GUIDANCE ON USE OF PRODUCER STATEMENTS

Producer statements were first introduced with the Building Act 1991. The producer statements were developed by a combined task committee consisting of members of the New Zealand Institute of Architects, Institution of Professional engineers New Zealand (now Engineering New Zealand), ACE New Zealand in consultation with the Building Officials Institute of New Zealand. The original suit of producer statements has been revised at the date of this form as a result of enactment of the Building Act (2004) by these organisations to ensure standard use within the industry.

The producer statement system is intended to provide Building Consent Authorities (BCAs) with reasonable grounds for the issue of a Building Consent or a Code Compliance Certificate, without having to duplicate design or construction checking undertaken by others.

PS1 Design Intended for use by a suitably qualified independent design professional in circumstances where the BCA accepts a producer statement for establishing reasonable grounds to issue a Building Consent;

PS2 Design Review Intended for use by a suitably qualified independent design professional where the BCA accepts an independent design professional's review as the basis for establishing reasonable grounds to issue a Building Consent;

PS3 Construction Forms commonly used as a certificate of completion of building work are Schedule 6 of NZS 3910:2013 or Schedules E1/E2 of NZIA's SCC 2011²

PS4 Construction Review Intended for use by a suitably qualified independent design professional who undertakes construction monitoring of the building works where the BCA requests a producer statement prior to issuing a Code Compliance Certificate.

This must be accompanied by a statement of completion of building work (Schedule 6).

The following guidelines are provided by ACE New Zealand and Engineering New Zealand to interpret the Producer Statement.

Competence of Design Professional

This statement is made by a Design Firm that has undertaken a contract of services for the services named, and is signed by a person authorised by that firm to verify the processes within the firm and competence of its designers.

A competent design professional will have a professional qualification and proven current competence through registration on a national competence based register, either as a Chartered Professional Engineer (CPEng) or a Registered Architect.

Membership of a professional body, such as Engineering New Zealand (formerly IPENZ), provides additional assurance of the designer's standing within the profession. If the design firm is a member of the ACE New Zealand, this provides additional assurance about the standing of the firm.

Persons or firms meeting these criteria satisfy the term "suitably qualified independent design professional".

*Professional Indemnity Insurance

As part of membership requirements, ACE New Zealand requires all member firms to hold Professional Indemnity Insurance to a minimum level.

The PI Insurance minimum stated on the front of this form reflects standard, small projects. If the parties deem this inappropriate for large projects the minimum may be up to \$500,000.

Professional Services during Construction Phase

There are several levels of service which a Design Firm may provide during the construction phase of a project (CM1-CM5 for Engineers³). The Building Consent Authority is encouraged to require that the service to be provided by the Design Firm is appropriate for the project concerned.

Requirement to provide Producer Statement PS4

Building Consent Authorities should ensure that the applicant is aware of any requirement for producer statements for the construction phase of building work at the time the building consent is issued as no design professional should be expected to provide a producer statement unless such a requirement forms part of the Design firm's engagement.

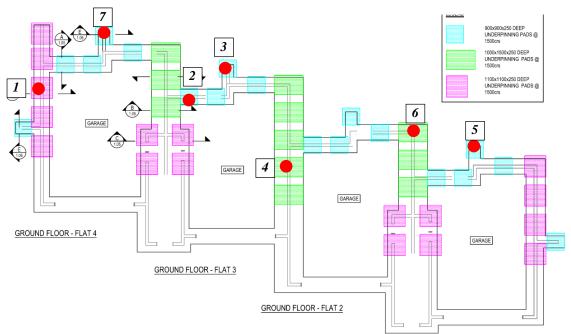
3) The average excavation depth was observed to be between 1100-1400 mm.







4) 7 locations were tested with the Scala penetrometer as shown below in plans.



