There is a seamless connection to a large deck and a view of nature's delights from each room.

The current owners have established a thriving boutique business, supplying everything from banana palms, pineapple plants, and lotus to feature rocks, water lilies, and seeds. With over 1000 banana clumps across 50+ varieties, eight established lotus ponds, and a strong customer base, this is a ready-made venture with huge scope for expansion. Demand for their plants and produce spans the country, with consulting services, guided tours, and retail sales already in place.

In addition to the plant nursery and productive gardens, the property features a solar-powered glamping cabin nestled in native bush, as well as a self-contained accommodation unit with power and wi-fi, and camping areas—offering untapped potential for eco-tourism. There's even the perfect site to establish a café and expand the visitor experience further.

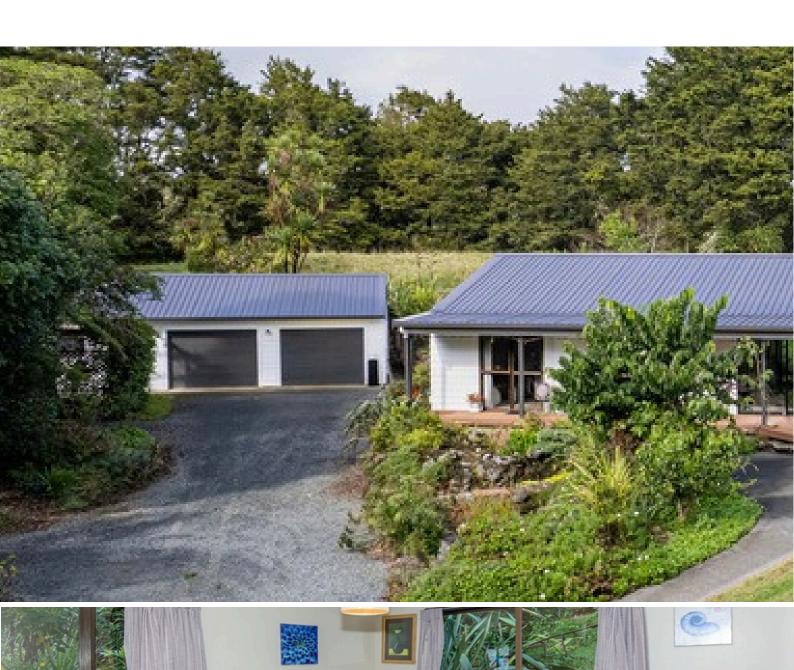

ROCKS

Once part of a much larger farm, tonnes of rocks were moved onto this block in the past. The sellers have been progressively clearing away the rocks from areas where grass or fruit are desired, in ways that are sensitive to the environment, preserving the natural environment and beautiful spaces they like to share with visitors. A trailer-load of rocks is \$60 per trailer if customers load themselves or \$100 if loaded by LOTL. Larger loads and rock sizes can be arranged.



A selection of merchandise is available to visitors, which include Blue Lotus tea, meditation oil and Celestial Regenerative Blue Lotus & Moringa Face Oil from Kiss the Earth NZ.

<u>Pineapples</u>

Many people are discovering the sheer delight of a locally-grown pineapple, whether it be one purchased from the local farmers' market or grown at home. For those wanting to grow pineapples for themselves, plants are for sale - queen, cayenne and red or can be couriered throughout NZ. Most people prefer yellow pineapples for their sweet and delicious flavour, but red pineapples are also eaten fresh and often used in cooking. They make a fantastic pineapple crumble! Plants come with planting instructions, are subject to availability, and recipes are available on request!



<u>Bananas</u>

Land of the Lotus have a boutique collection of over 50 different varieties of bananas, and specialise in rare and unusual plants. Customers can come for a visit and walk amongst the plantation. Shipping can be arranged all over New Zealand. Banana fruit is also for sale. Banana leaves are also a popular item, supplied for cooking and catering.



