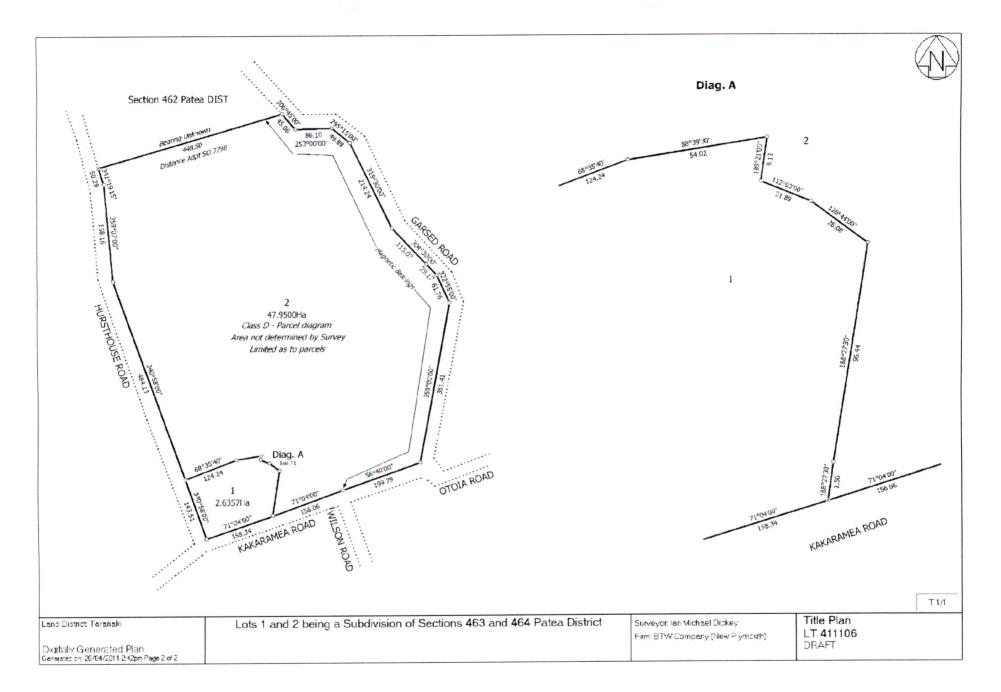

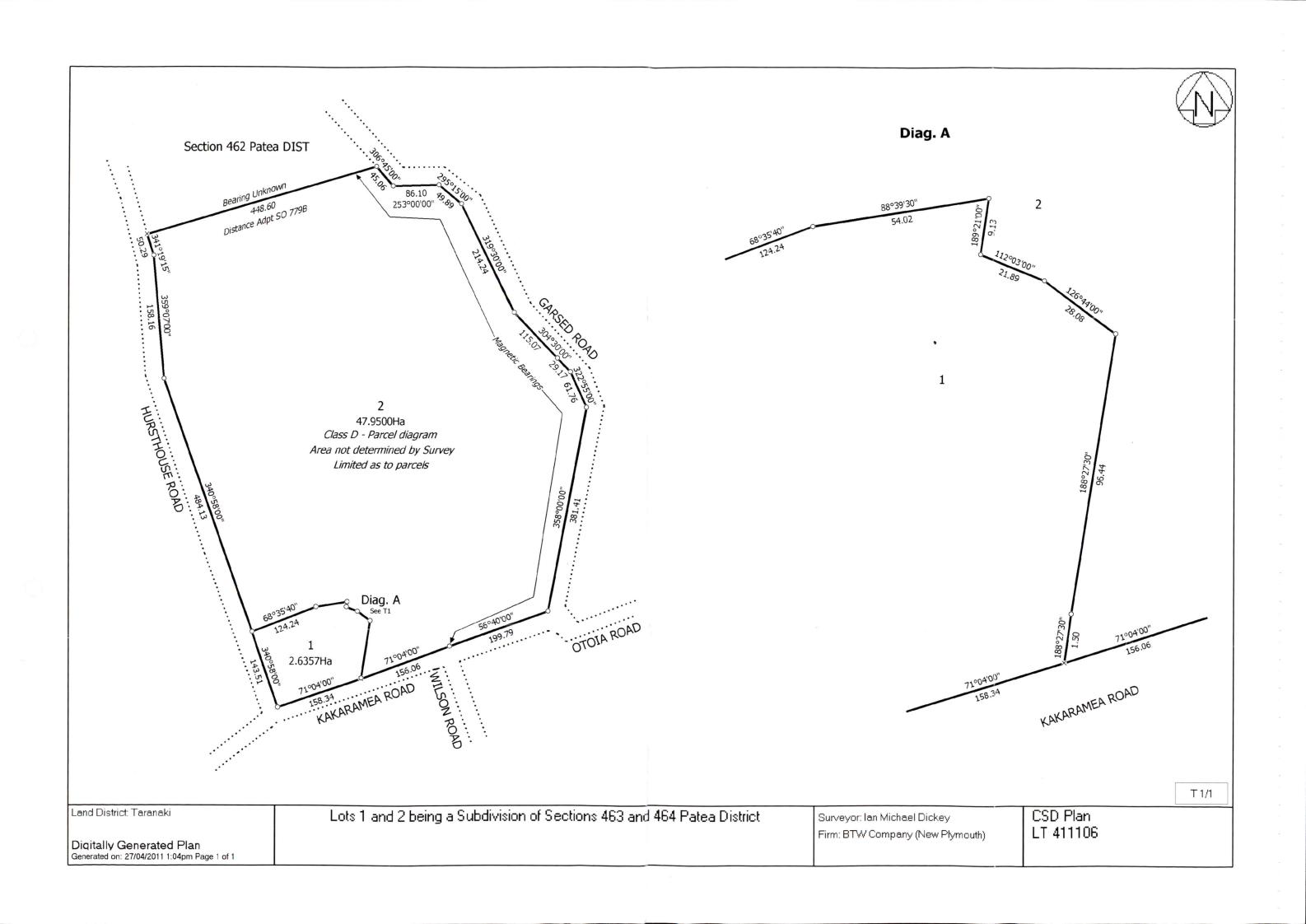

Description of Subdivision

The applicant wishes to subdivide the land into two lots, as shown on the attached scheme plan. The land is currently farmed with the principal buildings being two dwellings and a cowshed. The proposed lot sizes are as follows:

Lot 1	2.7ha
Lot 2	47.88ha

The application site is located in the Rural Zone as shown in the South Taranaki District Planning Map No. 12. The subdivision is a controlled activity as specified in Section 8.01.2(c) of the South Taranaki District Plan (STDP). The subdivision fully complies with the performance standards set out or referred to in Section 8.02 and is not listed in Sections 8.01.3, 8.01.4 and 8.01.5.

Subdivision Performance Standards - Controlled Activity

The subdivision would meet the performance standards set out in the STDP as follows:

1. Utilities and Services

Both of the proposed lots will make their own provision for **water supply** through rainwater tanks and for **effluent disposal** through septic tanks. **Stormwater** will be disposed of to ground via soak holes. Effluent and stormwater disposal for both lots will be independent and would not give rise to cross boundary effects.

2. Building Platform

Proposed Lots 1 and 2 provide suitable topography and are of a sufficient size to provide a building platform, however the subdivision is being undertaken to provide separate titles for the existing dwellings.

3. Access

Proposed Lot 1 will make use of the existing vehicle crossing off Kakaramea Rd and proposed Lot 2 will make use of the existing crossing off Garsed Rd. Vehicle access design complies with the design standards contained in Appendix 6 of the STDP.

4. Set Back

