This Code Compliance Certificate 090806 was issued on 8/04/24 and is the subject of a durability modification. Prior to issuing the Code Compliance Certificate an amendment to the original consent was required to consider the date the performance under B2.3.1 of the building code applies. This is required because Code Compliance Certificate was applied for more than 5 years following the completion of the build. Please refer to the Code Compliance Certificate for that date.

To date not all inspections for Building Consent 001072 have been undertaken and a Code Compliance Certificate has not been issued. Under the Building Act 2004 and Building Act 1991 a new owner inherits the responsibility, including any outstanding fees, for this consent and any additional work that may be required before the Code Compliance Certificate can be issued. This property is zoned Rural Production in the Operative District Plan (2021).

This property is located within PREC24 - Rural Hills Precinct. There are specific provisions in the Operative District Plan (2021) for this Precinct.

This property was created via subdivision in 1972. A copy of the Deposited Plan (DP 33688) and Record of Title is provided with this LIM.

This property is subject to a right to install and maintain stream protection works, a right of way, and gas supply rights.

It is recommended that the Record of Title is checked for any interests registered against the property such as easements or covenants.

This property contains some specific features on it that are recorded in the Operative District Plan (2021).

These features are:

Designation: land required for infrastructure or other public purposes. (KRH-001) (Old reference D0301) Railway purpose, railway through the Kapiti Coast District.

Transportation Noise Effects Route - which includes designations for both State Highway No.1 (NZTA-001) (Old reference D0101) and Railway (KRH-001) (Old reference D0301). This requires an acoustic design to new residential buildings or major additions.

This property is adjacent to a property which contains some specific features on it that are recorded in the Operative District Plan (2021).

These features are:

Designation: land required for infrastructure or other public purposes. (NZTA-001A) (Old reference D0101) State Highway Purposes, State Highway One through district.

Air Space Designation - land within the airport flight paths where height restrictions apply to buildings and trees as set out in the Operative District Plan (2021).

This property is located within the Conical Surface 1:20, Operations Area of the Paraparaumu Airport. Refer to the Airport Plan and Surfaces maps of the Operative District Plan (2021).

A Natural hazard is defined as any atmospheric or earth or water related occurrence (including earthquake, tsunami, erosion, volcanic and geothermal activity, landslip, subsidence, sedimentation, wind, drought, fire, or flooding) the action of which adversely affects or may adversely affects human life, property, or other aspects of the environment.

If this property has been the subject of a Resource Consent or Building Consent since 1 July 2020 a geotechnical assessment may have been supplied with that application. A geotechnical report may contain advice about ground conditions at that site including liquefaction, slope stability assessment as well as commentary on ground bearing capacity. Coastal Erosion and Inundation Hazards

Council holds a number of reports that assess the possibility that areas of the Kāpiti Coast District shoreline may be susceptible to current and future coastal erosion and inundation. The available information on coastal hazards that are specific to the District are available on the following link: www.kapiticoast.govt.nz/coastal-science. The science of coastal erosion and inundation continues to develop as national and international best practice changes, and new information is released. The information received by Council will therefore outline different perspectives.

Currently, information specific to the Kapiti Coast District includes:

- Council-commissioned assessments by Jacobs NZ Ltd, including coastal area-specific risk assessments, a hazard and susceptibility assessment, and the coastal hazards GIS map viewer allowing you to assess how any particular property may be affected.
- A community commissioned coastal hazard risk assessment report by Dr Willem de Lange and related predicted shoreline maps.
- Advice from the Ministry for the Environment and the Department of Conservation on coastal hazard risk identification and management of coastal risks.

Council will consider the information and its possible impact on Kāpiti properties, as part of its review of coastal provisions in the Council's Operative District Plan. On 30 January 2025 Council resolved that this work is a priority to progress.

Earthquakes

Greater Wellington Regional Council holds information on earthquake risks in the Kapiti Coast District. This information, along with associated Earthquake Risk Maps, can be found on the Greater Wellington Regional Council website www.gw.govt.nz/.

Earthquake fault traces within the Kapiti Coast are mapped in the Operative District Plan (2021). These are shown (if applicable) on the District Plan Features Map provided with this LIM and are available on our website Operative District Plan 2021 (kapiticoast.govt.nz).

Fire

Due to its climate and geographical features, the Kapiti Coast District can be susceptible to risks of fire, including wildfire. More information on this risk can be found in the <u>District Plan</u>, while mapping of the rural wildfire fire risk across the Wellington Region on the Greater Wellington Regional Council website (GWRC rural wildfire risk).