There are eight well stocked lotus ponds that can be visited - they are at their best in the summer months from late November to April. There's also tubs of lotus where you can get up close and personal with these ancient, much-revered plants. Plants and seeds are for sale. Plants, aquatic mix and fertiliser are also available. Seeds, fertiliser and aquatic mix can be couriered; plants are pickup only. Also available are the hard to find "Blue Lotus" - these are actually blue tropical waterlilies.



A list of current plants is available on request, providing an understanding of the scale of variety of tropical plants that are growing at this remarkable property most of which are available to be sold to the public.



TOURISM

Visitors are encouraged to allow plenty of time to take in all of Land of the Lotus! Extensive lawns and plantations are complemented by eight lotus ponds and sinuous banana beds featuring specialty banana plants. There are bush walks alongside the streams - complete with beautiful native bush and rock formations with plenty of places to sit and enjoy the view. There are both shorter and longer walks to suit different fitness levels, and even a children's playground.

PURCHASE OPTIONS



The sellers are open to structuring the sale of their unique property in a way that best suits the purchaser's vision.

There are three primary pathways under consideration:

OPTION 1: LIFESTYLE RESIDENCE OR RETREAT

The purchaser acquires the land, house, and all associated buildings, with the intention of using the property for personal enjoyment, accommodation, or as a retreat. This option does not include any business assets or ongoing commercial use and would suit someone seeking a peaceful and beautifully established lifestyle setting.

OPTION 2: FULL BUSINESS & PROPERTY PACKAGE

This turnkey opportunity includes the land, house, buildings, and the established business. Included in the sale are:

- The business name, website, and social media channels
- Stock at valuation (plants, seeds, retail goods)
- The mail order business, onsite retail operation, and accommodation component

The purchaser would take over the production and sale of lotus, bananas, pineapples, and other niche plants, with the current owners available to provide guidance and support for a mutually agreed transition period. By separate arrangement, the sellers are also willing to supply additional rocks and waterliles from their neighbouring property to support future growth.

OPTION 3: PROPERTY WITH ALTERNATIVE BUSINESS USE

In this scenario, the purchaser buys the house, land, and buildings but intends to operate an entirely new or different business — for example, a wedding venue, retreat centre, or additional accommodation model. The current owners would retain the brand name, website, and online presence, with a view to pivoting their original business to a wholesale-only model, separate from the property.

ADDITIONAL NOTES ON MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT

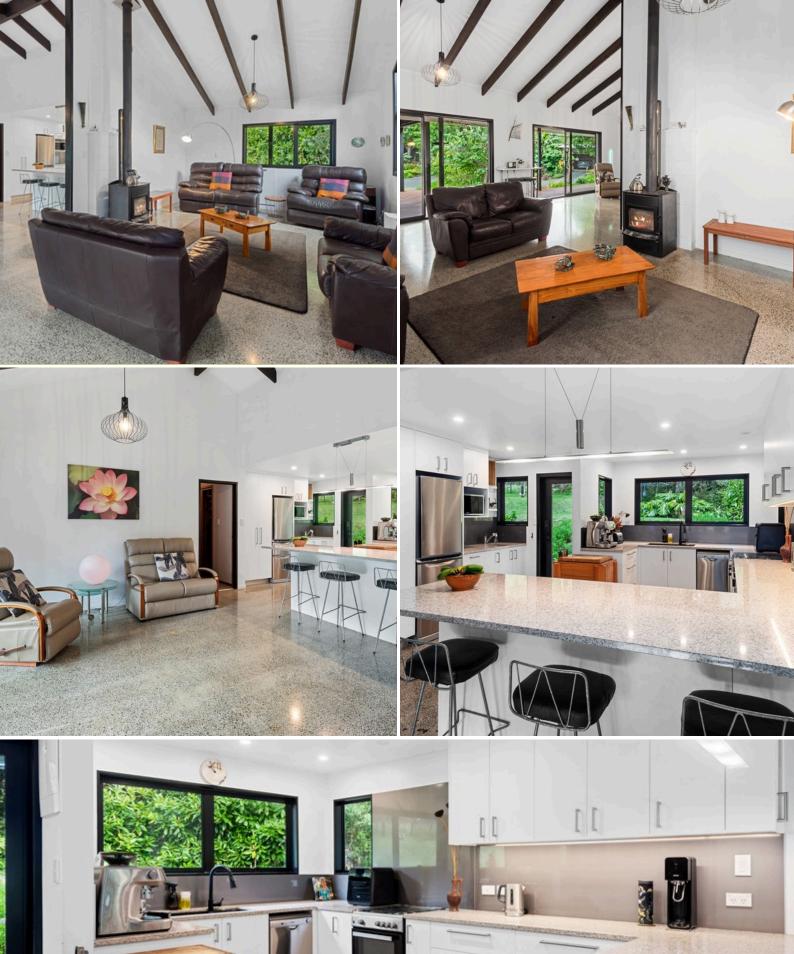
A selection of tools and machinery may be available by negotiation, depending on the chosen purchase structure. This can be discussed further based on the purchaser's intended use of the property.