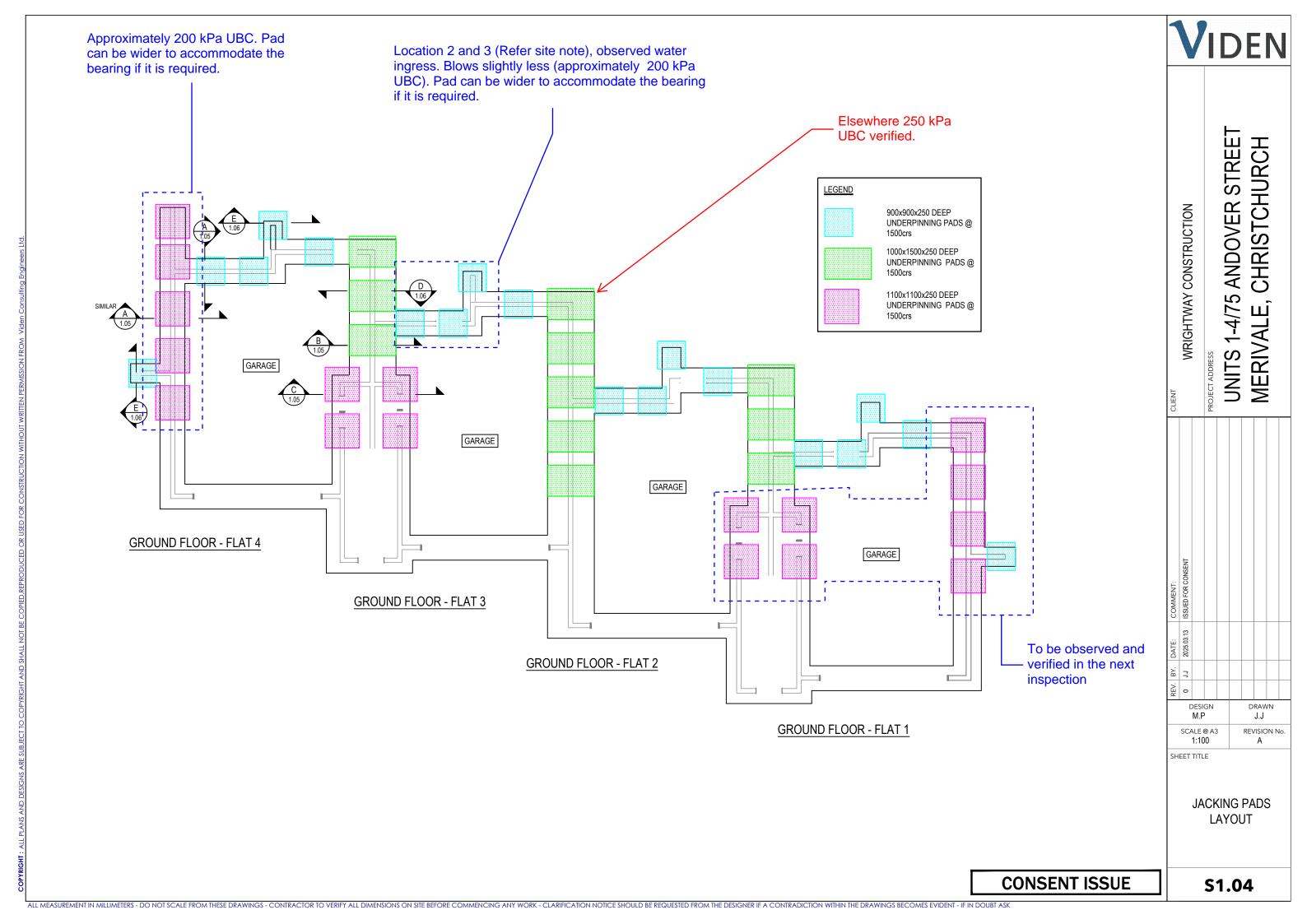
Test Locations:

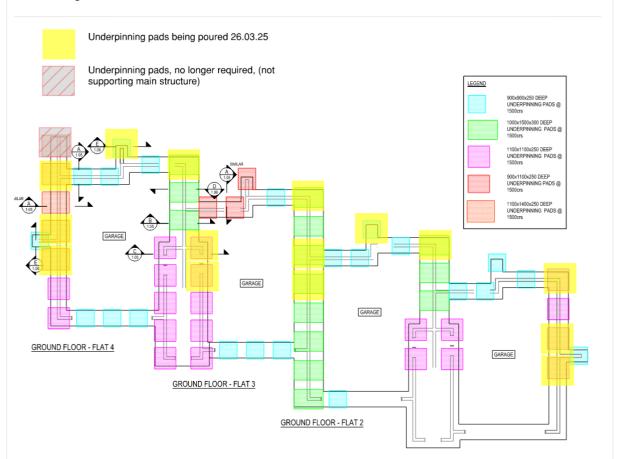

Observations: Underpinning Pad Concrete Pre-pour

A site visit was undertaken to view the reinforcing within a portion of the underpinning pads. See the underpinning pads highlighted (in yellow) below being covered by this construction monitoring record:



During the site visits a representative sample of the above pads had reinforcing installed, and all were generally as per the structural drawings. Subsequent to the site visit, photos of the reinforcing in the remaining excavations was provided. Pad sizes were at least as large as

outlined in the above drawings.