The existing shed on proposed Lot 1 will be located a minimum distance of 5m from the northern boundary. All other buildings will also comply with the minimum set back requirements of the STDP.

Assessment of Environmental Effects

The subject land is relatively flat and is located some 2.7km to the north-east of the settlement of Kakaramea. Surrounding land uses are predominantly rural which is typical of the area.

The proposed two lot subdivision described in this application is being carried out to provide for separate titles for each of the dwellings that are located on the site. There would be no significant change in land use with the larger Lot 2 continuing to be farmed. Subsequently effects on rural character and amenity would be no more than minor.

Each lot will make their own provision for services with no cross boundary effects. Vehicle access points comply with permitted activity performance standards contained in Appendix 6 of the STDP.

No Significant Natural Areas, Scheduled River, Stream or Waahi Tapu have been identified as lying within the boundaries of the proposed subdivision, nor in the immediate vicinity. Likewise, no Heritage Item, Notable Tree or other Archaeological Site is affected.

It is concluded that the subdivision will have only minor adverse effects on the environment and that these will be within acceptable levels for the Rural Zone.

Summary

The applicant wishes to subdivide the rural zoned land into two lots. All services will be provided and vehicle access points will comply with Council standards.

The subdivision is a controlled activity under Section 8.01.2(c) of the STDP. An Assessment of Environmental Effects has shown there will be only minor adverse environmental effects and these will be acceptable for the rural zone.