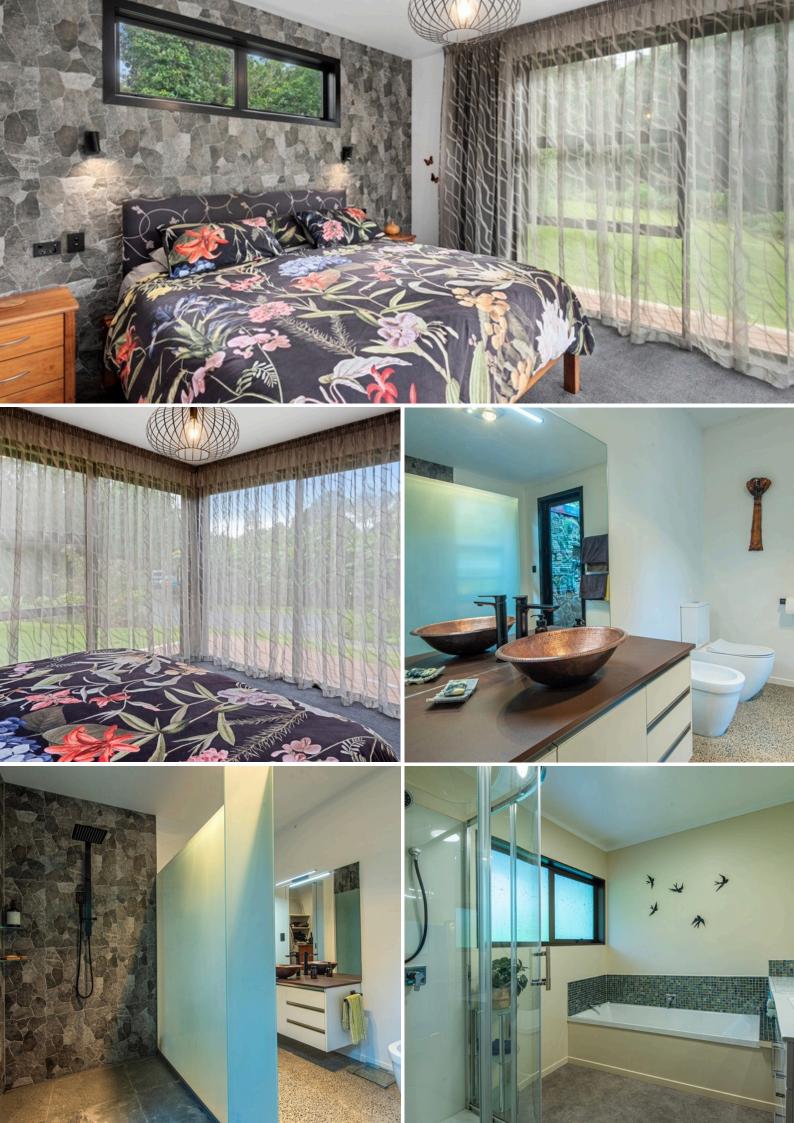
