Consent Notice

The Tasman District Council hereby gives notice pursuant to Section 221 of the Resource Management Act 1991 that the Council's consent number RM210681 in respect of Land Transfer Plan No. DP 577348 was granted subject to the following conditions to be complied with on a continuing basis: -

In respect of Lots 64, 65 and 66:

- 1. No owner shall fill or otherwise recontour the ground within 1.5m of the northern boundary of the Lot and shall ensure that the natural drainage channel is maintained free of any blockage or debris which would inhibit overland water flows in this area.
- 2. The finished floor level of any dwelling shall have a finished floor level as measured against New Zealand vertical datum 2016 ("NZVD") equal to or greater than:
 - a. in respect of Lot 64: 64.61 NZVD;
 - b. in respect of Lot 65: 64.56 NZVD;
 - c. in respect of Lot 66: 64.47 NZVD.
- 3. Swanney Building Site Certification Report dated 5 March 2024 was undertaken in order to ensure that there is a suitable area on Lots 64, 65 and 66 for the construction of a residential building in accordance with NZS4404:2010. A copy of this Report is available from Tasman District Council and includes the following recommendations:
 - (a) Specific design of foundations by a chartered professional engineer is required due to the potential for differential settlements across the lots following strong ground shaking associated with an earthquake event. Shallow foundation designed in line with the MBIE guidance document "Repairing and rebuilding houses affected by the Canterbury earthquakes" for improved foundations for land development technical category TC2 are considered appropriate for these lots.

(b) Any fill placed on any part of a Lot shall be certified by a suitably experienced chartered professional engineer, certifying that the fill has been placed and compacted in accordance with NZS 4431:1989.