Liquefaction

Due to its geographic location and soil typology, the Kapiti Coast District may be susceptible to liquefaction in the event of an earthquake. More information on this risk can be found in the <u>District Plan</u>, while mapping of <u>combined earthquake risk</u> including liquefaction, can be found on the Greater Wellington Regional Council website.

Tsunami Evacuation Zones

Tsunami Evacuation Zone Maps have been developed by the Greater Wellington Regional Council to assist emergency preparedness by identifying the area's residents may need to evacuate in the event of a tsunami.

Aerial Photograph

A birds-eye view in colour of the property and its surrounds.

Deposited Plan

Sometimes referred to as a 'Flats Plan' or 'Title Plan'. A Deposited Plan covers more than one lot (or property) and has a diagram showing the boundary distances and the land area. A Record of Title relates to a specific property and shows current owner and interests (such as mortgages, encumbrances and easements).

Building Information (if requested)

This includes any information Council holds about any structure that is on the lot (property), e.g. plumbing, drainage and floor plans and elevation drawings of the building and any alterations or additions to it, together with any code compliance certificates.

Services Network Map

Information on private and public stormwater and sewerage drains on the property as shown in Council's records.

Location of Health and Alcohol Licenses

This map shows the location of registered businesses in the neighbourhood that hold health and alcohol licenses.

Resource Consents

Included with this LIM are Reports and Maps of resource consents (if applicable that relate to the property) and a list of resource consents in the neighbourhood of the property that have been notified. The District Plan contains rules about different types of activities in different parts of the district. Anything not permitted by the Plan requires a resource consent. When a resource consent application is received the Council determines whether or not to notify it on the basis of the environmental effects under Section 95A-F of the Resource Management Act 1991.

Designation(s) (if applicable)

A designation is a planning technique used by Ministers of the Crown, councils and network utility operators approved as requiring authorities under section 167 of the Resource Management Act 1991. It provides for 'spot zoning' over a site, area or route in a district plan which authorises the requiring authority's work and activity on the site, area or route without the need for a land use resource consent.

District Plan

Every city and district council is required to have a District Plan under the Resource Management Act 1991. The District Plan plays a big part in how Kapiti develops. The rules in the Plan determine what you can and can't do on your property without permission from Council - whether it be subdividing, renovating, building a new garage or deck, or starting a home business. This LIM includes maps which show the Zone, Precinct, or Development Area (if relevant), the Features, Overlays and the Natural Hazards that relate to the rules in the District Plan.