Therefore, I have no objections to pouring the highlighted underpinning pads as outlined above.

Stability of the structure will need to be considered when all of the underpinning pads have been excavated, as we need to ensure sufficient soil remains in place to provide lateral stability to the existing dwelling and vertical support once lifted.

It was confirmed that once the above pads were poured, props would be installed to ensure we have sufficient support to the building above.

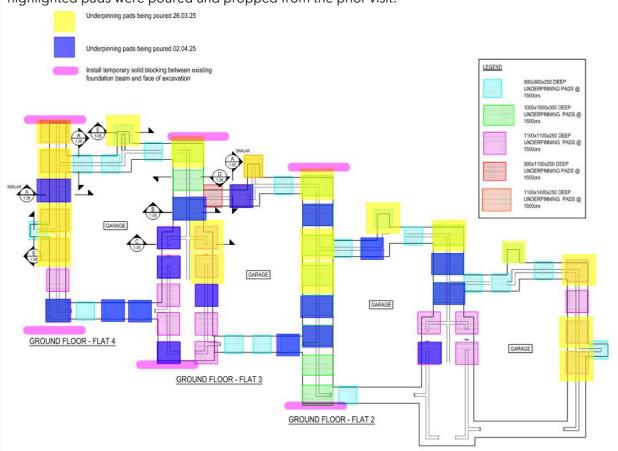

Observations: Remaining Underpinning Pads

A site visit was undertaken to view the next stage of excavated underpinning pads, see the pads highlighted (in Blue) below being covered by this construction monitoring record, while the yellow highlighted pads were poured and propped from the prior visit:



Previously, concern regarding the lateral stability of the structure during construction was raised in CM01. We recommend that temporary solid blocking be installed between the existing footing and the soil at the end pads shown in magenta above.

During the site visit, reinforcing was being installed in the excavated pads. However, a representative sample (>60%) of the above pads had reinforcing installed, and all were generally as per the structural drawings. Pad sizes were at least as large as outlined in the above drawings.

Therefore, I have no objections to pouring the highlighted underpinning pads as outlined above, Subject to approval from the geotechnical engineer.

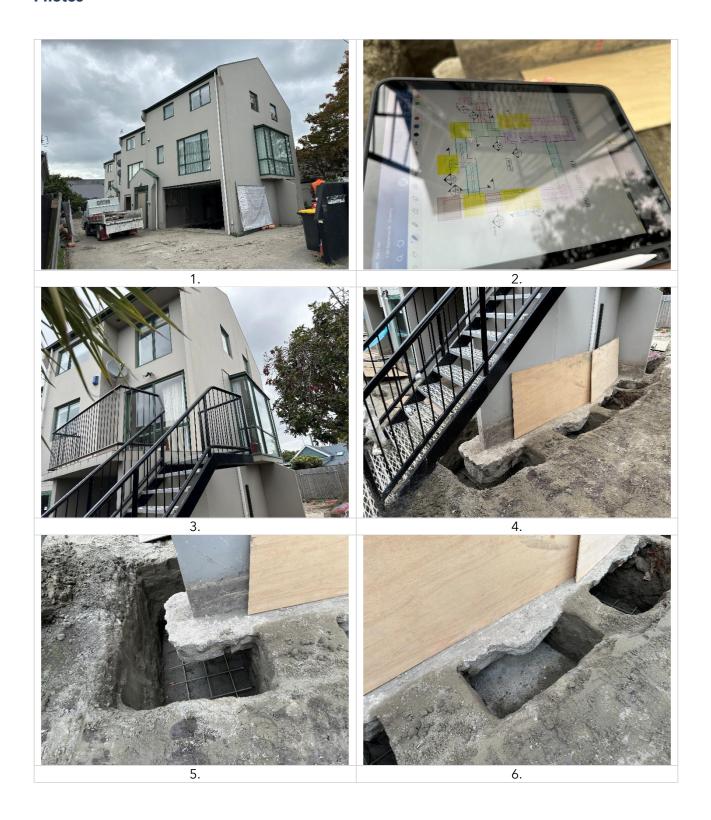
