- 3. <u>With respect to Lots 2-5, 7 and 8:</u> A firefighting water supply shall be provided in accordance with the New Zealand Fire Service Firefighting Water Supplies Code of Practice SNZ PAS 4509:2008.

4. <u>With respect to Lots 2-5, 7 and 8:</u> Onsite wastewater treatment and disposal shall be provided in general accordance with the findings, recommendations and constraints contained within the *Engineering Investigation for 10 Lot Subdivision for Nick Gawler. 317-319 Te Horo Beach Road, Te Horo* prepared by Landlink Ltd and dated 18 December 2019, submitted to Council in relation to application no. RM190267.

It shall be the ongoing responsibility of the owner to maintain and monitor their wastewater disposal so that any adverse effects on the environment are less than minor.

5. With respect to Lots 2-8: Onsite stormwater disposal shall be provided and shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the principles contained in Part 3 Section E of the Kapiti Coast District Council Subdivision and Development Principles and Requirements 2012 and shall take into account the findings and recommendations within the Engineering Investigation for 10 Lot Subdivision for Nick Gawler. 317-319 Te Horo Beach Road, Te Horo prepared by Landlink Ltd and dated 18 December 2019, submitted to Council in relation to application no. RM190267.

It shall be the ongoing responsibility of the owner to construct and maintain a system which meets the above performance standard.

- 6. <u>With respect to Lots 1-5 and 7-10:</u> The minimum flood level to the underside of the floor joist or underside of the slab of any habitable building including additions and alteration shall be 4.0 metres above the 1953 Wellington MSL datum.
- 7. <u>With respect to Lot 8</u>: No reticulated telecommunication service is provided to this Lot. It is the responsibility of the owner to provide telecommunication services, not Council.
- 8. <u>With respect to Lot 8</u>: No reticulated power service is provided to this Lot. It is the responsibility of the owner to provide power services, not Council.