Latest Flood Hazards

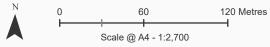

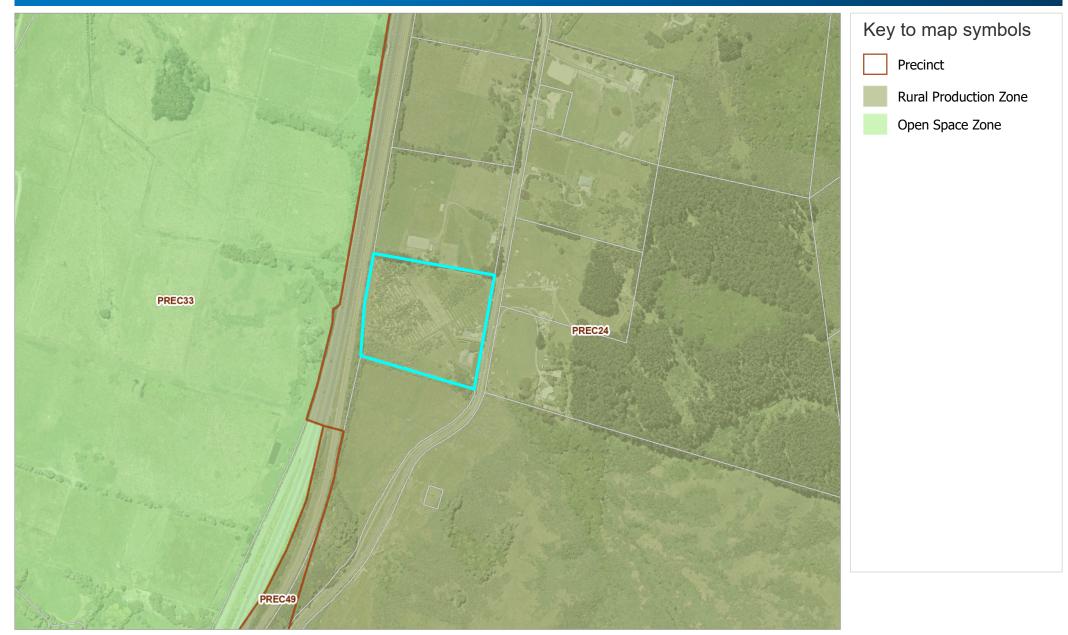




Operative District Plan 2021 - Zones and Precincts

PREAMBLE

This report provides an analysis of the issues relating to an application pursuant to section 348 of the Local Government Act 1974 for consent to the creation of three Right of Way Easements in Gross in favour of Kāpiti Coast District Council, shown on SO 445092 as follows:

- Areas AB and AD over Part Section 1 Survey Office Plan 36580 (otherwise known as 528 State Highway 1, and over Sections 2 and 3 respectively on SO 445092); and
- Area AC over Lot 5 DP 33688 (otherwise known as 86 Emerald Glen Road).

This application has been assigned Kapiti Coast District Council reference RM150129.

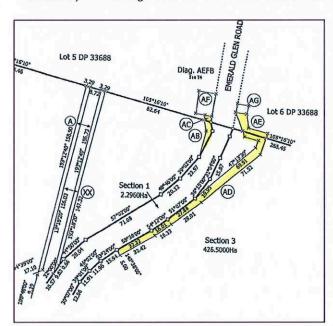
THE PROPOSAL

The application seeks the creation of three Right of Way easements AB, AC and AD over the land described above. The easement areas are illustrated approximately in blue, red and orange respectively on the Proposed Easement Plan by Opus (extract on the following page) reference: Drawing 5/2573/1/5504 prepared for the New Zealand Transport Agency.

All three proposed easments have a nominal width of 5 metres. The orange shaded area on the left hand image is Area AC (over the Sheffields's land. The areas over Department of Conservation land are shown as a red shaded area (AB) and a blue shaded area (AD).

The areas on the above easement plan extract are subject to survey. The final details are shown on LINZ approved Title Plan SO445092 (Sections 1 to 3 and Easements over Lots 5 and 6 DP 33688) approved on 26 January 2012. Refer extract to the left:

Note: A further area shown in green is still under negotiation and does not form part of this application. This is Area AE on the approved Title Plan.

The Right of Way areas denoted AB, AC and AD (and the future area AE, which is not part of this application) are proposed to provide ong-going access for stream protection works associated with the completed road formation and reconfiguration works undertaken on Emerald Glen Road by the New Zealand Transport Agency.

Emerald Glen Road was extended circa 2013 from the cul-de-sac formation shown in the left hand aerial image above, to the through road formation shown in the right hand aerial image. The work was undertaken to facilitate the removal of a level crossing at Waterfall Road to the north of the site and an associated central turning bay on State Highway 1. These had become a safety concern to the Transport Agency. The completed road extension is shown on the approved SO4405092 plan. The applicant advises that "Although the road extension"

has been constructed for some years ... it has not yet been legalised. This is expected to occur shortly".

The need for the proposed easements arises because the new section of Emerald Glen Road crosses a stream near the northern boundary of the Department of Conservation Land (where the former cul-de-sac carriageway previously terminated). Stream protection works were required to be installed as part of the new road formation, including a culvert and erosion/scour facilitities (at points marked AF and AG on the SO Plan extract above). The proposed easements AB, AC and AD are required to be created to enable access to the separate components of the Stream Protection Works either side of the road formation. Access is required on both sides of the road carriageway due to the gradient of the stream bank.

The applicant has advised (and provided a copy) of ageements in place with the two affected landowners the subject of this application to provide for the construction of the easement areas to a four wheel drive standard and for gates to be installed on the boundaries of the easement with other properties. The applicant has further advised, that while gravelling of the surface is provided for, physical formation of the right of way is unlikely to be undertaken because the land is flat, unfenced pasture.

This application therefore is essentially an administrative exercise to match the works with the legal paperwork.

THE SITE

The site (Part Section 1 Survey Office Plan 36580 and Lot 5 DP 33688) which is to be subject to the proposed Right of Way areas AB, AC and AD as Easements in Gross in favour of Kāpiti Coast District Council comprises a mixture of rolling and flat rural pastureland, with some rural buildings and a dwelling on Lot 5 (number 86 Emerald Glen Road).

