Continuation of "Estate of Interest or Easement to be created"

 - (b) any pre-used transported or kitset dwelling <u>unless</u> it has been approved by Wai-iti Hills

 Developments Limited which shall have absolute right of veto without having to specify reasons;
 - any dwelling outbuilding structure or fence constructed of pre-used materials (excluding bricks)

 unless it has been approved by Wai-iti Hills Developments Limited which shall have absolute right of veto without having to specify reasons;
 - (d) any dwelling building or structure with an external wall cladding of hardiplank or metal cladding or other cladding of similar composition or construction, the area of which exceeds 20% of the total area of the external wall areas;
 - (e) any building, dwelling or structure of a radically unconventional design <u>unless</u> it has been approved by Wai-iti Hills Developments Limited which shall have absolute right of veto without

- 6. The registered proprietor of the Servient Lot acknowledges that there is an abundance of birdlife in the area which has been encouraged by the prior landowners and the Wakefield Bush Protection Society. The registered proprietors of the Servient Lots are encouraged to embrace the culture of the Wakefield Bush Protection Society by discouraging their domestic cats from hunting the birdlife and by not encouraging wild feral cats. The registered proprietors of the Servient Lots shall not keep more than two dogs on the Servient Lot provided however that puppies under the age of ten weeks are exempt from this provision.
- 7. The registered proprietor of the Servient Lot shall not (unless permitted by the proviso to this clause) use nor permit the use of the property for institutional residential purposes or as a boarding house. For the purposes of this clause "institutional residential purposes" shall include the use of the property for housing purposes by central or local government agencies or public or private health sector or educational agencies or contractors. This clause however shall not prevent the property being used for tourist or holiday accommodation provided such use has been consented to by the Tasman District Council.
- 8. Wai-iti Hills Developments Limited will not be liable because of any action it takes or fails to take or for any default in any dwelling, building, fence or other structure erected on any of the allotments or at all as a result of these covenants or otherwise and the registered proprietors for the time being of the Servient Lots and the Dominant Lots shall indemnify and keep indemnified the said Wai-iti Hills Developments Limited and its legal successors (other than successors in title after registration of a memorandum of transfer) from any costs, claims, suits, demands, liabilities or otherwise howsoever arising.
- 9. The registered proprietor acknowledges that the above restrictions shall last for twenty-five (25) years from the date of deposit of the plan of subdivision No. 309235.
