## SCHEDULE 'B'

State whether any rights or powers set out here are in addition to or in substitution for those set out in the Seventh Schedule to the Land Transfer Act 1952.

1. Rights and Powers: In addition to those set out in the Seventh Schedule to the Land Transfer Act, 1952 in respect of the Right to Drain Water the grantee and his tenants shall have the right and power to drain and discharge water from eel tanks erected on the Dominant Tenement. The drain may be an open drain

## SCHEDULE 'C'

### 2. Terms, conditions, covenants, or restrictions in respect of any of the above easements:

(a) The formation and maintenance of the right of way shall be the sole responsibility of the grantee at his cost

(b) The existing open drain along that part of the servient tenement marked B shall not be interfered with or blocked by the grantee or his tenants

(c) The grantee will erect and keep maintained at his cost suitable gates at the north and south boundaries of the right of way to the intent that stock in Lots 2 and 3 do not have an exit at these points. The grantee shall keep these gates closed at all times while stock are kept in Lots 2 and 3 except when required to be opened during the time of passing through those points.

(d) The grantor, his tenants and any other person lawfully entitled so to do shall be entitled to erect at his expense a gate at a point where the right of way meets the drain reserve for the purpose of preventing stock from passing at that point to and from Lots 2 and 3 and the grantee and his tenants will close such gate if opened by him or them immediately after passing through the same.
