charge through the solarZero monitoring. During the day, the solar panels will be able to charge your smart battery.

It is wise to switch off anything you don't absolutely need on at this point in order to maximise the time remaining for things you do need.

In a powercut, if you try to draw too much power, anything that draws over 3kW at once, will cause the smart battery to shut off.

If this happens you should switch off these devices and wait for the smart battery to switch back on. A great tip is to make sure your kettle and toaster are turned off during a power cut.





Key solarZero benefits to market