At the southern end of the Department of Conservation land, there is an information site and access to walking and cycling recreation areas. The extension of Emerald Glen Road connects the former cul-de-sac formation through to a new grade separated interchange with State Highway 1 south of the site. There are gravelled walkway/cycleways either side of the new road formation.

A stream crosses the new road extension just south of the former cul-de-sac head location outside number 86. The proposed easement areas provide access to the stream protection instalations in this location, from both sides of the new road formation. They will be easements in gross, in favour of Kāpiti Coast District Council.

RELEVANT STATUTORY PROVISIONS

Section 348 of the Local Government Act 1974 sets out the powers of Council with respect to Private Roads and Private Ways and states:

348 Powers of council with respect to private roads and private ways

- (1) Except with the prior permission of the council, no person shall lay out or form any private road or private way, or grant or reserve a right of way over any private way, in the district.
- (2) Subject to section 347, in granting any such permission the council may—
 - (a) impose such conditions as to widths, levels, entrances, courses, formation, cost of formation, maximum number of buildings to be erected fronting any such private road or private way, minimum distances between any 2 buildings, position of building line, and otherwise in all respects whatsoever as the council thinks fit; and

- (b) require the owner or owners to whom permission is given to enter into a bond to comply with any conditions imposed by the council. Every such bond shall be deemed—
 - to be an instrument creating an interest in each parcel of land to which the conditions apply within the meaning of section 62 of the Land Transfer Act 1952, and may be registered accordingly; and
 - (ii) to be a covenant running with each such parcel of land, and shall bind subsequent owners.
- (3) Any permission of the council under subsection (1) to lay out or form any private road or private way as aforesaid shall be deemed to lapse on the expiration of 3 years after the grant thereof, unless the work has then been completed to the satisfaction of the council; but may from time to time be extended by the council for a period or periods not exceeding 1 year at any one time.
- (4) With respect to any private road, the council—
 - (a) may require any projection or obstruction in or over any part thereof to be removed at the expense of the person causing the same or to whom the same belongs:
 - (b) may by notice in writing require the owners of land or buildings abutting on the private road to construct or repair the road, with the footways, kerbing, and channelling thereof, and every such owner shall be liable for the construction and repair of so much of the private road as the council thinks fit:
 - (c) in case of default, may execute the said works, and recover the cost from the owners in the aforesaid proportions.
- (5) Subsection (4) shall apply to every private way which for the time being serves as an approach to 2 or more allotments that are separately owned or separately occupied or to any allotment on which there are 2 or more buildings that are separately occupied.
- (6) Nothing in this section applies to a private road or right of way lawfully created as part of a subdivision under the Resource Management Act 1991.

ASSESSMENT

The land over which the three skights of Way are to be created is zoned Rural (District Plan Map 19), and Hill Country (Rural Subdivision Map 05). There are Well Defined and Constrained Fault Avoidance Zones running parallel and to the east of easement Area AD but clear of the easement.

The stream protection works areas which the Right of Way will provide access to are within the Rural Zone/Hill Country Overlay area.

Based on the information provided by the applicant, and my site visit observations, there are no physical works required to form the access over the proposed easement area as this is suitable terrain for four wheel drive vehicles. It is possible that some gravel surfacing may be involved at a later date, and this has already been approved by the affected landowners and covered in separate ageement documents.

The application has been circulated to the Council's Senior Development Engineer who has reported to me by email that he has no objections to the proposal and no conditions to recommend.

The easements provide necessary access to maintain stream protection works around the bridge formation that is part of the Emerald Glen Road extension.

I consider that there would be no adverse effects and no difficulties associated with creating, maintaining and using ROW access areas AB, AC and AD on the application site. I consider that there is no need to impose any conditions, given the access is readily avaliable now. I therefore conclude that the ROW approval can be granted.

RECOMMENDATION/DECISION

Pursuant to Section 348 of the Local Government Act 1974, the undersigned Officers acting under Delegated Authority from Council, hereby **GRANT** consent for Right of Way Easements in Gross in favour of Kāpiti Coast District Council, shown on Title Plan SO 445092 (Sections 1 to 3 and Easements over Lots 5 and 6 DP 33688), as follows:

- Areas marked AB and AD over Part Section 1 Survey Office Plan 36580 (Sections 2 and 3 respectively on SO 445092); and
- Area AC over Lot 5 DP 33688.
